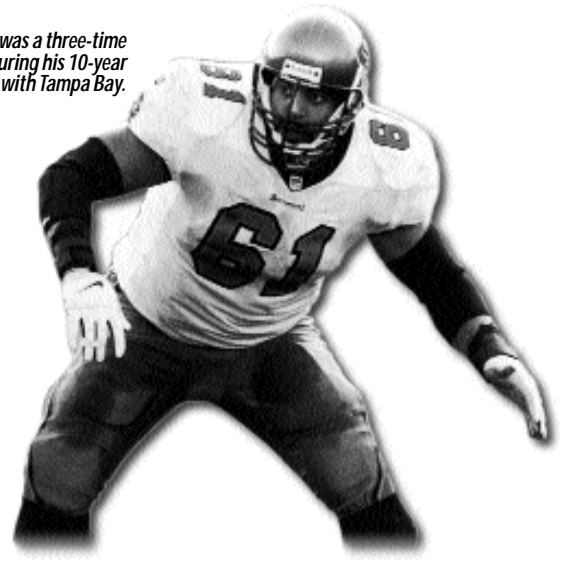

remembering 1970

wake forest's first acc championship team

Over 30 years have passed since the Wake Forest football program captured its first Atlantic Coast Conference championship in the fall of 1970, but the pride and memories of that notable campaign still run deep.

The young men who made up that WFU squad surpassed all odds to win the crown, as they were projected to finish last in the league in most preseason polls. A challenging schedule, lack of depth, and too many young players were just some of the ready-made excuses already being handed to the Deacs before the season even began.

Head coach Cal Stoll, in his second-year at the helm of WFU football, along with his staff and team, refused to listen to the gloomy forecasts. However, the year started as predicted, with three straight losses - all on the road - to ninth-ranked Nebraska, ACC foe South Carolina and Florida State.

The Deacons didn't give up, and turned things around the next week, playing its fourth straight road game at Virginia. WFU's crushing defense contained the Cavaliers for a 27-7 victory, sparking a four-game win streak in which the Deacs put away Virginia Tech (28-9), Clemson (36-20) and UNC (14-13).

With both teams owning a 2-1 ACC mark and tied for second place in the league standings at that point of the season, the match with the Tar Heels

would prove to be one of 1970's most exciting contests. Down 13-0 late in the game, the Deacons scored their second touchdown with 12 seconds remaining to even the score. The extra point lifted WFU to 14-13 lead, and Deacon defensive star Ed Stetz intercepted UNC's desperation pass to seal the victory.

Although the Deacons fell the next week to another top 10 team, Tennessee, they bounced back with a 28-14 victory over Duke in Durham. But for the dream of an ACC championship to become a reality, the Deacs had to once again stage a come-from-behind win, this time against NC State. A 16-13 win over the Wolfpack closed out the Deacons' ACC slate with a school-best 5-1 mark, and a subsequent defeat of Duke by the Tar Heels granted Wake Forest its first ever conference crown. Coach Stoll was named ACC Coach of the Year.

Although a loss at Houston concluded the season schedule, it didn't diminish the winning attitude and gutsy efforts of the team that preseason prognosticators overlooked - the 1970 ACC Champion Demon Deacon football squad.
