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RESEARCH STATEMENT

My research is set at the intersection of (international) political sociology, political and social theory, and sociology of religion with a special expertise on Russia and Russian Orthodoxy. The focus of my publications lies on religion-state relations in Russia and Orthodox Christianity, on political liberalism, secularism and religion, on the sociology of human rights, and transnational norm mobilization. The most significant achievement in recent years was winning both an ERC Starting Grant and an FWF Start Prize for my project “Postsecular Conflicts” (2015-2022), which investigated moral conservative norm mobilization and transnational networks of right-wing actors across Russia, Europe and the United States. The resulting monograph, entitled *Moralist International. Russia in the Global Culture Wars* (co-authored with Dmitry Uzlaner), will be published with Fordham University Press in 2022.
