Acadian Ambulance began operations in Louisiana on September 1, 1971, with two ambulances and eight medics covering 279 square miles of Lafayette Parish.

Today, Acadian Ambulance provides compassionate and highly skilled medical care to more than 24 million residents and covers almost 57,000 square miles in Louisiana, Mississippi, Texas and Tennessee. Our fleet of more than 620 ambulances transports 680,000 patients and travels 38 million miles each year, enough to circumnavigate the earth 4.2 times each day.

Acadian's ground operations are accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Ambulance Services (CAAS) and our air ambulance operations are accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Medical Transport Systems (CAMTS) signifying that Acadian Ambulance meets the gold standard determined by the ambulance industry. Acadian Ambulance is proud to be one of a very select few ambulance services in the nation to hold both CAAS and CAMTS accreditations.

Acadian Ambulance has been recognized as one of the nation's best emergency medical service providers. Acadian's service area features a diverse geography of rich swamps, bayous, marsh lands and vast rural areas that makes quick response by ground ambulances a difficult task. As a result, Acadian Ambulance launched Acadian Air Med in 1981. In addition, Acadian Air Med also allows Acadian Ambulance to quickly reach emergencies offshore.

By 1989, Air Med was using fixed-wing aircraft for extended emergency and non-emergency patient transports throughout Central and North America. Today, Air Med flies more first-response missions than any other air medical service in the United States from bases throughout Louisiana.

Air Med's fleet of EC-135 and 145 helicopters, Beechcraft King Air turboprops and Bombardier Learjet 45 aircraft is equipped with advanced lifesaving equipment, including blood units, and staffed by expert flight nurses, paramedics and pilots.

Acadian Air Med's operations have earned accreditation from Commission on Accreditation of Medical Transport Systems (CAMTS), which is considered the gold standard in air ambulance services. Along with Acadian Ambulance, Air Med is one of a very select few EMS services in the nation to hold both CAAS and CAMTS accreditations.



In the early 1980s, oil and gas companies working in the Gulf of Mexico called upon Acadian Ambulance to respond to offshore emergencies. Understanding the industry needs, Acadian Ambulance pioneered the placement of medics on offshore installations and adapted our services from helping injured workers to proactively preventing worker injuries.

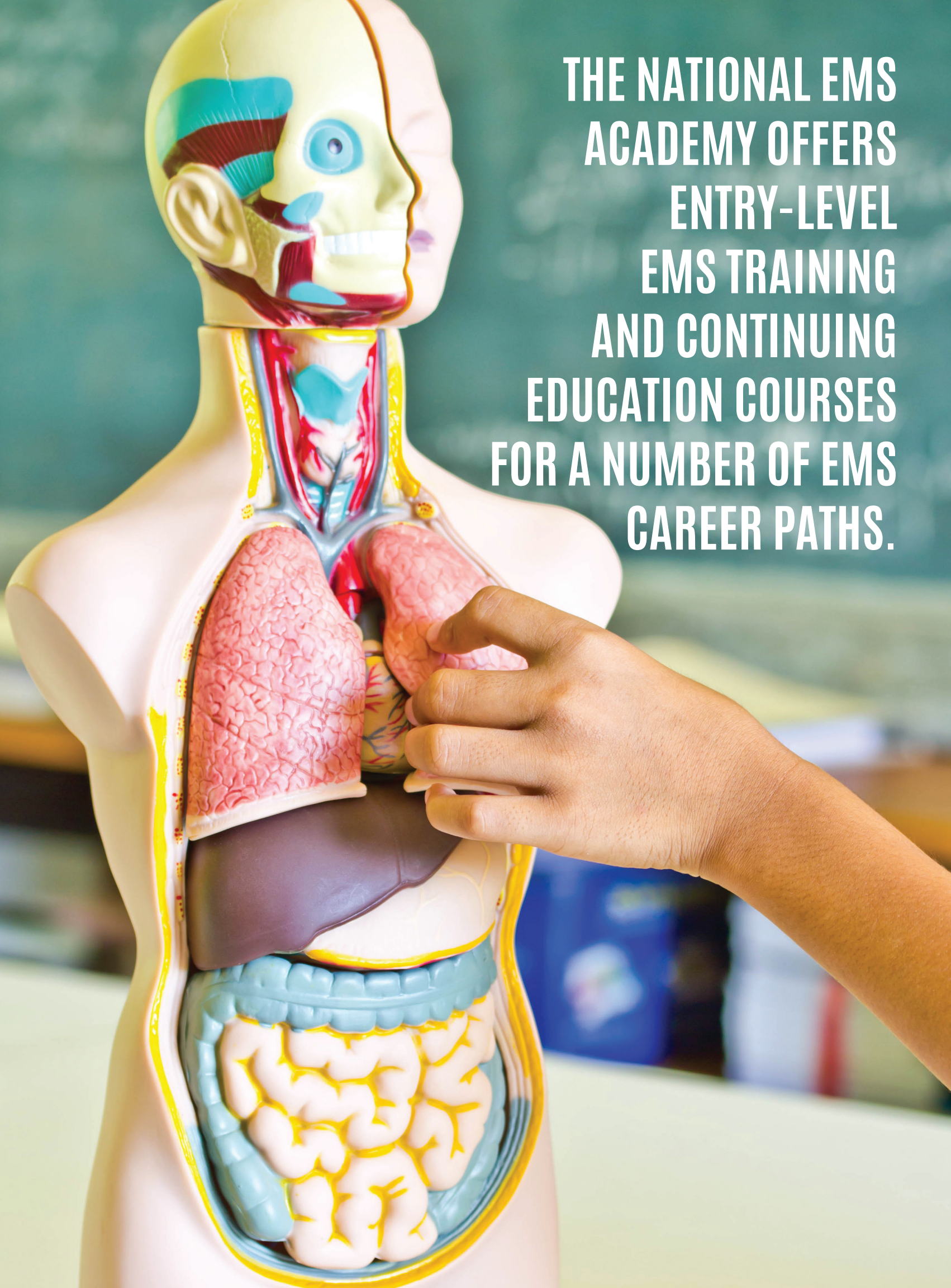

Fully accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs, the academy collaborates with South Louisiana Community College and Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service to educate EMTs and paramedics for agencies across the United States.

The National EMS Academy offers entry-level, continuing education and refresher courses for a number of EMS career paths. Hybrid EMT and paramedic programs combine online instruction and exams and in-person skills training, allowing students to have more flexibility in pursuing their goals.

As an authorized American Heart Association training center, the academy provides CPR and emergency cardiovascular care courses year-round.

Acadian Total Security operates a network of three highly sophisticated, bi-directionally redundant call centers with highly trained dispatchers. The Acadian Total Security monitoring centers are The Monitoring Association 5-Diamond certified and UL listed, setting a standard in the security monitoring industry.

In 2014, Acadian expanded to include retail equipment sales and installation for business and residential customers. The company provides fire and security systems, home automation devices, audio and video equipment and services, personal medical alert systems, video security surveillance and monitoring, thermal imaging and temperature screening, access control systems and GPS fleet management.

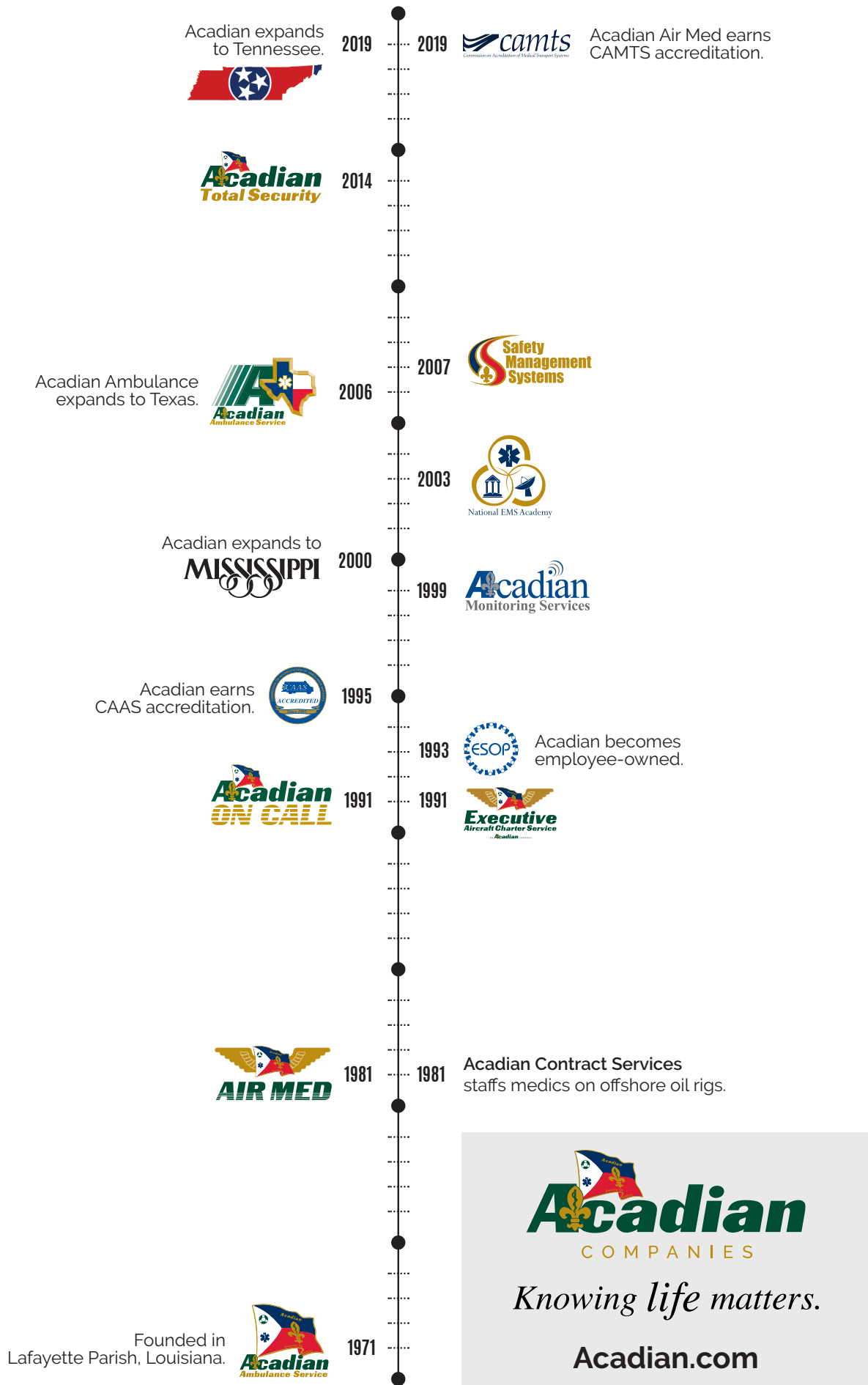
