

1 General information

1.1 Release update

The update to the version Amadeus Bahn **4.15** is done on **1**st **March 2023** via server download. No local installation is required.

When launching Amadeus Bahn you will always automatically receive the latest version.

Thus (safety relevant) changes are immediately available. Functional changes are notified in advance by publishing release notes.

You find information about your current version in customizing , tab "Version Info" or in the header of the client in Selling Platform Connect.

JavaTM 8 is required for using Amadeus Bahn. Please note that Oracle has changed the license model for Java. Java 8 may be used without license only for private use. Amadeus provides licenses for commercial use in the Selling Platform and Selling Platform Connect. Therefore, only the Java 8 versions released by Amadeus may be used. You can find the released version in the Amadeus Service Hub.




2.1 Links to the DB RailGuide

In January 2023 Deutsche Bahn moved the german DB RailGuide to the new portal "DB Campus".


Therefore, the following adjustments to the Amadeus Bahn user interface became necessary:

a) The link in the Amadeus Bahn help menu has been changed to DB Campus (only in the German Amadeus Bahn Interface)






b) In the search tree (Guided Mode) all links to the DB RailGuide have been removed:






c) The links to the DB seat map and coach diagram have been removed:


