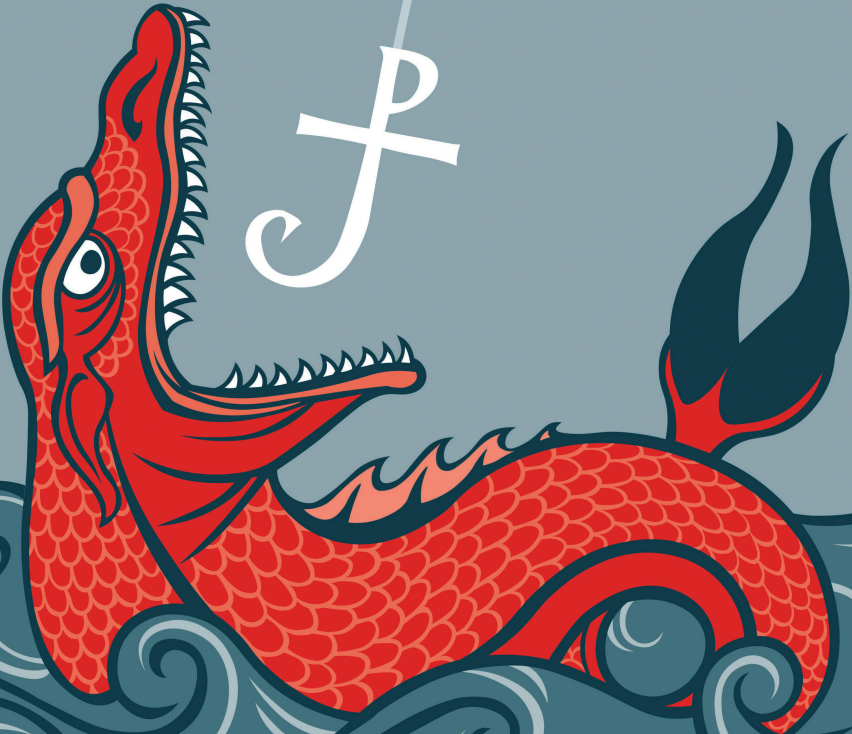


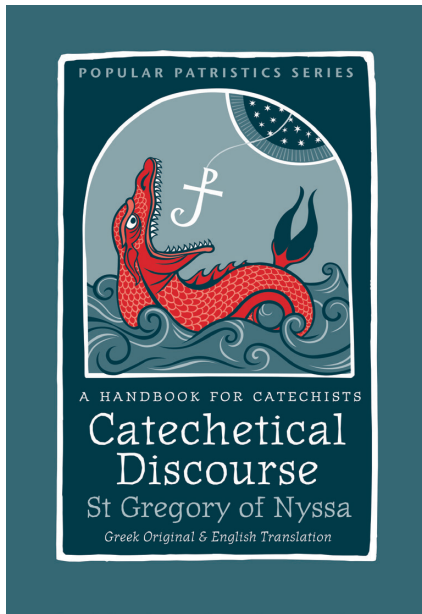

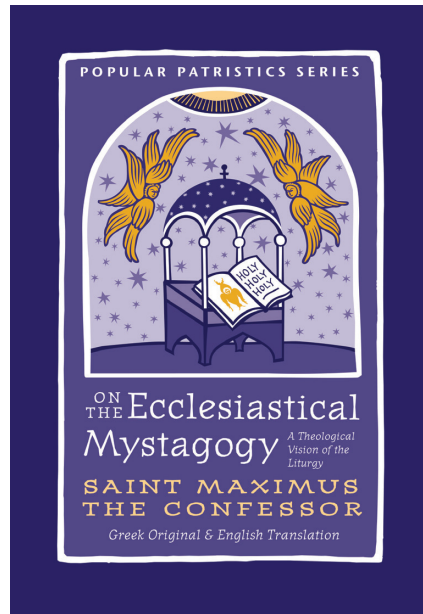

Written as a handbook for his catechists, St Gregory articulates the foundations of the faith: the Trinity, creation, the fall and the nature of evil, the saving work of Christ, and the sacraments of baptism and the Eucharist. Drawing upon the previous tradition—especially Origen, St Methodius, and St Athanasius—the *Discourse* went on to influence the later fathers. This work is also known for its ambiguous relationship to Origen’s universalism, perhaps including the idea that the devil himself will be saved. The translator’s introduction addresses this question, and provides a clear understanding of the work in general.

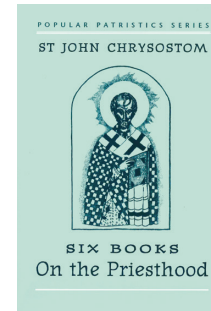

As St Maximus puts it, “Let us not be absent from the holy Church of God because she contains great mysteries of our salvation according to the divine symbols performed there. She reveals the gift of adoption that perfects each one into the image of Christ.”
