Mid-America Pipeline Company, LLC (MAPL) is planning to construct the Western Expansion II (WEP II) loop pipeline project that will loop the existing MAPL pipeline, an approximate 96 mile long, 16-inch natural gas liquids pipeline across the eastern portions of Grand and Uintah counties, Utah.


