Head Coach John Pfaffl

- UW-Milwaukee & Stritch Alum
- Entering thirteenth season as Head Coach
- With Stritch since 1989
- 252-120 Record as Head Coach
- 147-66 Conference Record as Head Coach

John Pfaffl begins his thirteenth year (2022–23) as head coach of the Cardinal Stritch University women's basketball program. Prior to becoming head coach, Pfaffl was a recognizable fixture with Stritch athletics, serving in various roles since 1989.

Pfaffl's coaching record includes stellar marks of 252-120 (.677) overall, 147-66 (.690) in the CCAC and 104-34 (.754) at home. He has twice been named CCAC Coach of the Year in 2011 and 2012. His team's win percentage of .677 places him at 25th best among active NAIA head coaches. During his first ten-seasons, before the NAIA combined their two divisions, his teams have qualified



for the NAIA II National every season, 6 times advancing to the Sweet 16 and in 2014 were FINAL FOUR finalists. He is most proud of his teams achievements in the classroom and their many service and volunteer activities (partnering with Special Olympics, the United Way Women's Shelter, the Milwaukee Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, to name a few).

The 2018-19 season saw the Wolves finish with a 24-10 overall record and 17-3 in conference play, earning them a share of the regular season championship. Earning an at-large bid to the NAIA II tourney, they upset Sterling in the first round before bowing out in the Sweet 16 to eventual national champs Concordia (NE).

The Wolves advanced to the national tourney in their 2017-18 season and lost in the first round to Jamestown University, finishing the year 19-11 and 12-8 in conference play.

In the 2016-17 season the Wolves ended year with an overall 25-7 mark and a conference record of 17-3. Receiving an at-large bid, the Wolves returned to the NAIA National Tournament for the 16th consecutive year. At the National Tournament, Pfaffl led the Wolves to their fifth Sweet 16 appearance since him taking over the head coaching position.

During 2015-16, PfaffI led the Wolves to a 25-8 record. The Wolves were ranked as high as No.6 in the national polls and ended the season as a top 15 team in NAIA. It marked the 15th consecutive year that Stritch qualified for the national tournament.

The 2014 season was a memorable one, as Pfaffl guided Stritch to the NAIA Division II Final Four for the first time in school history. The Wolves finished 27-7, including an 18-game win streak. At the national tournament, Stritch defeated Saint Ambrose University, Jamestown College and Morningside College before falling to No. 1 University of St. Francis.





HEAD COACH JOHN PFAFFL - BIO/RECORD

During the 2012 season, PfaffI led the Wolves to a 27-7 record (11-1 CCAC). Stritch experienced its greatest success during a 15-game win streak. The Wolves were CCAC regular-season champions and CCAC Tournament champions.

Pfaffl's coaching roots began at the youth level before moving up to the high school ranks in 1989, when he began coaching football at Milwaukee Pius XI and girls basketball at St. Mary's Academy. He eventually became an assistant coach for Rich Panella at Stritch.

After serving five seasons as solely a part time assistant for the women's team, Pfaffl was hired full time in 1994, serving as the Sports Information Director, assistant men's and women's basketball coach, and head men's and women's cross country coach. He also worked as an adjunct instructor, teaching physical education, as well as, sport management courses.

After 15 years in those roles, Pfaffl stepped down to become the Director of Recreation, Intramurals and Facilities at Stritch while continuing to assist under Coach Panella.

In the unique position serving as an assistant coach for both the men's and women's basketball teams under two Hall of Fame coaches, Pfaffl was involved in two very successful programs. During his tenure with the women's team, the Wolves posted a .809 winning percentage (.884 in conference play), won 16 regular-season titles and advanced to the NAIA Division II Tournament 14 times. The men's team claimed a .688 winning percentage (.706 in conference play), won six regular-season titles and advanced to the NAIA Division II Tournament six times.

He took over the women's basketball program from Panella in 2010, who Pfaffl refers to as one of the main influences in his life who molded him into the person and coach he is today.

A Milwaukee native, Pfaffl has been heavily involved in athletics. He competed in football, basketball, and track and field at Milwaukee Pius XI High School, then started in the backfield as a frosh for the Lawrence University football team before eventually transferring to UW-Milwaukee to complete his undergrad degree.

Pfaffl holds a bachelor's degree in health science (University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee) and a master's in sport management (Cardinal Stritch University). He and his wife, Janice, reside in Fox Point with their daughters, Sofia and Karli, along with their goldendoodle, Ryli.

Caitlin Connor is entering her second season as an assistant coach for the Cardinal Stritch University Women's Basketball team. Since her start at Stritch in September 2021, Caitlin has had an active role in many duties for the program. These include coordinating individual and small group development workouts, creating scouting reports, academic monitoring, and recruiting. This summer, Caitlin was in charge of running the Women's Collegiate Summer League games at Stritch, and assisted Coach Pfaffl during the new School of Hoops program for middle and high school girls.

Prior to her time at Stritch, Caitlin spent 2 years assisting the women's and men's basketball teams at her alma mater, UW-River Falls. She utilized her senior year at UWRF to complete a coaching practicum with the Men's team. She held many titles while working with the Men's program, including assistant coach, manager, statistician, and social media marketer. Following her graduation, she volunteered as the Video Coordinator and Director of Player Development for the Women's team.

Caitlin got her start in coaching during her junior year of high school. She assisted multiple girls' teams at Richfield Middle School for 4 years and during the summers, coached for the Hartford Basketball Club at Hartford Union High School. This introduction to coaching helped her gain experience working with athletes ranging from 5th grade to high school seniors.

Caitlin graduated in 2020 from UW-River Falls with her bachelor degree in Psychology and minor in Athletic Coaching.

- Former assistant under Stritch legend Rich Panella
- Entering thirty-sixth season as assistant coach



Assistant Coach Tom Spera enters his 36th year with the Stritch women's basketball program. Spera's duties include perimeter player development and recruiting.

Spera came to the Wolves from St. Joan Antida High School, where he served as Rich Panella's assistant. Spera, who retired from the U.S. Postal Service, also assisted Panella with the Stritch softball team. He keeps busy in the summer coaching slow-pitch softball. Spera's teams have won five city softball championships and also one basketball city championship. In 1998, they won the Midwest Regional Softball Championship and were city champ runners-up.

Spera is a lifelong resident of Milwaukee.
