The Top Ten Native Texas Plants



RED YUCCA

Hesperaloe parviflora

Graceful arching evergreen with beautiful red flowers all summer. Humming birds love this plant. Tough – Tough – Tough

AUTUMN SAGE

Salvia greggii

One of Texas' best landscape plants. Autumn sage comes in a variety of colors like red, pink, coral, white, yellow and now a bright purple!

TEXAS SMOKE TREE

Cotinus obovatus

Soft green foliage and airy wisps of pink blooms that look like fairy smoke in the late spring. Small tree great for dry sunny gardens.

TEXAS PERSIMMON

Dispyros texana

This persimmon can't decide if it wants to be a tree or shrub. Either way you can't go wrong with this beauty. Semi-evergreen.

DEER HUHLY

Muhlenbergia rigens

Highly ornamental grass from the Trans Pecos. Arching grass blades create a soft semi-evergreen mound. Blooms in late summer. Stiff upright bloom spikes persist all winter.

MEXICAN FEATHER GRASS

Nassella tenuissima (Stipa)

We love this grass so much, it may make the top ten list again next year! Evergreen weeping grass that stands under 24". Nassella loves it hot and dry or will tolerate some shade.

CORONA DE CRISTO

Passiflora foetida

Fast growing passion vine with smaller fuzzy leaves. The flowers open on top of lacy bracts that enclose the red seed pod as it forms.

YELLOW HONEYSUCKLE

Lonicera sempervirens sulphurea

Bright yellow blooms on evergreen vine. This yellow variety of coral honeysuckle is a delightful addition to any garden.

FOURNERVE DAISY

Hymenoxys scaposa

By far the longest blooming perennial in Texas! Sweet yellow daisies atop a small evergreen mound from February to December. An absolute must for all Texas gardens.

SPIDERWORT

Tradescantia sp.

You'll love these shade tolerant natives because of their blue-green strap-like foliage and bright three petaled flowers. Flowers can be white, pink, purple, and lavender. Great in sun or shade. 'Condord Grape' is a variety with an exceptionally long blooming season.
