HEAD COACH NEIL JONES SEVENTH YEAR UC SANTA BARBARA, 2004

- + Jones enters his seventh season as the head coach of the Loyola men's soccer team, owning a 55-40-18 career overall record and 18-13-9 in MVC play.
- + Under Jones' tutelage, the 2018 Ramblers won 10 matches to mark the third time in the last four years Jones' squad cracked double-digits in the win column. The Ramblers finished as the No. 2 seed in the MVC Tournament to mark the second highest regular season finish in Jones' tenure. Due to the success on the field, many of his players were recognized as All-MVC selections, such as Grant Stoneman and Josh Lagudah taking home Defensive Player of the Year and Goalkeeper of the Year respectively. His group of student-athletes continued the track record of exceptional work in the classroom, highlighted by the United Soccer Coaches Team Academic Award, as well as Marius Kullmann taking home numerous academic honors.
- + Loyola battled its way to a 7-8-3 record in 2017, Jones' fifth year in Rogers Park. The Maroon & Gold recorded impressive road wins over Xavier and Missouri Valley Conference regular-season champion Missouri State. Five Ramblers earned All-Missouri Valley Conference accolades, a quintet that was highlighted by the First Team trio of Elliot Collier, Kyle Thomson and Grant Stoneman. Collier went on to become the first Rambler in program history to be selected in the Major League Soccer (MLS) SuperDraft after being taken in the third round by the Chicago Fire. Jones' group also continued to excel off the field, collecting the United Soccer Coaches Team Academic Award for a seventh-straight season.
- + Guided the 2016 team to a final record of 14-4-1, setting a single-season school record for wins, en route to winning their first NCAA Tournament game in program history and securing the University's first Missouri Valley Conference regular-season title in any sport.
- +Spent three seasons as Northwestern's Associate Head Coach (2010-12), helping the Wildcats to back-to-back Big Ten Conference titles and NCAA Tournament appearances during his stay in Evanston, III.
- + Contributed to UC Santa Barbara winning the 2006 national championship as an assistant coach for the Gauchos.
- + As a student-athlete at UCSB, Jones was a four-year starter and two-time team captain for a program that finished as the 2004 NCAA Runner-Up after falling to Indiana University on penalty kicks. A two-time All-Big West Conference selection, the center back/striker, who racked up 28 goals and 16 assists in his career, was a Academic All-American and was tabbed 2003 Big West Scholar-Athlete of the Year.
- + Coached 12 All-MVC selections at Loyola, including one Player of the Year, one Defensive Player of the Year, one Freshman of the Year and two Goalkeepers of the Year.

- + The 2008 MLS Draftee enters his first season on the Loyola men's soccer coaching staff after most recently working as the head coach for the Chicago FC United of the United Soccer Leagues' (USL) League Two. In 2018, the team captured the central conference championship and advanced to the league semifinal under his tutelage. Four MLS SuperDraft selections played for Bode, including former Rambler captain Grant Stoneman.
- + In March 2019, Bode coached the U14 Youth National Team at a camp held in Frisco, Texas.
- + Bode also spent a season at Brown University as an Assistant Coach. During that campaign, he played a key role in the development of six student-athletes that earned All-Ivy League selections.
- + Prior to Brown, he spent eight seasons as an assistant coach at Marquette, where he was named to the CollegeSoccerNews.com's Top Assistant Coaches list during his tenure with the Golden Eagles. While there, he coached three MU student-athletes that were drafted to the MLS in 2015, including the program's highest ever selection at No. 14 overall. Bode assisted in the development of 10 players that signed professional contracts, including four MLS draft selections.

- + Pinto enters his first season with Loyola fresh off a one-year stint with a UNCW team that qualified for the 2018 NCAA Tournament with a 12-5-3 record. Under his guidance, the Seahawks finished 18th nationally in team goals against per game and 19th nationally in team save percentage. Pinto also coached goalkeeper Ryan Cretens to a Second Team All-CAA honor.
- + Pinto's first job out of college was spending the 2017 season at Stetson University in DeLand, Florida. He helped the Hatters post a 7-7-2 record and capture the Atlantic Sun Conference regular season championship. He coached the conference's Goalkeeper of the Year in Joseph Melong and A-Sun Freshman of the Year Deniz Dogan as the Hatters finished conference play unbeaten at a 4-0-2 clip.
- + Pinto was also a member of the coaching staff at GPS Florida, serving as the Director of Goalkeeping while acting as the head coach for the U-12 GPS Florida Select I team.

VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH MARTIN ALBA FIRST YEAR MARQUETTE, 2019

- + Alba enters his first season with the program following a four-year playing career at Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wis. where he started in 37 of his 46 appearances for the Golden Eagles. As a senior, Alba appeared in a career-high 16 games and was named a BIG EAST All-Academic Selection in 2017-18.
- \pm A Calumet City, III. native, Alba attended George Washington High School and was ranked in the top-100 players in the 2014 recruiting class by both TopDrawerSoccer.com and College Soccer News. He also trained with the Chicago Fire Academy.
