Project Update: October 2015

From July to October 2015 we explored areas like Goleen Gol, Chitral Gol, Laspur, Shandur, Mastuj, Garam Chasman.

Total 16 populations of endemic flora with each of Astragalus affganus, Impatiens Iemannii subsp Iemannii, Oxytropis humifusa, O. immersa var. jinaliensis, Ranunculus membranaceus, Chondrilla setlusa and Epilobium royleanum. Two for Arabis pangiensis, A. chitralensis, Delphinium chitralense. Three of Impatiens bicolor bicolor.

Seeds of narrowly endemic of *Astragalus affganus* were also collected. New populations of *Chondrilla setlusa* and *Epilobium royleanum* were also found.

Floods occurred during July-August 2015 due to melting of glacier and affect upper valleys of Chitral.
