Raubex KZN (Pty) Ltd (Applicant) intents to apply for a mining permit to mine aggregate on 5 ha of the Remaining Extent of the farm Elands Spruit 5523, Ladvamith, Kwe-Zulu Natal Province.

SITE DESCRIPTION

The Remaining Extent of the farm Elands Spruit 5523 is situated approximately 26 km northeast of Ladysmith, between the Collings Pass road and the N11 national road. The area earmarked for the proposed mining falls on a section of the farm currently used for grazing purposes. A section of the proposed mining area was also historically used for quarrying purposes. LEGAL COMPLIANCE

An application for a mining permit in terms of Section 27 of the Mineral and Petroleum Resources Development Act, 2002 (Act No 28 of 2002) will be submitted to the Department of Mineral Resources.

The proposed mining area falls within 500 m of a wetland area and requires Water Use Authorisation in terms of Section 39 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998) for water uses as defined in section 21 (c) and section 21 (i).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The property has an existing quarry pit that was historically used for the winning of aggregates for road building purposes. The quarry was abandoned without being rehabilitated and the Applicant now wishes to expand the existing pit by making use of the open-cast mining method. The mining method will makes use of blasting in order to loosen the hard rock; the material will then be loaded and hauled out of the excavation to the mobile crushing plant where it will be screened to various sized stockpiles. The aggregate will be transported from site using tipper trucks. All activities will be contained within the boundaries of the approved site.

The proposed mining area is 5 ha in extent and the Applicant intents to win aggregate from the area for at least three years with a possibility of a two year extension. The aggregate to be removed from the mining area will be used in the building and road construction industries in the district. The proposed mining project will contribute to the upgrading/maintenance of road infrastructure in and around the Ladysmith area. The Applicant will make use of temporary infrastructure during the mining operations. Workers will daily be transported to and from the site.

THE MINING ACTIVITIES WILL CONSIST OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Stripping and stockpiling of topsoil.
- Blesting
- Excavation
- Crushing
- Stockpiling and transporting
- 9 Sloping and landscaping upon dissure of the site
- Replacing the topsoil and vegetating the disturbed area

THE MINING SITE WILL CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING:

- Drilling Equipment
- Excevation Equipment
- is Earth Moving Equipment
- Mobile Crushing and Screening Plant
- Mobile Office and Ablution Facilities

ACCESS ROUTE:

- The existing farm road (turning from Collings Pass road) will be used to gain access to the proposed mining area. No mining equipment or vehicles will access the N11 directly from the mining area.
- Haul roads, inside the approved mining area, will be extended as mining progress. All roads will be selected to avoid watercourses and steep gradients. Adequate drainage and erosion protection in the form of cut-off berms or trenches will be provided where necessary.
- The haul roads to be established to the site will be below the threshold of the EIA regulations of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No 107 of 1998) as amended June 2014.

BRIEF SITE DESCRIPTION

VISUAL EXPOSURE:

- The proposed mining area was identified to constitute the lowest possible visual impact on the surrounding environment. This application will entail the extension of the abandoned quarry pit on the property, but will also bring about the rehabilitation of the entire area upon dosure of the site.
- The mining area will be visible from the N11 as well as most of the Collings Pass road.
- In an attempt to mitigate the visual impact, the applicant will ensure that good housekeeping is implemented on-site.
- Upon closure, the site will be rehabilitated and sloped to ensure the visual impact on the aesthetic value of the area is minimized.

EXISTING INFRASTRUCTURE:

- A high voltage Eskom power line passes the property to the south. The nearest pylon of the power line is ±83 m from the proposed mining area.
- As mentioned previously the Collings Pass road (±80 m) and the N11 national road (±730 m) passes the proposed site respectively on the western and eastern sides. The Applicant will make use of the Collings Pass road to transport the material from site.
- The proposed mining site is ±150 m from a residential dwelling to the southeast and ±210 m from an earthen dam of the landowner (north).

VEGETATION COVER:

- The foremost section of the proposed mining area is currently used for grazing purposes.
- The establishment of the mining area will therefore necessitate the removal of indigenous vegetation from the footorint area.
- At the time of the inspection no red data or protected plants could be identified in the proposed footprint area of the mine.

SURFACE AND GROUND WATER:

- The proposed mining area will be further than 100m from any natural water source, and are therefore not expected to have a negative impact on any surface and/or ground water of the area.
- A drainage line with associated wetland area was identified within 500 m of the proposed mining area.
 Due to the nature of the proposed mining activity and the fact that all mining activities will be contained.

- within the boundaries of the site, it is not anticipated that the activity will negatively impact on the wetland
- A comprehensive hydrological study will be conducted to classify and delineate the wetland, upon which an application will be submitted to the Department of Water and Sanitation for authorisation.

SITES OF ARCHAEOLOGICAL AND CULTURAL INTEREST

No sites of archaeological or cultural importance were identified during the site inspection as the site has been extensively used for agricultural and/or mining purposes.

FAUNA:

The feuna at the site will not be impacted by the proposed mining activity as it will be able to move away or through the site, without being harmed.

POTENTIAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS

DUST:

- The short distance of the access road (±120 m) will assist in minimizing dust generation. The speed on the access road will however be limited to 30 km/h to prevent the generation of excessive dust.
- Roads will be sprayed with water or an environmentally friendly dust-allaying agent that contains no PCB's (e.g. DAS products) if dust is generated above acceptable limits.
- The conveyor belts of the crusher will be fitted with water sprayers to suppress fugitive dust.

NOISE

- 3 It will be ensured that employees and staff conduct themselves in an acceptable manner while on site.
- All mining vehicles will be equipped with silencers and maintained in a road worthy condition in terms of the Road Transport Act.
- The type, duration and timing of the blasting procedures will be planned with due cognisance of other land users and structures in the vicinity.
- Surrounding land owners will be notified in writing prior to blasting occasions.

ABLUTION, WASTE WATER & WASTE DISPOSAL:

- Ablution facilities will consist of chemical toilets hired from a contractor and serviced at least weekly.
- Any effluents containing oil, greese or other industrial substances will be collected in a suitable receptade and removed from the site, either for resale or for appropriate disposal at a recognised facility.

- Spills will be deaned up immediately to the satisfaction of the Regional Manager by removing the spillage together with the polluted soil and by disposing of it at a recognised facility.
- Non-biodegradable refuse such as glass bottles, plastic bags, metal scrap, etc., will be stored in a container at a collecting point and collected on a regular basis and disposed of at a recognised landfill site. Biodegradable refuse generated will be handled as indicated above.
- No weste will be burned or buried on site.

FINAL REHABILITATION

- Rehabilitation of the surface area shall entail landscaping, levelling, top dressing, land preparation, seeding (if required), and weed / alien clearing.
- All infrastructures, equipment, and other items used during the mining period will be removed from the site (section 44 of the MPRDA).
- Waste material of any description, including receptacies, scrap, rubble and tyres, will be removed entirely from the mining area and disposed of at a recognized landfill facility. It will not be permitted to be buried or burned on the site.
- Weed / Alien clearing will be done in a sporadic manner during the life of the mining activities. Species regarded as Category 1 weeds according to CARA (Conservation of Agricultural Recourses Act, 1983 Act 43; Regulations 15 & 16 (as amended in March 2001) need to be eradicated from the site on final classics.
- Final rehabilitation shall be completed within a period specified by the Regional Manager.

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT

This document is to inform you about the proposed activity and to determine whether there are any concerns or objections from interested and affected parties (I&AP's) that need to be considered.

Please note that only registered I&AP's and stakeholders will be entitled to comment on reports and plans to be submitted to the Department provided that the party provide its name, contact details and address and discloses any direct business, financial, personal or other interest which hashe may have in the approval or refusal of the applications.

The DSR will be submitted to the Department of Mineral Resources – KZN (DMR) for review purposes. This report will also be made available to the public for a 30 days review period. An electronic copy of the report will be published on the Greenmined Environmental website (www.greenmined.com). Upon laps of the commenting period the DSR will be updated to reflect the comments received during the public commenting period upon which the final Scoping Report will be submitted to DMR for its consideration as part of the authorization process in terms of the NEMA regulation. 

RE: NOTICE OF APPLICATION IN TERMS OF SECTION 27 OF THE MINERALS AND PETROLEUM RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT ACL2 002 (ACT NO. 28 OF 2002) AND THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT 107 OF 1998 NEMA) AS WELL AS THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REGULATION, 2014

Reference is made to the above-mentioned background information document received by this Office.

This Department has the following comments with regards to the proposed development:

(1) Water Uses and Water Use Authorisations

- (1.1) The proposed mining area project falls within 500 metre of the wetland area and therefore in terms of the National Water Act (NWA), they constitutes Section 21(c) and (i) of the NWA, i.e. "Impeding or diverting the flow of water in a watercourse" and "altering the bed, banks, course or characteristics of a watercourse" respectively and must be authorised by this Department, under the provisions of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act No. 36 of 1998) (NWA)), hereinafter referred to as the NWA. The river, stream and associated buffers must be treated as sensitive environment areas: caution must be exercised near the watercourses.
- (1.2) These areas are subject to 1:100 year flood line restriction. Your attention is drawn to Government Notice No. 1199 dated 18 December 2009 in Government Gazette No. 32805 which states that a General Authorisation is not applicable to "developments within a 500m radius from the boundary of a wetland or sewerage pipeline, pipelines carrying hazardous material and to water and westewater treatment works". A Wetland Delineation study must be conducted for all wetlands occurring on site, according to this Department's guideline titled, "A Practical Field Procedure for Identification and Delineation of Wetlands and Riparian Areas", (DWAF, 2005).
- (1.3) The locality maps must show the 1:100 year flood lines in terms of Section 144 of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998) which states that, "for the purpose that all persons who might be affected have access to information regarding the potential flood hazards, no person my establish a development unless the layout plan shows, in a form acceptable to the local authority concerned, lines indicating the maximum level likely to be reached by floodwaters on average once in every 100 years", must be submitted to this Department to ensure that this

Development is outside the flood line. Provide a 1:50 000 topographic map showing the exact boundary of the footprint together with the geohydrological map of a proposed Project Area.

- (1.4) It is the responsibility of the Applicant to identify all water uses applicable to the Project in terms of Section 21 of the NWA and to ensure that all applicable water uses are authorised as such. The Applicant must consult with this Department if clarity is required with regards to water uses and water use authorisations. The Department would like to be informed on where and how the water is obtainable for the process.
- (1.5) The Applicant must note that if the proposed Project engages in any water use that requires a water use licence in terms of the NWA, then by default all other water use activities taking place on the property, irrespective if it would be regulated by a General Authorisation, would require to apply for an Integrated Water Use Licence. This is part of the integrated licensing process.
- (1.6) Please note that no person may use water unless permitted under the NWA. Should you engage in any water use activity without the necessary water use authorisation, it is regarded as an unlawful water use. You will thus be guilty of an offence and liable for a fine or imprisonment as stipulated in Section 151 of the NWA. It is therefore advised that a Water Use Licence Application for the Project must be submitted to this Office for consideration. A Pre-Water Use Licence Application meeting is recommended. The Applicant is required to contact Ms. Zamashenge Hadebe of the Water Use Authorisation Unit on (031) 338 2700.

(2) Solid Waste Management

- (2.1) The requirements of this Department with respect to solid waste must be strictly enforced and complied with.
- (2.2) Should private contractors be used, all solid waste must be disposed of at a permitted landfill site and proof of this must be made available to this Department when required.
- (2.3) Such waste must be placed in skips stored in a designated storage / collection area prior to being safety disposed of and must not cause any surface and groundwater pollution, or pose any health hazards.
- (2.4) The recycling of suitable material is encouraged by this Department, provided it is properly managed.
- (2.5) Discuss the potential for resource recovery from wastes and residues (Including re-use, recycle or energy recovery from solid waste and liquid effluents).

(3) Sewage and Wastewater Management

- (3.1) Washing, refuelling, maintaining of vehicles or the transfer of hazardous substances must be conducted within a banded area. All drainage arising from the banded area must be treated as a water containing waste and disposed of safety.
- (3.2) The use of any temporary, chemical toilet facilities must not cause any pollution to water sources or pose a health hazard. In addition, these toilets must not be situated within 100m from a watercourse or within the 1:100 year flood line (whichever is the greatest). Furthermore, no form of secondary pollution should arise from the disposal of refuse or sewage from the temporary, chemical toilets. Any pollution problems arising from the above are to be addressed immediately by the Applicant.
- (3.3) The following is applicable should small volumes of wastewater be generated during the construction phase:
 - Water containing waste must not be discharged into the natural environment.
 - Measures to contain the water containing waste and safely dispose thereof must be implemented.

Describe the methods for collecting, storing, treating, transporting and finally disposing of the wastes during construction and operation phase.

(4) Storm water Management

- (4.1) It is imperative that there is proper management of storm water at the project site. "each of the new facilities will need to develop their own project to illustrate how their storm water will need to be managed" and that "environmentally sensitive storm water discharge structures will also need to be designed in order to ensure that storm water discharge from the proposed development does not negatively impact the River system." These storm water management plans must be included in the Final Report and must be strictly adhered to.
- (4.2) The Engineer or Contractor must ensure that only clean storm water runoff enters the environment.
- (4.3) Drainage must be controlled to ensure that runoff from the project area does not culminate in off-site pollution, flooding or result in any damage to properties downstream of any storm water discharge point(s).

(5) Erosion Control

- (5.1) Erosion control measures must be put in place to minimise erosion along the proposed construction areas. Extra precautions must be taken in areas where the soils are deemed highly erodible.
- (5.2) Soil erosion onsite must be prevented at all times, i.e. pre-, during- and post construction activities. Erosion control measures must be implemented in areas prone to erosion such as near water supply points, edges of slopes, etc. These measures could include the use of sand bags, hessian sheets, retention or replacement of vegetation.
- (5.3) Where the land has been disturbed during construction it must be re-habilitated and revegetated back to its original state after construction.
- (5.4) Stockpiling of soil or any other materials used during the construction phase must not be allowed on or near steep slopes, near a watercourse or water body. This is to prevent pollution or the impediment of surface run-off. The Applicant must control and establish suitable mitigation measures to prevent the erosion of stockpiles.

(6) Spillages Management

- (6.1) There must be no unacceptable impact on the quality of both surface and groundwater in the area. If pollution of any surface or groundwater occurs, it must be immediately reported to this Department and the appropriate mitigation measures must be employed. In addition, should the proposed development impact on any groundwater and/or surface water users, then water of equal quality and quantity must be provided to the affected users.
- (6.2) Storage of material, chemicals, fuels etc. must not pose a risk to the surrounding environment, and this includes surface and groundwater. Temporary bunds must also be constructed around chemical or fuel storage areas to contain possible spillages. Such storage areas must be located outside the 1:100 year flood-line of the water source and must be fenced to prevent unauthorized access into the area.
- (6.3) It is important that any significant spillage of chemicals, fuels, etc. during the construction phase and/or operational phase is reported to this Office and other relevant authorities. In the event of a spill, the following steps can be taken:
 - > Stop the source of the spill;
 - Contain the spill;
 - > All significant spills must be reported to this Department and other relevant authorities;
 - Remove the spilled product for treatment and authorised disposal;
 - Determine if there is any soil, groundwater or other environmental impact;

> If necessary, remedial action must be taken in consultation with this Department; and

Incident must be documented.

(7) General

(7.1) No form of secondary pollution should arise from the disposal of sewage and refuse. The

contractor must be clearly briefed on the method of disposal of such waste and compliance

must be ensured or monitored. Any pollution problems arising from the above project is to be

addressed immediately by the Applicant.

(7.2) Define the responsibilities for implementation of mitigation including funding.

(7.3) Describe reinstatement and after use of land occupied temporarily for operation of the Project.

(7.4) This Office reserves the right to inspect the site without prior notice in order to ensure that its

requirements, as mentioned above, are adhered to. Should any problems be noted, measures

must be undertaken immediately to rectify the situation.

(7.5) This Department reserves the right to revise or withdraw these comments and request further

information from the Applicant should any other information that contradicts the above come to

light.

(7.6) Notwithstanding the above, the responsibility rests with the Applicant to identify all sources or

potential sources of pollution from his undertaking and to take appropriate measures to prevent any pollution of the environment. Failure to comply with the requirements of the NWA could

lead to legal action being instituted against the Applicant.

PURPOSE OF MEETING:

To discuss the proposed extension of the existing quarry pit on the Remaining Extent of the farm Elands Spruit 5523 GS, Ladysmith, and obtain comments from the attendees in particular Mr. Khumalo and Me Mdluli who requested the meeting.

AGENDA:

- ℵ Commenting period

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

JvH presented an overview of the proposed mining project that borders the property of Mr. Khumalo, and explained that SANRAL proposes to upgrade the N11 (±40 km outside Ladysmith). JvH explained that Raubex KZN (Pty) Ltd (Applicant) intents to tender on the road upgrade project and therefore scanned the area, in the vicinity of the road project, for viable gravel sources. The quarry pit on Mr. Oosthuizen's farm is ideal due to its location in the approximate center of the road project. JvH explained that in order to be awarded a road tender, the tenderers need to submit the lowest price. Should the Applicant be able to obtain the necessary fill material from the intended quarry it will greatly reduce hauling cost which will have a direct impact on the tender price.

JvH further stated that prior to commencement of mining the Applicant needs to apply for a Mining Permit (MP) from the Department of Mineral Resources – KwaZulu-Natal (DMR) in order to comply with the legal requirements. The Applicant therefore appointed Greenmined Environmental (GE) to conduct the relevant studies and handle the Mining Permit application process.

Public participation forms a significant part of the MP application process and therefore discussions commenced firstly with the landowner to obtain his consent. GE also contacted the directly surrounding landowners to obtain their comments/concerns with regard to the project. These comments/concerns then need to be addressed and mitigation measure proposed to reduce the impact on the surrounding environment as far as possible.

CF explained the Environmental Impact Assessment process as well as the Mining Permit Application process to the attendees.

JvH reiterated that the main objective of the proposed mining operation is to supply gravel to the intended road upgrade project (N11), and that the quarry will not be operated as a commercial site. The mining area will therefore be closed and rehabilitated as soon as the road upgrade project is complete.

TT repeated the project overview in Zulu.

COMMENTING PERIOD:

The main concern of the attendees was that an access road will be made through their property, or that the mining project will spill over onto their land.



CF indicated the boundaries of the proposed mining area on the Regulation 2(2) Plan, and explained that all mining activities, by law, have to be conducted within these boundaries. CF further explained that the existing entrance to the Elands Spruit farm (turning from the Collings Pass road) will be used to access the mining area. No roads will be made through the property of Mr. Khumalo.

Another concern was that the houses at the Khumalo yard will crack or be damaged as a result of the blasting at the quarry.

JvH explained that Raubex KZN currently operates a project in Tombo where blasting is done at a quarry located between numerous houses. It was explained that prior to commencement of the mining activity an assessment will be done of all the buildings at Mr. Khumalo's yard to document the structural integrity. During a blast, vibration measuring equipment (seismograph) will be placed at the Khumalo yard to measure the ground vibrations that extents from the quarry. Should the vibration testing indicated excessively high readings the blasting at the quarry will be amended to lower the impact. Any structural damage, that resulted as a direct cause of the mining at the quarry, will be repaired at the cost of the Applicant.

The possible impact of blasting on livestock were raised.

CF explained that the Applicant has to inform Mr. Khumalo prior to each blast. The notification will allow him sufficient time to move the livestock away from the quarry area. It was also mentioned that Mr. Oosthuizen will continue using the camp, in which the quarry will be operated, as a conditioning camp for his cattle. Blasting at the quarry will therefore take cognizance of the fact that there is livestock within close vicinity.

The attendees enquired whether the project will create any job opportunities.

JvH confirmed that the project will create some jobs although not on a large scale.

TT translated the comments and responses as the meeting progressed.



WAY FORWARD:

CF handed a hard copy of the Draft Scoping Report to Mr. Khumalo, and explained that the report carried a 30 days commenting period. CF invited the attendees to read through the report and submit any additional comments before the end of the commenting period (11 May 2017). It was also agreed that the minutes of the meeting will be compiled by CF and included in the Final Scoping Report to be submitted to DMR for approval.

JvH explained that the Applicant understood that it enters the area for a brief period only while the residents stay in the area. JvH stated that the Applicant therefore intents to work with the surrounding community in order to operate a successful project and leave the environment in an improved or at least the same state as prior to the mining activity.






