### What are EMS providers required to report?

EMS providers should report all runs. A run is a resulting action from a call for assistance where an EMS provider is dispatched to, responds to, provides care to, or transports a person.

### What are the reportable data elements?

All of the required fields are listed in the applicable data dictionary.

*NOTE. The EMS & Trauma Registries will only accept NEMSIS V3.3.4 data.*

### How does an EMS provider send data?

Data should be sent electronically. The appropriate method is to establish an account with the EMS & Trauma Registries and use the online system for submitting data. EMS providers may use their own software or the free online system for entering data.

### How often does an EMS provider send data?

Data should be submitted within three months from the date of call for assistance. The EMS & Trauma Registries recommends that EMS providers and business associates submit data monthly. When there is no data for a particular month, the EMS provider

## Introduction

The Provider’s Primary Impression suggested list has been updated to employ a two-tier choice hierarchy in an effort to make identifying and selecting an appropriate value easier for EMS personnel. The first tier represents a generic impression hierarchy. The second tier represents a more specific impression within the generic impression hierarchy. Additionally, more EMS friendly terms are provided. Thus, EMS software implementing this list may provide an interface that first allows EMS personnel to choose a generic impression, and then a more specific impression options are provided to make the final value choice.

## eSituation.11 - Provider’s Primary Impression

The code list associated with eSituation.11 (Provider’s Primary Impression) represents a range of values found in the 10<sup>th</sup> revision of the International Classification of Diseases – Clinical Modification (CD-10-CM). The process for gaining access to the ICD-10 CM code values is provided below.

## Suggested List

The suggested list can be accessed from the NEMSIS TAC website on the Version 3 Resources page: <https://www.nemsis.org/v3/resources.html>. The suggested code list for eSituation.11 (Provider’s Primary Impression) is represented in the ICD-10-CM ranges listed in the table below.

In order to capture the majority of the ICD-10-CM Codes within the NEMSIS Version 3 dataset, the range of codes (and corresponding XSD patterns) have been extended for the Impression elements (eSituation.11 - Provider’s Primary Impression & eSituation.12 - Provider’s Secondary Impressions). The range now includes the R Signs and Symptoms codes to meet the needs of EMS in the pre-hospital setting. The NEMSIS TAC recommends a limited use of R codes where possible.

Based on the NEMSIS Version 3.3.1 dataset the ICD-10-CM codes used to document the EMS professional's provider impression may allow the general section code. No longer is it a requirement for the codes to incorporate at minimum one (1) decimal point. In order to allow for specificity of the impression description the EMS professional may document out to four characters following the decimal. For example, D49 Neoplasms of unspecified behavior [EMS Use: Cancer, unspecified], is now allowed.

In the case of an injury to a lower leg the EMS professional may be more specific and document S89.91XA (Unspecified injury of right lower leg, initial encounter) to provide further level of detail.

## Comparison of Classification and Terminology Systems

Version 3 | July 2018

The purpose of this document is to summarize the key classification and terminology systems that are used internationally to capture information about disorders and diseases for the purposes of global mortality and morbidity tracking. These systems are also used for medical records, including electronic medical records, in primary and secondary care.

**Classification systems:** The *International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems (ICD)* is a detailed index of diseases and injuries developed and maintained by the World Health Organization (WHO). Details of a diagnosis are recorded by a clinician in the patient's medical notes. These are translated into ICD-10 codes by a clinical coder to provide consistency for data reporting and aggregation, for statistical analysis, epidemiology, reimbursement and resource allocation.

**Terminology systems:** A clinical terminology system, for example, *SNOMED CT*, is a comprehensive, structured collection of descriptive terms, which are used in clinical practice at the point of care. Terminology includes the diagnoses but also items such as symptoms, treatments, procedures, administrative terms, social and environmental factors. Each clinical concept or phrase is assigned a unique code to provide a standardized terminology for recording and sharing clinical findings across multiple health care settings. ICD-10 codes have been mapped to *SNOMED CT* codes for interoperability. (1)

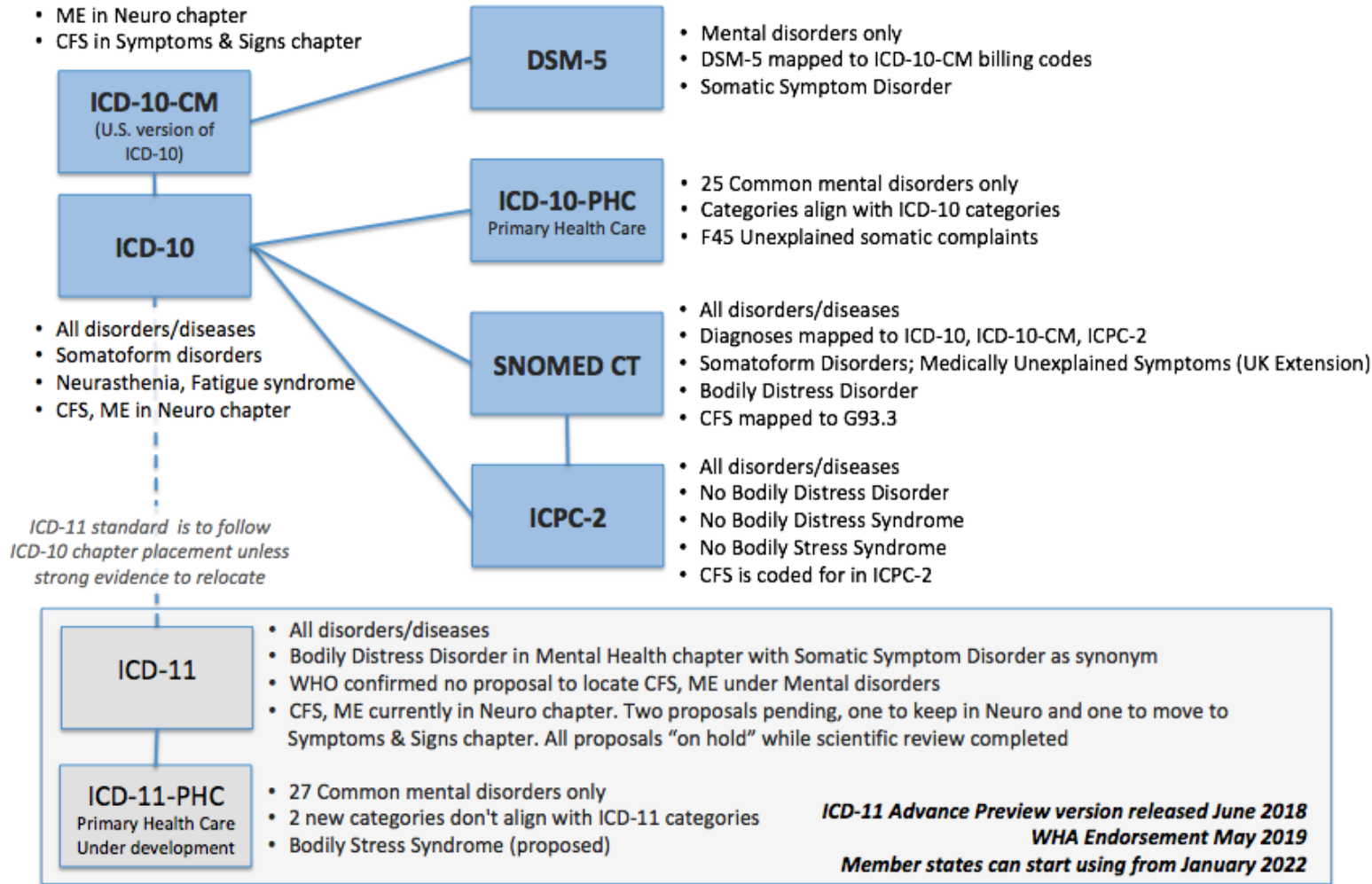

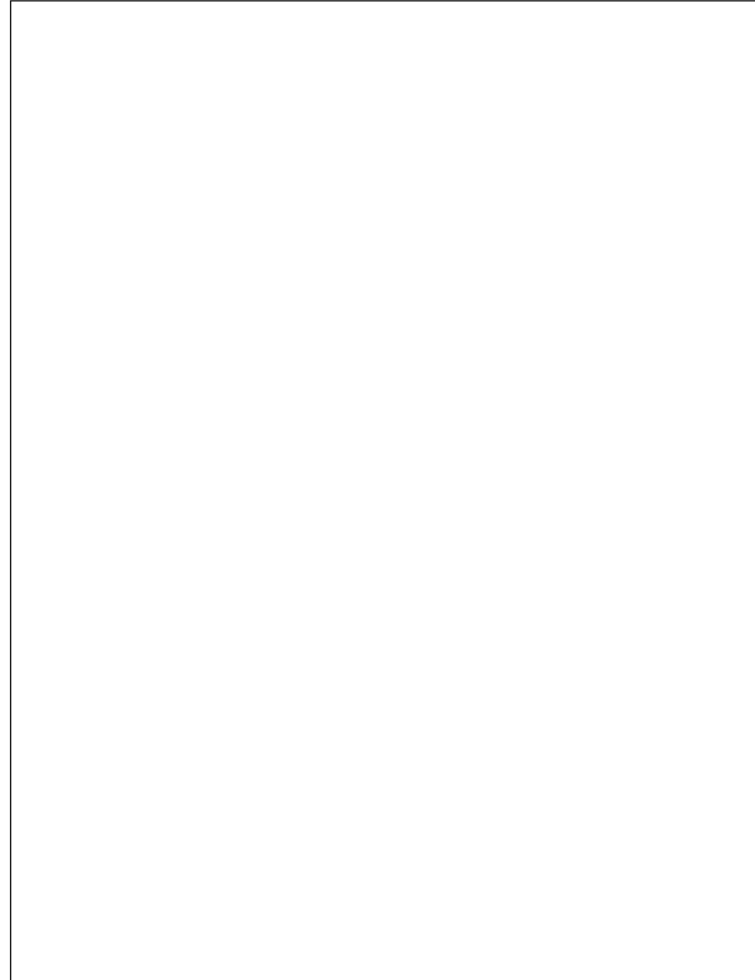
