

Augusta will celebrate its annual Heritage Days festival Labor Day weekend, in the city's downtown area and city park. This will be the 48th year for Heritage Days, following a one-year hiatus because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The festival, the oldest continuous festival in this historic river town, gets underway on Friday, Sept. 3, and runs through Sunday, Sept. 5 with a jam-packed schedule of events.

Carriage rides will be available for tours of the town and visitors will find a variety of vendors of all kinds of crafts, antiques, and food booths lining the festival area, including the world-famous Rotary Burgers from the event sponsor, the Augusta Rotary Club.

Among the entertainment and events offered up will be beauty pageants, tree climbing, a petting zoo, inflatables for kids, a baby show, art displays, sports, games, and raffles. There will also be a car show and music throughout the weekend from area musicians.

The grand finale will be the popular Frog Derby, a Heritage Days tradition.

While in Augusta, visitors will have the opportunity to see many homes that are on the National Registry of Historic Places, learn about Augusta College and the Underground Railroad, relive the Civil War Battle of Augusta, walk along Riverside Drive and have a seat at Sunset Point to watch Augusta's legendary sunsets. Guests may also want to take a ride on the Augusta Ferry to cross the Ohio River, tour the Rosemary Clooney Museum, enjoy a wine tasting at Baker-Bird Winery or bourbon tasting at Kentucky's newest distillery, all while enjoying the periodic melodious notes from the city carillon atop historic Augusta Independent School. A stop at the August Caboose provides information on the city's attractions.

The city of Augusta was named one of the must-see places in the commonwealth by the late Dr. Thomas Clark, Kentucky's most famous historian. It has been listed as one of 11 great river towns by Fox News and CNN, joining such company as New Orleans and Cincinnati, and was named one of the "10 Most Beautiful Towns in Kentucky by theculturetrip.com.




