SIDE LETTER OF AGREEMENT

Between

SAN JUAN UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (District)

and the

SAN JUAN TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (Association)

August 8, 2022

Regarding: Compensation for Missed Elementary/K-8 Preparation Time

Background: The State of California continues to experience a teacher shortage, which in turn, directly affects the number of substitute teachers available. As a result, some teachers are losing their contractual preparation time.

Intent: The intent of this Side Letter of Agreement between the District and the Association is to provide compensation for lost elementary/K-8 preparation time to any certificated member who covers a class or loses preparation time due to a lack of a substitute.

Agreement: The District and the Association hereby agree to the following:

- Any missed preparation time will be made up within 30 days of the missed date.
- At the time the preparation time is missed, the teacher can decide to either be paid or have an equal amount of make-up preparation time provided.
 - If the choice is made to be paid, it is immediate, e.g., the teacher does not have to wait 30 days to try to have the make-up preparation time provided.
 - Missed preparation time will be compensated at a rate of \$15 for every 15 minute increment (in addition to their regular pay).
 - If the teacher chooses a make-up preparation time, and if after 30 days the make-up has not occurred, the default is pay at the rate referenced above.

This Side Letter of Agreement is non-precedential, effective August 11, 2022 through June 30, 2023. The parties may extend the letter an additional year by mutual agreement.
