
## Pagurus spilocarpus

**Coloration:** Shield and ocular acicles tan; with irregularly arranged reddish-brown flecks; Chelipeds tan, spines white at base and purple at tips; distinctive purple mark on the carpal segment of the chelipeds.

## **Defining Characteristics:**

- Chelia with strong, conical spines on dorsal surface and dorsomesial and dorsolateral margins
- Right cheliped considerably larger than left
- Telson with posterior lobes asymmetrical left lobe larger than right
