Noncompliance description:

Summary

Some certification labels may contain incorrect information and, therefore, fall to comply with the requirements of 49 CFR Part 567, "Certification."

Detail

During production, some certification labels were printed on a back-up printer. A printing verification had been performed on the primary printer but not the back-up printer. As a result, the GVWR, GAWR and tire size specifications may be incorrect on some labels, which fails to comply with the requirements of 49 CFR Part 567, "Certification."

Determination of noncompliance:

On July 29, 2004, a HMA associate discovered the incorrect label specifications. An investigation revealed one of the certification label printers had printed incorrect text.

Program for remedying the defect:

The owners of all affected vehicles will receive a notification by mail and be asked to inspect the certification label. If the label is incorrect, the owner will be asked to take their vehicle to an authorized Honda dealer. The dealer will install a correction label, free of charge.
