

PARASELLIGUEA, A NEW GENUS OF MALESIAN POLYPODIACEAE, A CORRECTION

SUMMARY

The monotypic genus *Paraselliguea*, based on *Polypodium leucophorum* Baker, is validated.

Key words: *Paraselliguea*, Polypodiaceae, Malesia.

When I transferred *Polypodium leucophorum* Baker to the new genus *Paraselliguea* (Hovenkamp, 1997), I regrettably omitted the required Latin diagnosis of that new genus (ICBN art. 36.1). The omission is here corrected.

Paraselliguea Hovenkamp, *gen. nov.*

Rhizoma longe repens sinuosa, paleis peltatis longe subulatis patenti-squarrosis rufis obtecta. Frondes 4–5 cm remotae simplices, lamina tomentosa, venis reticulatis, soris irregulariter dispersis.

Type and sole species:

Paraselliguea leucophora (Baker) Hovenkamp, *comb. nov.*

Polypodium leucophorum Baker, J. Linn. Soc. (Bot.) 22 (1886) 229. — Type: Hose 129 (holo K), Matang, Sarawak.
