SUBSHRUB - evergreen.
1 - 2' high, 2 - 4' spread. Rounded.
Leaves silvery, deeply divided.
Flowers insignificant - spring to summer.



Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, foggy hillsides, bluffs and canyons on south Channel Islands (San Clemente, Santa Barbara, San Nicolas).

Full sun.
Good drainage. Coarse soil.
Prefers coastal exposure.
