



Hypodermoclysis (HDC)

Site Location: _____

Type: Subcutaneous

Things to look for:

- Is the site leaking? (e.g. leaking thru dressing, or clothes or bed linen wet)
- Is the site hard or red?
- Is the subcut line still in the person skin or has it become dislodged?
- Is the tubing still connected?
- Has the fluid stopped dripping into the drip chamber?
- Is the fluid bag empty?

Notify a nurse if you see any of the above the concerns.

Reminders:

- Do not pull on the infusion tubing
- Do not kink or put pressure on the tubing
- Do not use scissors near the infusion tubing
