Date 12 June 2014. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track: Bedfordia hill). Habitat: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate: Standing dead Bedfordia salicina.

Description: Several scattered sessile globose sporangia and plasmodiocarps, 1.8–2.8 mm long x 0.6–0.8 mm diameter. Hypothallus membranous, shiny, yellow. Peridium two closely adhering layers: the outer layer thick yellow lime; the inner layer membranous, hyaline and iridescent. Columella absent. Capillitium yellow, thickened at nodes. Spores in clusters, pyriform, black in mass, brown by transmitted light, with short spines on outer layer and warts on inner layer, 8-11

Notes: Three collections from dead standing Bedfordia salicina. Once collected from dead Pomaderris apetala.
