Rare Plant Status Review: *Eriogonum luteolum* var. *saltuarium* Nicholas Jensen (CNPS) and Roxanne Bittman (CNDDB) June 6, 2008

Changes made since the original status review appear in blue.

Background

Eriogonum luteolum var. saltuarium is an annual, herbaceous species in the Polygonaceae. *E luteolum* var. saltuarium was originally described by James Reveal in *Phytologia* 66(3): 264-265 (1989). Although not included in the current *Jepson Manual* (1993), the species will be included in the upcoming second edition. *E. luteolum* var. saltuarium is most closely related to *E. luteolum* var. pedunculatum, which occurs at lower elevations in the Sierra Nevada foothills. *E. luteolum* var. saltuarium is distinguished from other varieties of *E. luteolum* by its erect growth habit and the comparatively large size of its flowers and involucres. *E. luteolum* var. saltuarium flowers between July and September.

E. luteolum var. *saltuarium* occurs in sandy, granitic flats within upper montane coniferous forest and Great Basin scrub habitats from 1700 to 2400 meters in elevation. It is the only variety of *E. luteolum* that does not occur on serpentine soils.

E. luteolum var. *saltuarium* is known from two locations in the Sierra Nevada, near Dardanelle in Tuolumne County and near Luther Pass in Alpine County. Plants have been collected at four, nearby locations near Dardanelle. It is unclear whether plants at this location represent one large occurrence or four distinct occurrences. In the *Flora of North America* (Vol. 5), James Reveal states that, "only a few hundred individuals have been observed in the field."

E. luteolum var. *saltuarium* is threatened by recreational activities. Granitic flats and slopes within (and beyond) the known range of *E. luteolum* var. *saltuarium* should be searched for additional occurrences of this taxon.

Based on the information currently available, CNPS and CNDDB recommend that *E. luteolum* var. *saltuarium* be added to CNPS List 1B with a .3 .2 threat ranking.
