- Vice-President's Report - Karyn Green, Jenny Langan, \& Amy Featherstone

Jenny Langan: Family movie night-Friday January $5^{\text {th }}$. Heather Keppy would like PTA to narrow down to 3 movies for the students to vote on. Those at PTA meeting eliminated 3 movies from Heather's list and students will vote on Lego Batman, Moana, Sing. Amy Featherstone: PJ Drive-collection ended on December $8^{\text {th }}$. ## New Business:

- $6^{\text {th }}$ Grade class of 16-17 will use their gifts to school funds to hire Sally Daly to do some painting of the east wall in cafeteria, the main hallway leading to the lunch room entrance and the bulletin board outside the entrance doors near the gymnasium.
- Gifts to School--Funds raised from Fall Fest go directly back into the classroom. Wish list is now as complete as can be at this time. Discussion was made about line items. Motion to approve fall fest funds gifts to school motioned by Jenny Leslie, seconded by Juliana Robinson. Motion approved. At this time, we will hold off on the teacher checks until final numbers come in regarding gifts to schoolchanges in shipping costs, tax, etc. may be slightly different than currently quoted.
- Forest Grove Elementary - Dr. Spelhaug

Welcome to Dr. Spelhaug for coming to speak with us regarding the possible changes the school board will need to make concerning boundaries for new Forest Grove school. Forest Grove ( $6^{\text {th }}$ elementary) will open 2021-2022 school year. It has yet to be determined whether the school will be constructed as a 2,3 or 4 section school. Looking at having it designed similar to Hopewell. The reason for trying to create boundaries at this time is to give new housing areas some idea of the school their children would be attending. Map shown (see below): black circles represent 1-mile radius walk zone for Hopewell, Pleasant View and Forest Grove. Map shown is 1.5 yrs. old and shows planned development which has already been platted, constructed, etc. Even though there will be a high-density housing complex going up off Middle Road/Crow Creek Rd, studies historically have shown more students come from single family housing areas. Currently, it looks as though students within the boundaries of Forest Grove Rd (north), Criswell St (east), $53^{\text {rd }}$ Ave (south) and Middle Rd (west) would go to Forest Grove. (193 students in this area currently attend Pleasant View). Please keep in mind this is a starting point for the school board to create boundaries for the new school. Please don't hesitate to contact Dr. Spelhaug or school board members if you have questions, and families are always welcome to attend school board meetings. Dr. Spelhaug also thanked the parents and PTA's for their support of the students of Pleasant Valley Community School District.
