LISA LINDE, JAZZ ENSEMBLE



Lisa Linde has been the instrumental music director at Newton South High School since 1998. As a teacher and conductor, Lisa directs the Newton South High School Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, Honors Chamber Ensembles, Jazz Ensemble, Lab Jazz Ensemble, and four levels of jazz improv courses. Prior to joining the music staff at Newton South was the band director in Franklin, Massachusetts. Under her direction, Newton South performing ensembles consistently receive state, regional, and national recognition. The Newton South Jazz Ensemble has grown to the point that they regularly receive top ratings at MAJE state festivals and frequently place in the top four at the Berklee HS Jazz Festival. Most recently the Newton South Jazz Ensemble has been accepted into the 2018 Essentially Ellington HS Jazz Festival as well as being selected to the Charles Mingus HS Jazz Festival for the past two years, placing 2nd in 2019.

Lisa is a passionate advocate for gender equality in jazz and has recently started Jazzhers, an organization committed to shaping the future of jazz by helping young musicians who identify as female to become connected and feel empowered within the jazz community.

Lisa received her undergraduate degree in Music Education from the University of Massachusetts, Amherst and her masters degree in Wind Ensemble Conducting from New England Conservatory where she studied with Frank Battisti. She has served on several boards including MMEA Central District and MICCA as the Solo and Ensemble Chair.

AMANDA HOWLAND, JAZZ ENSEMBLE MANAGER

Amanda Howland is a local trumpet player and the director of band and chorus at Bridgewater-Raynham regional high school. She is a 2011 graduate of Anna Maria College with a degree in Music Education. There she studied trumpet with Jonathan Clark, piano with Elizabeth Noone and guitar with Kevin Grudecki. She performed in the Jazz Combo at AMC under the direction of Boston-area bassist Steve Skop and the Wind Ensemble at Worcester Polytechnic Institute under the direction of Douglas Weeks.

Amanda began her career teaching as a long term substitute for elementary music and Middle School Band in Somerset, MA. Then, Kindergarten music in Westport for one year. Since then she has been at the Bridgewater-Raynham Regional School district as the 7th grade general music teacher at Bridgewater Middle School (2014-2018) and now the High School Band and Choir director. She has also had the opportunity to teach 7th and 8th grade chorus, 5th and 6th grade band and the High School Jazz Band. She also started a “Junior” Jazz club for grades 6-8 and is the Assistant Director of the BRRHS Marching Band along with director Sandra Medeiros.

In addition to teaching, Amanda is also a professional trumpet player and has had the privilege of performing with the John Allmark Jazz Orchestra, the South Coast Jazz Orchestra, The Larry Brown Swinglane Orchestra, The Meadowlarks Big Band, Tri-County Symphonic Band, The Bay State Band, the Portuguese American Marching Band, and many others.



JENNIFER HARTNETT, TREBLE CHORUS

Jennifer is the Director of Choral Activities at Norwood High School, a position she's held since 2015. There, she conducts the Madrigals, Concert Chorale, and a cappella. She teaches Music Theory, Ukulele, and various Music History and appreciation courses. She's also the advisor for Norwood's chapter of Tri-M Music Honors Society and is Music Director for the musical. Prior to that, she worked in the Rockland Public Schools and taught choir for grades 5-12 and middle school general music. The NHS Madrigals perform regularly in the winter months for many local community events. Highlights include a Night of Stars Olympic Medalists, Stairs4OurTroops event at Gillette Stadium, Massachusetts State House and the Newport Mansions. Her ensembles regularly place gold or high silver at MICCA.

Jennifer holds an undergraduate degree in Vocal Performance from Bridgewater State College, a masters degree in Choral Conducting from Stephen F. Austin State University and an advanced teaching certificate in Music Education from Bridgewater State University. She's been the Director of Music at Avon Baptist Church since 2007. She is a lifetime member of ACDA, NAFME and serves as the Choral Representative for Southeastern District.

JAMES HAY, TREBLE CHORUS ACCOMPANIST

James Hay has a Graduate Performance Diploma (with Distinction) in Collaborative Piano from Longy School of Music. Previously, he studied Piano Performance at New England Conservatory of Music. His piano teachers include Wayman Chin, Yoriko Takahashi, and Gabriel Chodos. He has performed in Master Classes with Aube Tzerko, Victor Rosenbaum, Joan Panetti and Warren Jones. Mr. Hay is on the faculty as Visiting Lecturer and Staff Accompanist at Bridgewater State University and as Staff Accompanist at Anna Maria College. Previously, he was on the faculty as Visiting Lecturer and Staff Accompanist at U-Mass Dartmouth. He is Accompanist of Jubilate Chorale (Brockton), Bridgewater State University Chorale, and Anna Maria College Concert Choir and was accompanist of U-Mass Dartmouth Chorale, South Coast Children's Chorus and Organist at First Baptist Church in Brockton. He has been an accompanist for the Boston and Rhode Island Chapters of the National Association of Teachers of Singing, McClosky Institute of Voice, Mass Theatrica, Longwood Opera, North Shore Summer Concert Series, and New England Gilbert and Sullivan Society. He was Music Minister at St. Basil's Chapel in Bridgewater, Organist at Universalist Unitarian Church of Brockton and Studio Accompanist at the Voice Studio of Lin Schuller. Mr. Hay has performed at the Music Mansion in Providence, Rhode Island and the Longfellow House in Cambridge, Massachusetts and was a winner of the Longy School of Music Honors Competition in 2006.

BILL RICHTER, TREBLE CHORUS MANAGER

Mr. Richter is completing his 46th year in public education of which 39 have been in Scituate. He directs five choirs at SHS, the Pilgrim Festival Chorus based in Plymouth and choirs at the First Trinitarian Congregational Church in Scituate. Bill has served the Southeastern District numerous times as Chairperson, Conductor, Manager, Host and Judge. He has served SEMSBA in all those capacities as well.

KIRSTEN OBEROI, MIXED CHORUS



Quincy native Kirsten Oberoi is the Founding Artistic Director of the South Shore Children's Chorus (which currently serves over 130 singers grades K-12 from the greater South Shore), and also taught public school chorus at the secondary level for eight years in both Massachusetts and California. Regarded as a unique and creative choral artist and arts entrepreneur, Oberoi is known for her strong philosophies and teaching practices based on inclusion and equity in the music education classroom. Oberoi has presented at conferences sponsored by the Massachusetts Music Educators Association, the American Choral Directors Association, and the Rhode Island Chapter of the American Choral Directors Association. In 2018, she conducted both the Senior Mixed and Junior

Treble honor choirs through the Southeastern Bandmasters Association. In addition to her work with the South Shore Children's Chorus, Oberoi serves as the General Manager for the Greater Boston Choral Consortium, is a content creator and blog writer for Chorus Connection, and is the host of the Choral Connectivity; A People-First Approach to Singing podcast. Oberoi believes passionately that singing should be natural, fun, and accessible to all who want to learn.

SARAH TROXLER, MIXED CHORUS ACCOMPANIST

Sarah Troxler, Pianist, is the Music Accompanist at Scituate High School and Gates Middle School. An active performer, vocal coach, and theatre music director throughout the greater Boston area, she has worked with community organizations such as Americana Theatre Company, Spotlight Music and Theater Academy, North End Music & Performing Arts Center, and many more. A graduate of Longy School of Music (MM, Collaborative Piano), she currently serves as a Teaching Artist and as Piano Department Chair at South Shore Conservatory, Worship Coordinator at North Street Community Church in Hingham, and accompanist of Snug Harbor Community Chorus. Ms. Troxler is also a recent fellow of the Mass Cultural Council's Music Educators & Teaching Artists Program, where she worked to cultivate the voice of youth artists through mentorship and outreach opportunities.

SARA GODDU, MIXED CHORUS MANAGER

Sara Goddu is the Choral Director at Randolph High School and has been in the Randolph Public School system since 2012. In addition to teaching two choirs, ukulele, and a theater class, Sara also directs the Show Choir and the Spring Musical. Sara received her Masters Degree in Music Education from Gordon College and her Bachelor of Music Education at Anna Maria College. She is currently the SEMMEA Secretary and the Jr. Mixed Choir Manager. In her free time, Sara loves to see musicals, rock climb, and play trivia games!



GREGG CHAREST, CONCERT BAND

Gregg Charest lives on the island of Jamestown, RI where he spends time away from his mainland job as a band director for students in grades 5-12. Trained first as a classical and jazz musician, he received an undergraduate degree in Music Education from the University of Rhode Island, and a Master's in Music Education with a concentration in Conducting from the American Band College of Central Washington University.

As a performer, Gregg has been fortunate to share the stage with legendary Tonight Show Bandleader Doc Severinsen, The Canadian Brass, and Folk Music icon Pete Seeger, among many others. In 2021 alone, Gregg performed on more than 100 dates with his band, The Island Time Steel Band. The Steel Pan is perhaps his greatest obsession, and Gregg enjoys arranging, and composing for steel band when he isn't performing. His steel band recently released 2 singles on the "22 Islands" label, and is currently recording a full length album for release in 2022. As a conductor, Gregg has recently been seen directing groups like the Wakefield Concert Band, and The Jamestown Community Band. Known for his passionate use of technology in the band classroom, Gregg has presented on the topic at the Western International Band clinic, and guest lectured to future music educators at the University of Rhode Island, and Providence College.

ADAM GRUSHCOW, BAND MANAGER

Adam Gruschow is a music teacher in the Scituate Public Schools, teaching 4-12 instrumental music and 9-12 music technology. He received his undergraduate degree in music education and bassoon from Ithaca College in 2011 and earned a master's degree in music education from the American Band College of Sam Houston State University in 2017. Adam has maintained a private bassoon studio with students from Plymouth, Scituate, Hanover, Pembroke, and Brockton, and is currently serving as the instrumental editor for the Massachusetts Music Educator's Journal.



ERIN ERBAN, ORCHESTRA

Erin Erban is a performer and educator experienced in working with young orchestras. She has served as a conductor for the Bristol Community String Project, the Rhode Island Philharmonic Youth Orchestras, guest conductor with New Bedford Youth Symphony/SEMAYO, and as the conductor of the 2014 Rhode Island Junior Allstate Orchestra. She was president and treasurer of the RI String Teachers Association from 2008-2011. Ms. Erban frequently serves as clinician and adjudicator throughout New England and is principal violist with The Chamber Orchestra of Barrington at St.

John's in Barrington, RI. Ms. Erban currently teaches orchestra and chorus at Qualters Middle School in Mansfield, MA.

BETSY PABÓN, ORCHESTRA MANAGER

Elizabeth “Betsy” Pabón is originally from San Juan, Puerto Rico. She received her formal classical training at the Indiana University School of Music in Bloomington, Indiana, obtaining degrees in violin performance (B.M.) and music education (M.M.E.) with specialization in instrumental pedagogy. As a performer Miss Pabón has presented master classes, recorded, and performed as a soloist and chamber musician in Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic, Mexico, Uruguay, Ecuador, Peru, Italy, and in the United States. Miss Pabón is a member of the Suzuki Association of the Americas, the Suzuki Association of Massachusetts, the National Association for Music Education, and the Massachusetts Music Educators Association. In 2013 she relocated to the Boston/Providence area where she teaches orchestra and general music at the Galvin Middle School for the Canton Public Schools, and private and group lessons at the Rhode Island Philharmonic Suzuki School.

Most recently, Miss Pabón performed as a member of Unitas, a classical Latin American music ensemble in Boston, and as a member of Talztop Season 3 and Season 4, an acoustic rock orchestra. She also currently performs and records as a guest artist with various bands exploring aspects of creative and improvisatory music making. She is also currently serving as the SEMMEA Junior District Festival Orchestra Manager.
