Our trail networks offer something for every ability level, whether on foot or a bicycle. Up for a challenge? Check out mountain bike trails, or world-class rock climbing. There is an exhilarating zipline across the gorge, plus classic and extreme courses above treetops and canyons.

Don't forget to visit the region's museums, history and heritage sites. Downtown Cañon City and Florence are both hidden gems offering quaint, locally-owned shops, farmers' markets, restaurants, breweries, and annual festivals. Learn about dinosaurs that roamed this land 150 million years ago through outstanding indoor and outdoor exhibits and interpretive trails. A series of self-guided heritage tours are a helpful resource for further discovery, with ideas on other activities you can enjoy for free.

Plan more than a day to experience all the Royal Gorge Region has to offer. We recommend you spend at least a night, or more. # Four Seasons of Fremont County

The Royal Gorge Region enjoys a south-central Colorado sweet spot where mild temperatures grace the Arkansas River Valley and form an ideal year-round outdoor playground.

When the rest of the state is digging out from **Spring** snowstorms, area locals and visitors are hitting mountain biking and hiking trails. This is also a great time to visit museums and attractions like the Royal Gorge Dinosaur Experience and the Museum of Colorado Prisons. Get a jump on summer travelers and hit the Royal Gorge Bridge and Park to walk across one of the highest suspension bridges in the world, zipline over the canyon and brave the exhilarating Royal Rush Skycoaster.

**Summer** heats up with area outfitters launching boats into the Arkansas River for world-class whitewater rafting and kayaking. Hikers and bikers take to Skyline Drive and Cañon City's Royal Gorge Park trails, ATV and Jeep tours explore endless open space. See the valley's beauty from above on a helicopter or horseback tour.

As **Fall** rolls around, the desert-meets-mountain landscape radiates in reds, yellows and oranges. Autumn is the perfect time for a family stroll along the Arkansas Riverwalk Trail, antique shopping in Florence and wine tasting at the award-winning winery. In September, the Harvest Festival celebrates the region's rich agricultural heritage. Take a drive on the picturesque Gold Belt National Scenic Byway and cruise high above Cañon City on Skyline Drive's cliff-side razorback ridge.

Resting at 5,332 feet—slightly higher than Denver—and tucked into the valley's protective bluffs, **Winter** in the Region tends to hover around a comfortable 50 to 60 degrees. Conditions remain ideal for flyfishing, hunting, hiking, biking, rock climbing, golfing and even the occasional camping expedition. Though it operates year-round, the historic Royal Gorge Route Railroad's winter themed rides are a season must.

## St. Thomas More Hospital



St. Thomas More Hospital is the Royal Gorge Region's connection to quality health and wellness services. We offer 24-hour emergency/trauma services, Centura Health Urgent Care Cañon City, The Birth Place and more.

Particularly during peak travel season, we treat illnesses and injuries that people experience during outdoor recreational activities. For your safety and preparation, we encourage you to carry your medication list, emergency contact information, and a first-aid kit with you. Here are some additional tips:

#### HEAT EXHAUSTION/STROKE

Dress in layers for varying weather; wear sunglasses, sunscreen. If you feel fatigue, nausea, headache, excessive thirst, rapid heartbeat, muscle cramps, etc., get to air conditioning/shady area, rest, drink water, apply ice towels. Get medical care immediately; delay of severe cases can be fatal.

#### SNAKE BITES

The hospital carries anti-venom medication. Get medical care immediately; delay could lead to loss of limb or death.

#### ALTITUDE SICKNESS

For headache, no appetite, nausea/vomiting, weakness, dizziness, etc., go to lower altitude, rest, drink water, and take medication for headache. If symptoms worsen, get medical care immediately.

#### ORTHOPEDIC INJURY

For foot/ankle injury, use shoe as stabilizer; for broken bones, stabilize, ice, elevate; take anti-inflammatory medication; needs timely evaluation. If open fracture, get medical care immediately to avoid infection.

#### FR OR URGENT CARE?

If symptoms are sudden, serious and/or life-threatening, visit the St. Thomas More Emergency Room. Examples: difficulty breathing, chest pain/pressure, fainting/dizziness, sudden/ severe pain, uncontrolled bleeding, severe/persistent vomiting/diarrhea, difficulty speaking.

For minor injuries or illnesses that require attention but do not suggest an immediate threat to your health or life, consider Centura Health Urgent Care Cañon City. Examples: minor injuries/lacerations, eye discomfort/redness, minor fractures/sprains, urinary symptoms, coughs/colds, fever, flu, sore throat, skin rashes/infections.

# Royal Gorge Bridge & Park

The Royal Gorge Bridge & Park, one of Colorado's iconic and must-see attractions is the heart of the Royal Gorge Region. Open 365 days a year, adventure begins 10 miles west of Cañon City with a walk across one of the world's highest suspension bridges.

The park has a rich history of spectacular undertakings including the initial building of the Royal Gorge Bridge in 1929. Holding the title of the world's highest suspension bridge for over 7 decades, the bridge is the highest in America. In 2013 a wildfire destroyed 90 percent of the park which was rebuilt in only 14 months. The Bridge was minimally damaged and remained "standing tall" among the rubble.

Upon entrance to the park, guests are treated to the timeless beauty of the area with the new Visitor Center and its mammoth deck overlooking the gorge. This is the perfect place to shop, dine, or just relax and enjoy the surroundings. Café 1230, sitting 1,230 feet above the Arkansas River provides breathtaking views while enjoying a scrumptious meal, snack, or favorite brew.

World class attractions include gondolas traversing 2,400 feet across the gorge. Tommy Knockerland, a children's play land, features a beautifully crafted carousel and climbing structures. Kids will enjoy the splash pad, wax hand store and gold panning during the summer months. Be sure to visit the park's Plaza Theater and Historical Expo to view the history of the park and area.

For the daring, the Royal Gorge Cloudscraper by ZipRider flies guests a thousand feet over the river, or patrons can experience the World's Scariest Skycoaster sitting on the very edge of the gorge. Both are extra pay features and open mid-March to end of December (weather permitting.)

Entertainment abounds during the summer months where guests can enjoy bands and shows from Native American Dancers to top Recording Artists at the Elk Park Amphitheater, Bridge View Bandstand, and at the Visitor Center. Thanksgiving and Christmas are special times of the year and the park is open for your Holiday entertainment.

Stay tuned for a special Celebration in 2019 when the Park turns 90!

# Guided Jeep Tours Across the Royal Gorge Bridge

Enjoy the scenery and see places you can't access on your own while visiting the Royal Gorge with Colorado Jeep Tours, located in Cañon City just 10 miles east of the gorge. This is the only company that offers guided tours of the region, driving along the southern rim of the park and over the spectacular 2,400 foot long suspension bridge, normally reserved for pedestrians only.

These off-road jeep tours range from 3 hours to all day, and can be enjoyed by people of nearly any age or ability. Have a young one? No problem. Bring along a car seat and secure your child like you do in your own vehicle. Have a dog? Good-natured and well-socialized dogs can come along for the ride. Have mobility issues? Their well-trained guides will make every effort to help you into the Jeep, and insure your comfort and safety along the route.

Once seated in your covered, open-air Jeep with padded seats, you can sit back and relax. All Colorado Jeep Tours adventures are driven by professional and informative guides, so you're free to focus on the scenery, take pictures, and make memories with your family. Because the custom Jeeps hold up to 10 people, large families can enjoy the experience more by riding together.



Shop and sightsee, collect amazing antiques and delve into the countryside at a family-run orchard, pumpkin patch or corn maze. Drive the scenic **Gold Belt Tour**, walk discovery trails and search for fossils or have a relaxing picnic by the river.

Outdoor excursions span mellow to extreme. **Hike** at your own pace, take a **guided fishing** or hunting trip and see it all on a Jeep tour, guided horseback tour or an ATV tour through the Arkansas River Valley. Segway and helicopter tours are also ready for your next adventure.

# WHITEWATER KAYAK & RECREATION PARK



# Hiking & Biking the Royal Gorge Region

Add some adventure to your visit by checking out one - or a few! - of the Royal Gorge Region's trails. Offering something for every ability level, the region continues to add miles of new trails each year. Stunning views, wildflowers, and unique geology are ready to greet you on your trail adventure!

#### ROYAL GORGE PARK:

The Royal Gorge Park trails wind through piñon and juniper trees throughout the area, boasting trails from relatively easy to advanced. The Canyon Rim Trail offers up breathtaking views of the gorge, but be aware of exposed areas as you make your way along the trail. Other area trails are generally of intermediate difficulty as they meander throughout the park, and even connect with the Cañon City East Ridge Campground.

#### ARKANSAS RIVERWALK TRAIL:

The Riverwalk Trail runs through some of the most scenic parts of Cañon City. Along the 7-mile stretch of trail, you'll track the river's course through the city, passing historic properties, open farmland, cottonwood groves, and city parks. The Riverwalk Trail is mostly a flat, wide maintained trail that is open during all seasons; perfect for families and cruiser bike rides!

#### OIL WELL FLATS:

One of the most popular and extensive trail systems in the area, Oil Well Flats offers up about 12 miles of singletrack trails. Cruise through high desert as you ascend the Unconformity or Fire Canyon trails toward the high point of Island in the Sky for spectacular views of Cañon City and beyond to the Wet Mountains and the Sangre de Cristo range.

# ATV/Four-Wheeling

The Royal Gorge Region has some of the best trails in Colorado for ATV and 4-wheel fun at the Texas Creek Recreation Area. Detailed maps are available at Cañon City Chamber of Commerce, and the Visitors Center Cabin.

Clearance varies on these routes, and the network links some ATV sections with 4-wheel drive. There are miles and miles of trails and tracks. Among the most popular 4-wheel drive routes are Bull Gulch (606), Fremont County Road 27 (27), Fernleaf Gulch Connector (6020) and Reese Gulch Bypass (6024). Popular with ATVers are East Arkansas River Overlook (6025), Cut Off (6036) and Tucker Trail (6035).

Always consult maps, check weather forecast in advance; and be aware of the BLM regulations.

The Royal Gorge Region also has several guide services – a great idea for novice riders or folks unfamiliar with Rocky Mountain terrain. Visit the combined BLM/USFS regional office at 3028 E. Main Street, Cañon City for regulations, trail maps and other outdoor recreation information.

## **Rock Climbing**

The Royal Gorge Region is no stranger to rock climbing. Boasting one of Colorado's largest sport climbing destinations, Shelf Road, the region is a year-round destination for rock climbers. With a wealth of cliff options at Shelf Road, you will find plenty of sunny or shady climbing areas at most of the climbing sites. The lesser-known but still aweinspiring Tanner Dome offers adventurers single and multi-pitch climbs as well as sport and traditional/mixed routes. You'll find the climbing area by heading south on Oak Creek Grade Road, and approach via the East Bear Gulch Trail. Please note: The Tanner Dome area is closed to climbing from April 1st to August 1st for peregrine falcon nesting.



# Skyline Drive

Travel this one-way ridgetop for sweeping Royal Gorge Region vistas, spectacular geological wonders and along the way discover our unearthed dinosaur trackway.

#### THE HISTORY

During the early 1900s, local leaders devised a plan to build a road over the sharp Hogback west of Cañon City. The unprecedented scenic thoroughfare would gift visitors and residents dramatic Colorado views and allow them to practically touch the sky.

In 1905, around 60 inmates from the Colorado State Penitentiary were assigned to construct Skyline Drive. They finished in 1906 and the city council named designated vehicle days and horse-drawn carriage days to avoid conflicts along the narrow route.

#### THE GEOLOGY

Deposited sand and mud flowing in from the ancestral Rocky Mountains about 105 million years ago formed what is now known as the Dakota Hogback formation. View layers of red rock along the base of the ridge, dubbed the Fountain Formation by geologists, and see where dinosaur fossils were found in the Morrison Formation.

#### THE DRIVE

Skyline Drive is paved and lies northwest of Cañon City. It travels along a narrow razorback ridge for a few miles until reaching the end of the ridge. The descent begins with a hairpin turn and winds down the eastern side of the hogback. Not for the timid driver, there are points where both sides of the roadway drop several hundred feet.

Directions: Head west of Cañon City on Highway 50 for two miles and turn right at the entrance to Skyline Drive. Take note of vehicle length restrictions.

#### SIGHTS ALONG THE WAY

Plenty of pullouts and parking areas make it easy to stop and enjoy the views overlooking Cañon City, Florence, Fremont Peak and the surrounding landscape. Stop to see the Gateway Arch, an entrance marker built by inmates in 1932 using a stone from every state in the union.

Pull over near the top to view the interpretive display on the dinosaur footprint casts embedded in the cliff face. Local resident and paleontology student Bill Kurtz discovered the dinosaur trackway in 1999. Allow about one hour to explore Skyline Drive. The road is open daily during daylight hours and may close for inclement weather.

# Geology: Dinosaur & Fossil Finds

View prehistoric tracks, walk discovery trails, search for fossils (never disturb or remove fossils) or visit the Royal Gorge Regional History Museum to see an outstanding display of fossils, dinosaur bones, and a complete Stegosaurus replica skeleton displayed as it was found in the ground in 1992.

#### GARDEN PARK FOSSIL AREA

Garden Park Fossil Area, located just north of Cañon City on Red Canyon Road, is a 3,600-acre area that has been producing significant dinosaur fossils for nearly 125 years. Most of the Jurassic dinosaurs on display at Smithsonian's Museum of Natural History are from this area. Three stegosaurus skeletons, including Colorado's state fossil, were excavated here.

#### INDIAN SPRINGS TRACE FOSSIL SITE

The privately owned Indian Springs Trace Fossil Site is also designated by the National Park Service as a National Natural Landmark. Located just east of Cañon City on the private Thorson Family Ranch, the National Park Service designated it as a National Natural Landmark due to the importance of the Ordovician Period (485 to 443 million years ago) trace fossils found there. These trace fossils include tracks left by trilobites, fish and other prehistoric creatures along the wet shoreline of an ancient ocean. Indian Springs is considered the best locality to study Ordovician Period trace fossils in North America because of the excellent preservation and wide variety of ichnospecies, or types of trace fossils, found there.

#### ROYAL GORGE DINOSAUR EXPERIENCE

Home to a world-class collection of interactive displays, full-scale dinosaur fossil casts, real dinosaur fossils, entertaining guided tours of the exhibit halls, and outdoor animatronic dinosaur exhibits. Leave knowing a lot more about Colorado's paleontological history while also creating indelible memories of a great time spent learning, discovering and having fun with friends and family.

# Fishing, Wildlife & Bird Watching

The Royal Gorge Region and its lands are home to an amazing variety of wildlife viewing opportunities. Keep your eyes open for **deer, bighorn sheep, bear, eagles** and other birds of prey.

Grab your binoculars and a field guide for some of the best bird watching in Colorado. Bird watchers will want to check out the large blue heron populations along County Road 69 and also along the Arkansas River. Buntings, Eagles, Kittiwakes, Goshawk, Kestrel, Woodpeckers, and Yellowthroat are also common in the region.

**Cañon City's Riverwalk Trail** follows the Arkansas River for more than seven miles, winding through wetlands, groves of cottonwoods and the parks. An early evening stroll along the Riverwalk Trail provides great opportunities for bird watching and wildlife spotting.

#### LEGENDARY FISHING

The Arkansas River, with its **Gold Medal fishing** waters, is legendary and attracts anglers year-round from all over the United States. The Brown Trout population in this river is second to none and makes up the vast majority of catches, **Rainbows** and even an occasional **Cutthroat** are also found in some parts of the river.

Fly fishers are typically out year-round, but especially around the first week of May. During this time, one of the most intense **Caddis hatches** in all of the United States occurs between Cañon City and Salida. Savvy fly fishers know that some of the best dry fly fishing happens from mid-summer through the fall with grasshopper imitations.

#### RIVER RECREATION

Rafts and kayaks of every size float the beautiful **Arkansas River** from spring through summer and even into early fall. Some anglers fish from rafts and enjoy a thrilling ride through the rapids from Texas Creek to Parkdale and even through the gorge! A recreational raft trip is a good way to enjoy the river when the flows may be too swift for quality fishing. Check with local outfitters for guided fishing or rafting trips on the Arkansas River.


# Agricultural Heritage & Agritourism

The oldest orchards in Colorado are here! The first apple trees (brought across the Great Plains in oxcarts) were planted in the Florence area by Jesse Frazer in the late 1860's and later by Italian families, along with grapes in Spring Creek/Brookside area. The Arkansas River and its streams were the source of early irrigation works and the area's elevation, climate, sheltering hills and tillable soil provided a good setting for orchards, farms and ranches.

**Initial markets** for Fremont County's agricultural products included early Colorado mining camps, such as Cripple Creek and Leadville, for fresh fruit, vegetables, dairy products, meat and other provisions. By 1888 total fruit shipments from Fremont County were over 700,000 pounds of primarily apples but also including pears, grapes, plums, peaches, strawberries and other berries. Fremont County's 40,000 bushels of apples, compare to that year's production of 60,000 bushels for the entire state!

**Private investment** stimulated the development of the agricultural industry, providing irrigation canals, storage reservoirs, and land preparation. By 1893 over 45,000 acres of land was in agricultural production. Irrigation was provided by 13 canals from the Arkansas River, Grape Creek, etc. Businessmen, schoolteachers and other residents had small orchards or gardens producing fruit, berries and other crops for seasonal sale as supplemental income. Italian workers enjoyed a taste of their home country thru wine from grapevines they grew as a family tradition.

Associated enterprises like packing houses, flour mills, an ice plant, a Libby-McNeil-Libby pickle plant, cider mills, a creamery, soda bottling companies prospered. In 1905, Armour & Company of Chicago marketed Fremont County fruit and produce in major cities from Coast-to-Coast as part of their extensive distribution network. An average of 800 rail cars (some refrigerated) per year of agricultural products were shipped to market.



### Arts & Culture

First-time visitors are immediately struck by the mild climate and the breathtaking natural beauty of the Royal Gorge Region, but often it's the rich artistic expression and cultural diversity that brings people back.

#### LIVE THEATER

Musical and theater offerings are varied – from lavish stage productions presented by the Fremont Civic Theatre to solo and ensemble chamber recitals at the Fremont Center for the Arts and summerlong outdoor pop/jazz/bluegrass/eclectic musical performances in the park. In Florence, the Bell Tower presents varied concerts monthly. The historic Rialto Theater hosts periodic, and varied events throughout the year.

#### **PUBLIC ART**

Public art in the Royal Gorge Region is on display in downtown Cañon City. Macon Plaza, the pedestrianonly area on Macon Street between Fifth and Sixth Streets in front of the Fremont Center for the Arts includes a Sculpture Garden across from the newly restored Carnegie Library. Along Main Street you'll find over a dozen changing displays. The Florence Art Council has purchased and placed art throughout the downtown as well.

The Royal Gorge Regional Museum & History Center is the premier research facility for local historical information for Fremont County and the surrounding Royal Gorge Region. We are located in downtown Cañon City at 612 Royal Gorge Blvd., in the historic Municipal Building. Our Research Room has family and address files for a number of local residents, businesses, and homes. We also have other research materials such as historical photographs, local newspapers on microfilm, and area maps.

The museum is primarily located on the second floor of the historic Municipal Building with three separate galleries showcasing locally-found fossils, local artists and rotating exhibits like the current "Around the World in 80 Artifacts" exhibit. To round out the museum tour, 1860's Anson Rudd pioneer family cabin, the oldest residential structure in Cañon City, is open for visits behind the museum, weather permitting.

#### THE FREMONT CENTER FOR THE ARTS

The Fremont Center for the Arts (FCA) was founded in 1947 and has the distinction of being the oldest privately-run art center West of the Mississippi River. We are located in the heart of downtown Cañon City in the former 1931 Post Office building, which is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

Our mission is to foster and enrich the cultural and economic health for the greater Fremont County region through partnerships, presentations, education, and preservation of the arts for present and future generations.

We offer interactive classes on subjects from figure drawing, creative writing, portraiture, matting and framing, ceramics, dance, and more.


Each month the main gallery show changes, offering artists of all levels an opportunity to display their works. Our permanent collection started in 1947 and continues today with over 300 fabulous pieces. The collection is constantly rotated throughout the building and speaks to the art culture of Fremont County.

#### MUSEUM OF COLORADO PRISONS

The Museum of Colorado Prisons is quite unique, located next door to the Colorado Territorial Correctional Facility, an operational prison which opened in 1871. The Museum of Colorado Prisons houses no inmates within its walls. Instead, the former Women's Correctional Facility contains 30plus cells, each transformed into exhibits covering more than 140 years of the state's incarceration history. Displays encompass everything from confiscated contraband, inmate arts and crafts, original artifacts, and thousands of inmate records. Besides the audio tour or self-guided tour booklets (available in 4 languages), the museum invites visitors to participate in occasional events every year, such as nighttime ghost-hunting expeditions. Make the time to do time with us.

# Self-Guided Heritage Tours

# WALKING, BIKING, DRIVING OR ARMCHAIR EXPERIENCES

The Royal Gorge Region's rich history and diverse natural heritage come alive in this series of Heritage Guides. Printed Guides are available at area museums, chambers of commerce and visitor destinations. The guides may also be downloaded at www.fremontheritage.com or follow the link.

**DOWNTOWN CAÑON CITY:** Dating back to the 1860s, the Downtown Historic District is compact and walkable. Listed in the National Register of Historic Places, it includes 280 acres and 80 buildings. Allow about three hours to enjoy a stroll down Main Street, take in the history of 36 buildings and visit the many shops and restaurants.

**DOWNTOWN FLORENCE:** The recently designated Downtown Florence Historic District includes about 10 blocks along Main and Front Streets, and 52 buildings. The walkable tour describes 21 buildings and takes about two hours. Enjoy the many antique shops and wonderful restaurants that now occupy this charming town; whose booming 1920s economy was built on oil wells, coal mines and ore processing.

**SKYLINE DRIVE:** The entrance to this 2.8-mile scenic drive is located two miles west of Cañon City on US-50 and begins with an archway built in 1932 with stones from many states. A dinosaur track lay along the one-way drive along with turnouts for dramatic views. This is also an enjoyable hike that begins at the foot of the drive where interpretive signs are located near the Floral Street Trailhead.

**WESTERN FREMONT COUNTY:** This 50-mile scenic drive along the Arkansas River on US-50 between Cañon City and Salida explores area history and early economic activity with 37 stops of interest.

**HISTORIC HOWARD:** Near the county's western border, Howard (est. 1871) was an important railroad shipping point. This 18-stop tour takes in the town square amoung other historical sites.

**CEMETERIES OF FREMONT COUNTY:** This 74-page guide includes nearly 20 cemeteries that reflect area history.

**COAL CAMPS OF FREMONT COUNTY:** This 86-page guide provides the history of the towns and coal camps that grew to support the Cañon City Coal Field, one of Colorado's earliest.



# Western Fremont County

#### **PARKDALE**

Parkdale's prime location on the Arkansas River and near the Royal Gorge makes it a popular base camp for visitors. The area is the gateway to whitewater rafting and Bighorn Sheep Canyon.

#### **BIGHORN SHEEP CANYON**

Long known as a gateway into the Rockies, Highway 50 (once known as the Rainbow Route) runs west through the towering rock walls of the Arkansas River Canyon. This beautiful canyon is dubbed "Bighorn Sheep Canyon" and hosts a thriving population of Rocky Mountain Bighorn Sheep, Colorado's state mammal. These majestic animals are often seen on both sides of the river throughout the canyon. The Arkansas River Headwaters Recreation Area is a Colorado State Park running through the Bighorn Sheep Canyon with several recreational sites. These sites host restrooms, river access for rafting, fishing, picnicking, wildlife observation, camping, and interpretative signs of the area. (cpw.state.co.us/placestogo/Parks/ ArkansasHeadwatersRecreationArea)

#### TEXAS CREEK

Named for the Texas cattle driven through the area, this fly-fishing, ATV, and camping hotspot is loaded with scenic vistas and wildlife viewing opportunities. Highway 69 south at Texas Creek takes you to Hillside and the beautiful Wet Mountain Valley and fantastic views of the Sangre de Cristo Mountains, one of the most beautiful in all of Colorado.

#### COTOPAXI

This quaint community was once a railroad stop and well known for the Russian Jewish Agricultural Colony that settled here in 1882. A small fenced section of Russian Jewish graves remains in the cemetery behind the Cotopaxi School (Est. 1870s).

#### HILLSIDE

Roughly 100 people call Hillside home. It is situated between Westcliffe and Cotopaxi; a tight-knit farming community that has never had a mayor, town hall or city council.

#### COALDALE

A bustling mining town and popular touring stop for opera stars in the late 1800's, Coaldale is surrounded by towering peaks and is known for its secluded camping opportunities. Head south on Hayden Creek Road to see some of the last remaining charcoal kilns in Colorado. Charcoal production was a major industry in the early 1900s, producing charcoal for area smelters and railroads.

#### VALLIE BRIDGE


A river access and camping area is also the start of the Pathway into History interpretive drive with signs explaining the history of the area.

#### **HOWARD**

The Arkansas River runs through this pleasant valley community, drawing rafters, kayakers, and fishermen. The beautiful forested area features horseback riding, hiking, and ATV tours. The Old Howard Church constructed in 1898 sits on the original location of the Howard town site, about a mile off of Highway 50, facing the Sangre de Cristo Mountains and the Twin Sisters peaks, named by one of the original homesteaders. Self-guided tours of the area are available at the church.

#### SHELF ROAD


North on Raynolds out of Cañon City from U.S. 50. Right on Field Ave, Field Ave, which later Ys into Red Canyon Road, and later turns into Shelf Road.

#### HIGH PARK ROAD

West of Cañon City to CO. 9. North on Hwy 9 for eight miles to High Park Road. East on High Park Road.

All roads lead to historic Cripple Creek. In its glory days Cripple Creek boasted two opera houses, 75 saloons, 8 newspapers and a stock exchange. Limited stakes gaming has revitalized the town with casinos, shops and restaurants, while maintaining its heritage. Cripple Creek even has its own donkey herd, descendants of the animals that once worked in the mines.


