
Parametopella ninis

Diagnostic Characters:

- Accessory flagellum absent
- G1, propod slightly expanded, equal in length to carpus
- Pereopod 7, basis posterior lobe weakly expanded proximally, tapering distally
- Pereopod 6, basis linear, lacking any posterior lobe
- Telson armed with spines and/or setae dorsally
- Antennae 1, article 1 not produced
- Pereonite 4 not swollen dorsally
- Eyes present; pigmented, composed of multiple ommatidea
