## Diagnostic Characters:

- G2 of female and small non-thumbed male, palm usually concave
- G1, carpus, without seta at the anterodistal junction of the propodus
- G1, basis without a row of short setae along the length of the anterolateral margin
- G2, anterolateral margin of the basis with a row of setae along its length




Fig. 16. Jassa staudei. Holotype, adult male, major form, 6.0 mm. Broken Islands, north side of Wouwer Island, Barkley Sound, Vancouver Island, British Columbia, 27 June 1976, E. L. Bousfield, collector, NMNS 1976-157, station B7. Lateral view.
