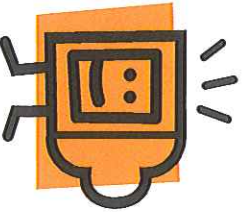

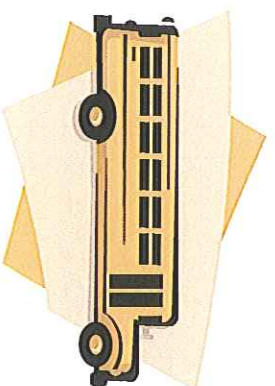


### PASS Data
