## Trichia lutescens Lister (Lister)

**Date** 26 Aug. 2013. Black Sugarloaf, Birralee (big tree track). **Habitat**: Closed wet Eucalypt forest. **Substrate**: Dead leaning *Bedfordia salicina*. **Description**: Scattered sessile globose sporangia, yellow 0.6–0.9 mm diameter. **Hypothallus** translucent yellow brown. **Peridium**: Membranous, translucent, 'marbled' yellow and ochraceous, dehiscence irregular. **Capillitium** pale yellow simple (unbranched) elaters, 3 µm diameter, spiral bands with free ends either tapering or ending abruptly. **Spores** yellow in mass, pale by transmitted light with scattered warts 10 µm **Notes**: One collection only. Stephenson (2003): 'a rarely collected species ...from widely scattered localities in the Northern Hemisphere, apparently most common at high latitudes.'
