Use the following menu path(s) to begin this task:

SAP Easy Access

- Select *SAP menu* → *Logistics* → *Logistics Execution* → *Master Data* → *Warehouse* → *Storage Bin* → *Create* → *LS01N - Manually*
- Select *SAP menu* → *Logistics* → *Logistics Execution* → *Master Data* → *Warehouse* → *Storage Bin* → *Change* → *LS02N – Single Bin*
- Select *SAP menu* → *Logistics* → *Logistics Execution* → *Master Data* → *Warehouse* → *Storage Bin* → *LS03N - Manually*

Transaction Code

- **LS01N = Create**
- **LS02N = Change**
- **LS02N = Display**

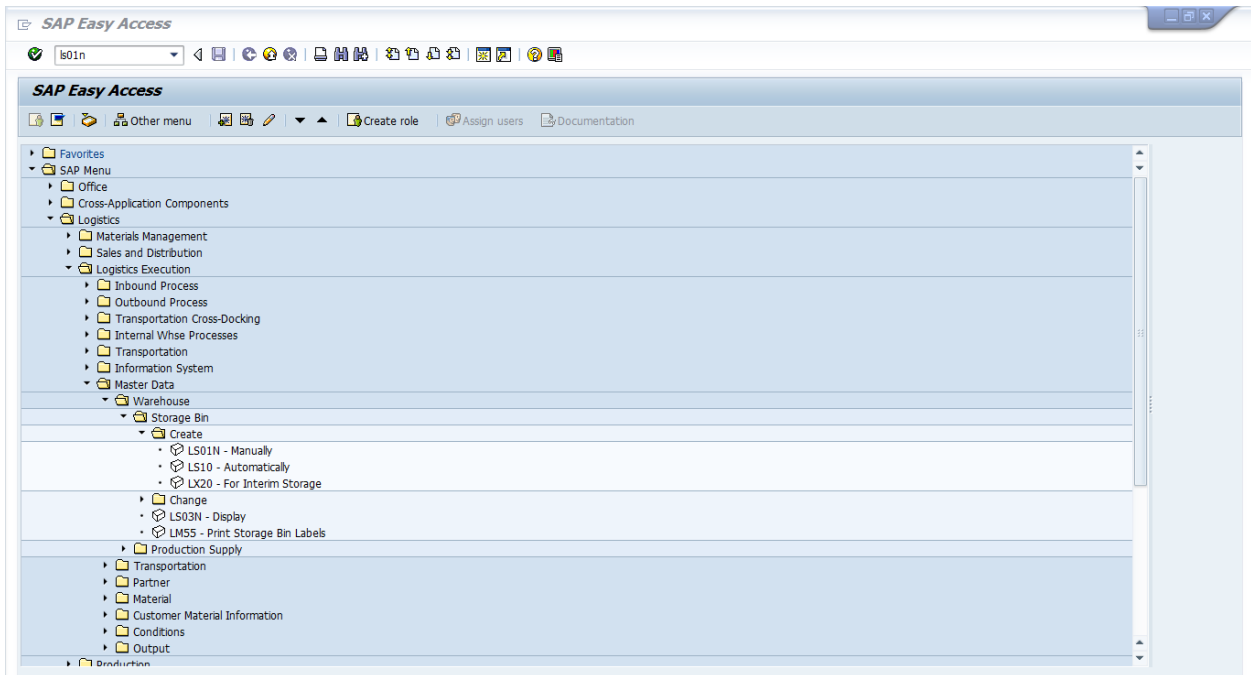
Helpful Hints

- The **R/O/C** column in the field description tables below defines whether the field is (R) required, (O) optional, (C) or conditional.

Procedure

1. Start the task using the menu path or enter the transaction code into the command field

Create Storage Bin

3. As required, complete/review the following fields:

Field Name	R/O/C	Description
Warehouse number	R	<p>Unique number identifying a warehouse</p> <p> Enter the warehouse number</p> <p>Example: U10</p>
Storage Type	R	<p>Description of the Storage Type within the warehouse.</p> <p> Note: Here you can enter a storage type or a range. Or you can leave blank and all will display</p> <p>Example: 340</p>
Storage bin	O	<p>Description of the Storage bin within a storage type.</p> <p> Note: Here you can enter a storage bin or a range of bins. Or you can leave blank and all bins will display</p> <p>Example: D101B</p>

4. Click Enter  to continue.
