The 2023 season is Houston's first in the Big 12 Conference. The league is the seventh in which Houston has competed during its award-winning history.

Houston Athletics has won 179 conference championships with 17 NCAA team national championships and 68 NCAA individual national crowns in 77 years of existence. Forty-one Cougars have earned Olympics medals.

THE OPENING KICKOFF

- Houston and West Virginia are meeting for the first time in the history of the programs. The Cougars and Mountaineers have several notable ties, headlined by Cougar Head Coach **Dana Holgorsen's** eight seasons at the helm of West Virginia. In total, 16 current Houston Football coaches, staff members and student-athletes either coached, played or worked at West Virginia. For a full list, see page 7.
- The Cougars are 14-6 in their last 20 matchups following the open date including an 11-4 mark since the 2011 season. UH has won its last two matchups following the off week, defeating Navy, 38-20, on Oct. 22, 2022, and defeating ECU, 31-24 in overtime on Oct. 23, 2021.
- Houston will hold its annual Blackout game Thursday with fans encouraged to "Black Out" TDECU Stadium. The team will don white helmets, black jerseys and black pants. Two seasons ago, Houston knocked off #19/16 SMU, 44-37, in the squad's Blackout game thanks to a go-ahead 100-yard kickoff return touchdown from **Marcus Jones** inside one minute remaining in the game.
- Houston is 46-18 in October since 2006 including a 26-9 mark at home. Houston has won seven straight games in the month (Oct. 1, 2021-present) with its lost loss coming on Halloween 2020 vs. UCF (44-21).
- UH is 6-1 in its last seven non-Saturday games. On a Friday, Oct. 7, a season ago, Houston stunned Memphis with 26 fourth-quarter points as part of a 33-32 victory. Houston's last Thursday night affair, Oct. 7, 2021, at Tulane, featured eight sacks and a 40-22 victory. On Thursday, Nov. 17, 2016, Houston sacked Louisville quarterback Lamar Jackson 11 times, routing the #3/3 Cardinals, 36-10 at TDECU Stadium.
- Houston quarterback **Donovan Smith** is coming off a record-setting game in his return to Texas Tech, where he played three seasons (2020-22). The junior, who leads the Big 12 with 24.8 completions per game, matched a career high with four touchdown passes including finding redshirt freshmen **Dalton Carnes** and **Bryan Henry** for their first career touchdown receptions. Smith's 61 combined completions between Games 4-5 led all Power 5 quarterbacks. He was one of three Power 5 quarterbacks to complete 75% of his passes (min. 25 attempts) without throwing an interception over the two-game stretch.
- Eleven different players have caught a pass for the Cougars in each of the last two games. The last time Houston had 11+ players with a catch in consecutive games was Nov. 5, 2011, at UAB and Nov. 10, 2011, at Tulane. Prior to its Sam Houston game on Sept. 23, the last time the Cougars had 11+ players catch a pass in a game was Sept. 25, 2021, against Navy (11).
- The Cougars have not lost the turnover battle in their first five games. Houston ranks fourth nationally with just three turnovers and is fifth in turnover margin (1.20). Houston has forced nine turnovers which ranks fourth in the Big 12.
- UH has scored on its opening possession seven times in its last 12 games including three consecutive contests. Texas Tech's defense had not allowed a score on the opening drive this season before the Cougars went 75 yards in 12 plays, capped off by a six-yard touchdown pass.
- After allowing six sacks and 16 quarterback pressures against TCU in its Big 12 opener, Houston's offensive line has bounced back. Over its last two games, the unit has permitted just one sack and limited opponents to a combined 12 quarterback pressures. Left tackle **Patrick Paul** leads the country among tackles with a 94.8 pass block grade and ranks fourth nationally with an 84.6 offensive grade per PFF.
- In each of its first two Big 12 games, Houston has trailed by seven points at the break only to be shut out in the second half. The Cougars outgained Texas Tech, 489-400, last time out and scored touchdowns on four of their first five drives but allowed two special teams touchdowns in a 49-28 loss.

Houston Football overcame a slow start to defeat Memphis, 25-15, running off its fifth consecutive victory to begin the season on Oct. 12, 2013, inside BBVA Compass Stadium. Trailing 15-10 midway through the third, **Kenneth Farrow** put the Cougars ahead with a 1-yard run and followed that by taking a shovel pass in for a two-point conversion. He extended the lead to 25-15 with a 6-yard run with 10 minutes remaining. Houston held Memphis without a touchdown as the Tigers made five field goals in the loss.

TEAM NOTES

• Houston Football is looking to replicate the magic of its soccer and volleyball programs. Houston Soccer picked up the school’s first Big 12 Conference victory with a 2-1 victory over West Virginia on Sunday, Oct. 1. #21 Houston Volleyball swept the Mountaineers in straight matches last weekend including the team’s first league victory with a 3-0 result on Friday.

• After scoring on just 64% of redzone opportunities (9 of 14) across their first three games, the Cougars have capitalized in their last two contests, scoring in seven of eight (87.5%) of chances.

• Houston freshman running back **Parker Jenkins** has rushed for a combined 176 yards over the last two games including a three-score, 105-yard outburst against Sam Houston on Sept. 23. In his last two games, Jenkins owns seven rushes of 10+ yards. Jenkins’ 72.6 run grade (PFF) on the season ranks third among all Power 5 true freshmen running backs.

• The 2023 season is Head Coach **Dana Holgorsen’s** 17th coaching in the Big 12 Conference. Holgorsen has coached four of the league’s 14 schools, totaling a combined 74 Big 12 victories as a head coach or assistant coach at West Virginia (2012-18), Oklahoma State (2010) and Texas Tech (2000-07), including a combined 18-9 conference record over his final three seasons with the Mountaineers.

• Cougar wideout **Samuel Brown** leads the Big 12 Conference in receiving yards (518), receiving yards per game (103.6) and receptions per game (6.8). The sophomore hauled in his first receiving score last time out, courtesy of a 16-yard touchdown at Texas Tech. Brown’s 518 receiving yards are the third-most for a Cougar wideout through the first five games in the last two decades.

• UH defensive back **Malik Fleming** is tied for seventh nationally with three interceptions in five games. Fleming’s six interceptions since the start of the 2022 season ranks tied for 12th nationally. All six of those interceptions have come in the last 12 games.

• Houston sophomore **Matthew Golden** is one of 17 players nationally and is one of two Big 12 Conference players with a kickoff return touchdown. Golden raced 98 yards for the score against TCU. Golden has hauled in nine touchdown receptions over his last 10 games and ranks second in the Big 12 with four receiving TDs this season.

AGAINST THE MOUNTAINEERS

• Former Oklahoma linebacker and current Houston defensive end **David Ugwoegbu** has appeared in three games and played a combined 149 snaps, totaling 18 tackles, against West Virginia. Ugwoegbu contributed nine tackles, 0.5 tackles for loss and a breakup against West Virginia in Morgantown on Nov. 12, 2022. Ugwoegbu had six tackles in the 2021 matchup on Sept. 25 in Norman. He totaled three tackles on Oct. 19, 2019, in Norman.

• Then-Texas Tech quarterback **Donovan Smith** completed all four of his attempted passes including a 2-yard touchdown pass to cap an 84-yard drive on Oct. 22, 2022, in Lubbock. Smith rushed twice for 14 yards in the 2021 matchup on Oct. 2 in Morgantown.

• Then-Texas Tech cornerback **Alex Hogan** logged one tackle and played 28 snaps against the Mountaineers on Oct. 24, 2020, in Lubbock. He added one stop as part of 14 snaps at West Virginia on Nov. 9, 2019.

• Then-Oklahoma State wide receiver **Stephon Johnson Jr.** played 84 offensive snaps and caught one pass for nine yards against West Virginia in Stillwater on Nov. 26, 2022.

INSIDE THE SCHEDULE

• Houston’s matchup against West Virginia is the Cougars first against a program outside of Texas. Houston plays seven total games against in-state programs. UH plays 10 games in the state of Texas – its most since 1990. UH’s seven on-campus games are its most since 2015. UH leaves the state just twice, its fewest since playing as many out-of-state games in 1994, and will only fly three times (at Texas Tech, at Kansas State and at UCF).

• Based on 2022 win-loss record, UH’s schedule ranks tied for the sixth toughest nationally. Cougar opponents went 96-60 (61.5%) a season ago. The schedule is the toughest in the state of Texas and second toughest in the Big 12 [No. 3 West Virginia – 98-59 (62.4%)]. Ten of Houston’s 12 opponents reached a bowl, eight were ranked in the AP poll and four reached their conference title game in 2022.

ROSTER MAKEUP

• Houston’s roster features 50 newcomers including 23 transfers. Approximately 25% of the Cougars’ current roster has experience at a Power 5 program and 70% of its roster received at least one Power 5 offer.

• UH has no shortage of experience on the offensive line. Entering the season, UH o-linemen had played 192 collegiate games and made 145 starts. The 145 starts were the fifth-most nationally and most in the Big 12. The unit had played 9,981 Division I snaps on the line, led by **Patrick Paul** (2,190), **Jack Freeman** (1,919), **Peyton Dunn** (1,293), **Tank Jenkins** (1,192) and **Max Banes** (1,155).

A VICTORY WOULD

• Be Houston Football’s first Big 12 Conference win.

• Be the first Big 12 Conference victory by any of the league’s three schools coming over from The American.

• Be Head Coach **Dana Holgorsen’s** 75th Big 12 Conference win as a head coach or assistant coach.

• Give Houston its eighth straight victory in October (Oct. 1, 2021-present).

• Move Houston to 3-1 at TDECU Stadium this season and 41-16 since the facility opened in 2014.

HOUSTON (AP) – Junior quarterback Donovan Smith threw for 233 yards and two touchdowns, Samuel Brown had 106 yards receiving and Houston held on for a 17-14 win over UTSA on Saturday night in a season opener and the Cougars' first game as a Big 12 Conference member.

Smith, who was 22-of-34 passing, threw touchdown passes of eight yards to Joseph Manjack IV in the first quarter and six yards to Matthew Golden in the third as Houston built a 17-7 lead. The Cougars finished with 334 yards of offense.

Frank Harris was 18 of 36 for 209 yards passing with a touchdown, but he was intercepted three times. Kevorian Barnes rushed for 103 yards and a touchdown for UTSA, which finished with 417 yards.

After UTSA cut the lead to three on a 20-yard touchdown pass from Harris to Joshua Cephus with 5:42 remaining, Houston was able to run out the clock, including a crucial 3-yard gain by Smith to just get the first down with 1:45 remaining.

Houston has beaten UTSA in consecutive season openers after outlasting the Roadrunners, 37-35, in triple overtime last season in San Antonio.

THE TAKEAWAY

UTSA: The Roadrunners, which joined the American Athletic Conference this season, had issues staying on the field going 4 for 13 on third downs. UTSA had an even offense with 209 yards passing and 208 yards rushing.

Houston: The Cougars' defense kept Harris under pressure for most of the night, which contributed to the three interceptions. Two of the interceptions were by Malik Fleming. Houston had issues rushing the ball, finishing with 101 yards on the ground.

HOUSTON – After mounting a 28-point comeback to tie the game late in the fourth quarter, the University of Houston Football program was unable to hold off Rice in double overtime, falling 43-41 in the Bayou Bucket in Rice Stadium.

Trailing 28-0 late in the second quarter, the Cougars (1-1) rallied to tie the game at 28-28 on junior quarterback Donovan Smith's 1-yard touchdown run with just 15 seconds remaining in regulation.

After trailing by four scores with 2:43 left in the second quarter, the Cougars rallied for 28 unanswered points to close regulation and force overtime for just the second time in the history of the Bayou Bucket.

Golden started the scoring with a 10-yard reception from Smith to get Houston on the board, 28-7, with 2:42 remaining in the first half. The Cougars' defense kept it a three-score game heading into halftime as Hamilton leaped for an interception in the end zone with nine seconds on the clock.

After a scoreless third quarter, the Cougars rallied in the fourth. Starting a drive with a fumble recovery in the waning seconds of the third, Houston's Smith fought his way in with a 1-yard rush to cut the Cougars' deficit to 28-14 with 14:05 left in the fourth quarter. Sneed followed it up two drives later with a 14-yard rushing touchdown of his own to put Houston down by seven with 3:46 remaining.

The Cougar defense forced a three-and-out for Rice (1-1) on the ensuing possession, giving Houston a chance to tie it with 2:49 remaining in regulation. Smith and the offense rattled off a eight-play, 40-yard drive, capped by a 1-yard scramble by Smith, to tie the game with 15 seconds left.

Houston opened overtime by taking its first lead of the contest as Golden caught his second touchdown of the game on a 2-yard pass from Smith, but Rice forced a second extra period as Daelen Alexander scored on a 3-yard rush to even the score at 35-35.

Alexander scored again for the Owls to start the second OT frame and took it in himself for the two-point conversion to put Rice up 43-35 and put the game back into the Cougars' hands. While Smith rushed for his third TD of the game on Houston's 20T possession, the Cougars failed on their two-point attempt to give Rice the win.

Rice started the scoring on the opening drive as Luke McCaffrey, younger brother of the San Francisco 49ers Luke McCaffrey, caught a 10-yard pass from JT Daniels.

The Owls extended their lead to 21-0 by the end of the first quarter as Alexander ran in for a one-yard touchdown, and McCaffrey found the end zone again on a 32-yard reception. Rice capped its regulation scoring with a 15-yard pass from Daniels to Braylen Walker to put the Owls up, 28-0.

HOUSTON (AP) – TCU quarterback Chandler Morris threw for 314 yards and two touchdowns as the Horned Frogs spoiled Houston's Big 12 Conference debut with a 36-13 victory on Saturday night.

TCU (2-1, 1-0) won its second straight game after a season-opening loss to Colorado.

TCU's offense had a fast-paced opening drive that ended with a 33-yard touchdown pass from Morris to Warren Thompson, just 1:31 into the game. Morris finished 24 of 37, threw one interception and added 53 rushing yards on 12 carries.

Houston's only touchdown came late in the first half on a 98-yard kickoff return by Matthew Golden, cutting TCU's lead to 13-10. TCU immediately answered with a 16-yard touchdown run by Emani Bailey, and the Horned Frogs led 20-13 at halftime.

Bailey ran for 126 yards on 23 carries.

TCU's defense held the Cougars in check. Quarterback Donovan Smith completed 18 of 35 passes for 245 yards, while the Cougars (1-2, 0-1 Big 12) totaled 35 rushing yards on 26 carries.

Houston was trying to bounce back from a double-overtime loss to cross-town rival Rice.

Houston receiver Samuel Brown entered the game leading the Big 12 with 15 receptions and 244 yards through his first two games. Brown had another active game against TCU, making five catches for 99 yards.

Griffin Kell made three of five field-goal attempts for TCU, including a 53-yarder.

THE TAKEAWAY

TCU: After entering Saturday's game ranked 126th in the nation in allowing 343.5 passing yards per game, TCU's secondary showed much improvement against Houston, aided in part by a much more aggressive pass rush up front. TCU had six sacks and eight tackles for loss.

Houston: The Cougars have one more non-conference game against Sam Houston before finishing out the season with eight Big 12 games.

HOUSTON – The University of Houston Football team closed its non-conference schedule with a 38-7 win over Sam Houston on Saturday night at TDECU Stadium. The Cougars snapped a two-game losing skid while posting a season-high 538 yards of offense in the contest.

Freshman running back Parker Jenkins became the first Cougar in program history to rush for three touchdowns in his first start – with all coming in the first half. He became the 15th Houston player with 3+ rushing scores in a half. Jenkins also matched the program record for rushing touchdowns by a freshman.

Junior quarterback Donovan Smith narrowly missed out on his first 300-yard passing game as a Cougar, tallying 294 yards while going 31-for-40 with a touchdown. Meanwhile, sophomore quarterback Ui Ale used his second collegiate pass to throw a 58-yard touchdown, Houston's longest offensive play of the year.

Houston opened the game with a 13-play, 69-yard drive that ended with junior Jack Martin splitting the uprights from 23 yards out to put the Cougars up 3-0. Sam Houston responded on its opening drive, briefly taking a 7-3 lead on a 2-yard rush from Trapper Pannell.

The Cougars wasted no time in answering as Jenkins carried in his first touchdown, a 2-yard scramble, that gave Houston a 10-7 lead it would never relinquish. Jenkins would ultimately carry in two more touchdowns in the first half, a 1-yard rush with 7:22 left and another 2-yard score to put Houston up 24-7 at the break.

Houston continued to cruise in the second half. Smith earned his first passing touchdown of the game in the Cougars' first drive of the third quarter, finding sophomore Matthew Golden for a 6-yard touchdown. Ale capped Houston's scoring in the fourth quarter, sending his first collegiate completion to sophomore Stacy Sneed for a 58-yard touchdown, Houston's longest offensive play of the season, cementing the Cougars' 38-7 win.

UP NEXT

Houston will meet Texas Tech at 2:30 p.m., Sept. 30, inside Jones AT&T Stadium in Lubbock, Texas. It will be the Cougars' first Big 12 road game.

LUBBOCK, Texas – University of Houston junior quarterback Donovan Smith threw for 335 yards and a career-high-tying four touchdowns, but it would not be enough as Texas Tech took a 49-28 win over the Cougars inside Jones A&T Stadium on Saturday evening.

Playing for three seasons with the Red Raiders before transferring to Houston, Smith led the Cougars to touchdowns on their first three and four of their first five possessions. The Las Vegas native completed 12 of his first 15 pass attempts and finished with touchdown tosses to Bryan Henry, Samuel Brown, Joseph Manjack IV and Dalton Carnes.

Completing 29-of-40 passes, Smith recorded his first 300-yard passing game as a Cougar and the fifth of his career. It was the third highest total of his career, trailing only 359 yards with Texas Tech against Kansas State on Oct. 1, 2022, and 350 yards against the Cougars in Lubbock on Sept. 10, 2022.

Smith tied his personal best with four touchdown tosses, equaling his total against Murray State in the 2022 season opener with Texas Tech.

With the loss, Houston fell to 2-3 overall and 0-2 in Big 12 play. Texas Tech improved to 2-3 overall and 1-1 in league action.

In an offensive slugfest early, Houston outgained the Red Raiders 489-400 and held the ball for more than 35 minutes. The two teams combined for five touchdowns and nearly 350 yards of total offense in the second quarter alone.

However, Texas Tech was equally efficient offensively in the first half and took advantage of a 100-yard kickoff return and blocked punt return for touchdown in the first 30 minutes en route to the win.

Brown led all receivers with nine catches for 113 yards.

Texas Tech running backs Tahj Brooks and Cam'Ron Valdez tied for game-high honors with 106 rushing yards each with Brooks posting two touchdowns and Valdez adding a 41-yard touchdown run midway through the fourth quarter to cap the day's scoring.

UP NEXT

Following Saturday's game, Houston will enjoy its bye weekend before hosting West Virginia at 6 p.m., Thursday, Oct. 12, inside TDECU Stadium.

HOLGORSEN AT WEST VIRGINIA

• **Dana Holgorsen** closed his tenure at West Virginia as the second-winningest coach in Mountaineer history with an eight-year record of 61-41. His 61 wins trailed only College Football Hall of Famer Don Nehlen for most wins in West Virginia history. He led the Mountaineers to bowl games in seven of his eight seasons including each of his final five seasons. West Virginia was ranked in both major polls at least one week in seven of his eight years including the entire 2018 season with several weeks inside the Top 10. Holgorsen was named head coach at Houston on Jan. 1, 2019.

COACHING, STAFF TIES TO WVU

• Houston Associate Head Coach and Defensive Coordinator **Doug Belk** spent two seasons at West Virginia (2017-18) as Cornerbacks' Coach. In 2018, in Big 12 play, the Mountaineers led the Big 12 with 12 interceptions. The 2017 defense ranked No. 16 nationally in most defensive three-and-outs per game and No. 24 in best third-down defense.

• Houston Quarterbacks Coach **Mike Burchett** was a two-year quarterback at West Virginia under Holgorsen and spent three seasons on staff including two as Offensive Graduate Assistant (2015-16) and one as Offensive Analyst (2017).

• Houston Special Teams Coordinator **Mark Scott** spent seven seasons at West Virginia (2012-18) including his final two seasons working with the Mountaineers' linebackers and special teams units. He tutored five All-Conference and helped the Mountaineers to six bowl appearances.

• Houston Wide Receivers Coach **Daikiel Shorts Jr.** produced a decorated playing career at West Virginia before working as a Program Assistant with the Mountaineers for the 2018 season. During his time at WVU as a player, Shorts led the Mountaineers in

receiving in three of his four years and was named a team captain in 2016. He also earned the 2016 Iron Mountaineer Award. He closed his career ranked fifth on the WVU career chart with 177 receptions and sixth with 2,263 receiving yards.

• Houston Director of Strength & Performance **Darl Bauer** spent 10 seasons as a member of West Virginia's Strength & Conditioning Staff before joining Houston on Jan. 13, 2019. Bauer had been on West Virginia's strength and conditioning staff since 2009, assisting with the football strength and conditioning program, first as a graduate assistant for a year before becoming a full-time member of the staff. He was promoted to Assistant Director of Strength and Conditioning/Director of Applied Performance in December 2017.

• **Ryan Dorchester** was named Assistant Athletics Director for Football Operations at Houston on Jan. 11, 2019, after 14 seasons at West Virginia including his last five as Director of Player Personnel. In his last role at WVU, Dorchester served in an administrative capacity, overseeing the organizational aspects of recruiting and managing the personnel of the current members of the program. He served as the liaison to Holgorsen on all recruiting issues while coordinating Holgorsen's recruiting efforts, including correspondence and in-person visits.

• **Kevin McCadam** joined Houston as its Assistant Director of Strength & Performance in February 2019 following six seasons at West Virginia as the assistant director of strength and conditioning/speed development.

• **Nate Majnaric**, who was named an UH Assistant Strength & Performance coach at Houston in February 2019, graduated from West Virginia and was a member of the Mountaineers' football team. He was an All-Big 12 Academic honoree and earned his bachelor's degree in coaching education with an emphasis on exercise psychology. He joined the West Virginia program as a sophomore as a walk-on, earning a scholarship as a senior.

• **Casey Smithson**, UH's Director of Player Personnel, earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from West Virginia in 2011 and his master's degree in sport management in 2014 before going on to work with the Mountaineer Football program as defensive recruiting coordinator. Smithson began working with the program in 2007 when he assisted the coaching staff as a recruiting intern and student recruiting assistant. He served as the recruiting and operations graduate assistant from 2011-14.

• **Dylan August**, an Offensive Analyst for UH, graduated from West Virginia and worked with the Mountaineers as a Graduate Assistant.

• **T.J. Simmons**, an Offensive Graduate Assistant for UH, played in 30 career games (21 starts) for West Virginia as a wide receiver including ranking second in the Big 12 in yards per reception in 2020 (17.4).

QUARTET ARRIVES AT UH FROM WVU

• Houston sophomore wide receiver **Samuel Brown** spent the 2020-21 seasons at West Virginia, playing in nine total games.

• Houston senior defensive back **Noah Guzman** spent the 2019-20 seasons at West Virginia, appearing in seven games during 2020 and nine games, including one start, in 2019. He logged nine tackles during 2020 and 24 tackles, including 14 solo stops, in 2019.

• Houston tight end **Mike O'Laughlin** spent five seasons (2018-22) at West Virginia, playing in 31 career games while hauling in 37 receptions for 292 yards and one touchdown. He redshirted during his 2018 season under Holgorsen.

• UH running back **Tony Mathis Jr.** played four seasons at WVU (2019-22), appearing in 31 games including 11 starts. He logged three 100+ rushing performances. Mathis started 10 games at running back in 2022, finishing No. 7 in the Big 12 in rushing yards per game (56.2)

- In the month of October for his career, Smith has completed 72% of his passes (59 of 82) alongside 651 passing yards and four TDs.
- Smith's 124 completions in 2023 are the most for a Houston quarterback through five games since **David Piland's** 155 in 2012.
- Smith's 59 rush yards last time out against Texas Tech marked a career high. The junior averaged 6.6 yards per carry.
- In his career vs. Big 12 competition, Smith is 192 of 298 passing (64.4%) for 2,209 yards and 23 TDs (15 passing, 7 rushing, 1 receiving).
- Smith's performance a season ago against #25 Houston was not just impressive, it was historic. Smith is the lone player in the last two decades with 35+ pass completions, 350+ passing yards, 2+ passing TDs and one rushing score in a game against the Cougars.
- Smith was one of two Big 12 quarterbacks and 19 players nationally to complete 30+ passes for 350+ yards and 2+ scores in a road game in 2022 (at #25 Kansas State). UH quarterback **Clayton Tune** led the nation with three such performances.
- Smith was the lone Big 12 Conference quarterback and one of 10 Power 5 quarterbacks to complete 70% of his passes with a minimum of 45 attempts in a single game a season ago, doing so at #25 Kansas State (Oct. 1).

OFFENSIVE OVERVIEW

Houston had its first true quarterback competition since 2018 with junior transfer Donovan Smith earning the job and looking to capitalize on arguably Head Coach **Dana Holgorsen's** deepest wide receivers' room at Houston. The Cougars' offensive line returns five letterwinners and three starters from a season ago and welcomes in five newcomers including four with prior Division I experience.

Houston scored 30+ points in 11 games a season ago and has piled up 20,000+ yards of total offense in four seasons under Holgorsen. With **Eman Naghavi** joining as Running Game Coordinator/Co-Offensive Coordinator and **Mike Burchett** being elevated to Quarterbacks Coach, UH looks to remain one of the nation's top offenses.

QUARTERBACK

DEFENSIVE OVERVIEW



Houston has forced nine turnovers in its first five games, a mark which ranks fourth in the Big 12 Conference. The Cougars have not lost the turnover battle this season and rank fifth nationally in turnover margin (1.20). The Cougars are fourth in the country with just three turnovers lost.

UH is looking to bounce back from an overall disappointing defensive performance during 2022, which included a rash of injuries, and return to their prowess from 2021 which featured the nation's top third-down conversion percentage defense. Houston will be tasked with replacing its top five tacklers including defensive back **Gervarius Owens** (7th round, NFL Draft). The Cougars brought in seven defensive players with prior Division I experience including 2022 Honorable Mention All-Big 12 Conference defensive lineman **David Ugwoegbu** (Oklahoma) and 2022 All-American Athletic Conference Second Team defensive back **Malik Fleming** (East Carolina).

HEAD COACH DANA HOLGORSEN

FIFTH SEASON AT HOUSTON (29-23) | 12TH SEASON OVERALL (90-64)

- Named head coach at Houston on Jan. 1, 2019, after eight seasons at West Virginia.
- Has tutored 23 All-Americans, 11 national award winners and 14 national award finalists. In four NFL Drafts since taking the helm at Houston, 11 Cougar players have been selected including five in the top three rounds.
- Houston has won 20 games over its last two seasons (2021-22) marking the program's third highest total in a two-year span. The run has featured back-to-back bowl victories (2021 Birmingham Bowl; 2022 Independence Bowl) for the first time since 2014-15. With a win in the Independence Bowl on Dec. 23, 2022, Holgorsen became the first Houston Head Coach since Bill Yeoman to register multiple bowl victories.
- Houston went 13-3 over its final 16 American Athletic Conference contests (2021-22). The Cougars won a national-best 10 road contests between 2021-22 including six consecutive matchups from Oct. 1, 2021-Oct. 22, 2022, which ranked as the nation's second longest streak in that timeframe.
- Since Holgorsen's arrival in 2019, Houston is the only program nationally to boast a punt return touchdown and kickoff return touchdown in four consecutive seasons (2019-22).
- Guided Houston to an 8-5 record and Independence Bowl victory in 2022. The Cougars won six of their final eight games while ranking eighth nationally in passing offense (314.0), 10th in punt returns (15.0 per return), 11th in team tackles for loss (7.2 per game), 12th in passing efficiency (158.38) and 16th in scoring offense (36.1).
- As part of his commitment to the future of Houston Football, Holgorsen pledged \$1 million towards University of Houston's "Houston Rise" campaign towards the development of the program's state-of-the-art Football Operations Center (FOC).
- Under his leadership in 2021, the Cougars won 12+ games for just the third time in program history. Houston won 11 consecutive games, its longest stretch since 2011, en route to an appearance in The American Football Championship.
- In the 2021 Birmingham Bowl, Houston knocked off Auburn to clinch the program's first bowl victory since 2015.
- Houston was one of six teams nationally to rank in the top 20 in both points per game (35.9) and opponent points per game (20.4).
- For the second time in his coaching career, Holgorsen tutored a Paul Hornung Award winner as consensus All-American Marcus Jones captured the award in 2021.
- Closed his tenure at West Virginia as the second-winningest coach in Mountaineer history with an eight-year record of 61-41. His 61 wins trailed only College Football Hall of Famer Don Nehlen for most wins in West Virginia history.
- Led the Mountaineers to bowl games in seven of his eight seasons including his final five seasons. His first season at West Virginia ended with a 70-33 rout of Clemson in the Orange Bowl.
- West Virginia had 10 NFL draft picks in first three rounds in his final seven years, the second most in Big 12, including at least one Top-15 draft pick in four of his final seven years. In all, he had four NFL Top-15 draft picks during a seven-year stretch, the most in the Big 12, and 20 players drafted in seven years at WVU, tied for second-most in the Big 12 during that span.
- An offensive genius, his passing offenses and total offensive output have ranked in the Top 10 nationally all but four years during the 14-year span since he became offensive coordinator at Texas Tech in 2005.
- He's had eight quarterbacks pass for 4,000 or more yards and 10 throw for 30 or more touchdowns in a season with 20 receivers finishing with 1,000 or more yards in a season, including 11 finish with 90 or more receptions and 16 finish with double figure TD receptions in a season.
- He is the only coach in West Virginia history to have coached a team with at least 450 rushing yards in a game (Oklahoma, 2012) and at least 450 yards passing in a game (six times).
- He had 10 wins over Top 25 opponents in his eight-year tenure at WVU.
- West Virginia was ranked in both major polls at least one week in seven of his eight years including the entire 2018 season with several weeks inside the top 10.
- In 2018, Holgorsen led a West Virginia team that was ranked every week during the season and finished the regular season with a No. 15/16 ranking in both major polls.
- Under his leadership, quarterback Will Grier finished No. 4 in the Heisman Trophy race and was a finalist for the Maxwell Award, The Johnny Unitas Golden Arm Award, the Senior CLASS Award and the Manning Award. Grier was ranked in the top 10 nationally in 11 offensive categories and seven categories in the top five.
- Outside of football, Holgorsen served as the chair of the WVU Medicine Children's capital campaign, raising \$60 million to build a new home for pediatric and maternal services.
- In 2016, the AFCA District 4 Regional Coach of the Year and Paul "Bear" Bryant Coach of the Year finalist led the Mountaineers to a 10-3 overall mark and 7-2 record in the Big 12.
- His 2016 team achieved the ninth 10-win season in school history, becoming one of six WVU teams to do it in the regular season. Holgorsen is one of three WVU coaches, along with Nehlen and Rich Rodriguez, to post multiple 10-win seasons.
- In 2012, Holgorsen led WVU into its first year of competition in the Big 12 Conference, guiding West Virginia to a 7-6 overall record and an appearance in the New Era PinStripe Bowl. Five Mountaineers earned 25 All-America honors and three were drafted in the top three rounds of the NFL draft.
- Holgorsen had a successful first season at WVU in 2011, coaching the Mountaineers to a 10-3 record, the Big East championship and a 70-33 Orange Bowl rout of Clemson. The victory was WVU's third Bowl Championship Series championship in school history and earned Holgorsen the First-Year Coach of the Year award by the Football Writers Association of America.
- Before West Virginia, Holgorsen spent the 2010 season as offensive coordinator at Oklahoma State. He was a finalist for the 2010 Broyles Award, given to the nation's top assistant, and also named the Rivals.com Offensive Coordinator of the Year.
- During his two-year tenure with Houston, his offenses put up explosive numbers, accounting for 563 yards of total offense per game, passing for 433.7 yards per game and totaling more than 42.2 points per game. His offense ranked No. 3 in total offense in 2008 and No. 1 in 2009. His quarterback, Case Keenum, led the nation in total offense in 2008 and 2009, totaling 403.2 yards per game as a sophomore and 416.4 yards his junior season. He also ranked among the Top 10 nationally in pass efficiency both years.
- Holgorsen was a member of the coaching staff at Texas Tech from 2000-07, serving as the inside receivers coach from 2000-04, before being elevated to co-offensive coordinator in 2005 and offensive coordinator in 2006-07.
- Holgorsen also spent time at Valdosta State (1993-95) as the quarterbacks, receivers and special teams coach, Mississippi College (1996-98) as the quarterbacks, receivers and special teams coach and at Wingate (1999) as the quarterbacks and receivers coach.

TDECU STADIUM

BERT F. WINSTON BAND COMPLEX

A 39,089-square foot building on the east end of TDECU Stadium housing the Spirit of Houston Band Recital Halls and classroom spaces, Coach Bill Yeoman Hall and the UH Athletics Ticket Office.

COACH BILL YEOMAN HALL

A 2,000-square foot tribute area to University of Houston history located on the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium. Serves as a gameday club for ticket holders in section 129 and north side loge boxes.

DORIS NANTZ PRESS BOX

The Doris Nantz Press Box contains seats for 70 working media along with a press dining area and a wired photographer work room.

FIELD SURFACE

The synthetic surface installed at TDECU Stadium is the S5-M manufactured by UBU. S5-M, a Speed Series product, is a slit-film turf blade with a sand/rubber combination for infill. It is the same surface installed at the Houston Football practice facility. The turf is designed to host a multitude of events, including but not limited to, high school football games, band practice, specific UH intramural events, etc.

LEGENDS PLAZA

A plaza area recognizing the proud tradition of Houston Football at the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium.

LOCKER ROOM (HOME)

State-of-the-art 5,000-square foot home locker room located at the southeast corner of TDECU Stadium. Views exclusive to the club area give those fans an opportunity to watch team members travel from the locker room to the field level.

LOCKER ROOM (VISITOR)

Located at the west end of the stadium with a field entrance in the northwest corner of TDECU Stadium. Multi-functional locker room can be split and serve two separate teams simultaneously.

ORIENTATION OF STADIUM

East-to-west giving fans and television audiences a spectacular view of the downtown Houston skyline while also keeping in line with the University's grid system and creating more efficient parking. Sun and shade studies were also conducted to improve the best level of comfort for Houston fans and not affect student-athletes.

PARTY PATIOS

Four (4) open-air lower bowl party decks with 24 armchairs (20 inches wide). Both the east and west lower bowl end zones contain a party deck with two located on the north lower bowl sideline.

PREMIUM SEATING

Consists of 5,000 of the 40,000 seats in the TDECU Stadium.

Club Area - The stylish club area is the ultimate Houston Football experience. With 12,400 square feet of multi-purpose club area overlooking the field of play, fans with access to the club area enjoy upscale food and drinks while receiving first-class hospitality on game days. The climate-controlled area also feature high-definition televisions and private restrooms. The area is also available to host special events, meetings and classes.

Suites - Spanning from end zone to end zone on the south side of TDECU Stadium with a view of downtown Houston, 26 premium suites each containing 12 outside padded arm chairs, four inside bar stools and entertainment area. Houston fans enjoy comfort and style in these 325-square foot suites with individual upscale service and amenities.

Loge Boxes - 42 loge boxes each containing four seats and high-definition monitors located throughout the stadium.

Club Seats - 766 armchair style padded club seats that are 22 inches wide and located in the lower bowl of TDECU Stadium.

Additional Premium Seating - 2,778 armchair seats that are 20 inches wide and 1,210 benches with backs with the majority located in the lower bowl of TDECU Stadium.

SUITE DECKS

Two (2) open-air party suites located on the suite level positioned at each end (east and west end) of the suites. Each open-air suite contains 60 padded armchairs (21 inches wide).

TICKET OFFICE

The University of Houston Athletics Ticket Office is located on the northeast corner of TDECU Stadium facing Cullen Blvd. The facility has eight exterior ticket-selling windows along with two interior windows in the ticket office lobby in close proximity to the stadium parking garage.

VIDEO BOARD

State-of-the-art HD-video board located on the west end of TDECU Stadium. Sized at 2,584 square feet (38 feet high, 68 feet wide), the board was designed by Panasonic using Nichia technology.
