


SEAGRASSES OF WEST AFRICA:

A tropical species found in sandy-muddy sediment in sheltered bays. It can be exposed during low tide and submerged in shallow areas.

SEAGRASSES OF WEST AFRICA:


Cymodocea nodosa

A Mediterranean species found in sandy sediment in sheltered bays. It is always submerged in shallow areas.


