Date: 30 May 2014. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track).

Habitat: Closed wet Eucalypt forest.

Substrate: Leaf in litter accumulated among fronds of

Dicksonia antarctica.

Description scattered to gregarious stalked brown sporangia 0.8–1.2 mm high. **Sporotheca** ovate to sub-cylindrical, light brown, 0.6 x 0.4–0.6 mm diameter. **Stalk** ≤ half height of sporotheca, black in reflected light, reddish by transmitted light, 0.5–0.6 mm long. **Hypothallus** discoid, conspicuous, reddish brown. **Peridium** fugacious. **Columella** gradually tapering, almost reaches the top of the sporotheca where it merges into capillitium. **Capillitium** abundant, brown, perpendicular to columella, anastomosing, with free ends. **Spores** brown in mass, reddish brown by transmitted light, warted, most 7.5 μm, a few much larger.

Notes: Keys out to C. pulchella in N.E. N.-B. (1991).
