Artemisia palmeri San Diego Sagewort



WOODY PERENNIAL semi-deciduous 2 - 3' high, 3' spread. Delicate, linear gray-green leaves. Aromatic. Flowers are inconspicuous - summer.

Native habitat: Coastal sage scrub, riparian - bluffs and canyons below 1500'; south coast into Baja California.

Full sun to part shade. Frost resistant. Needs water (4 x /month). Can naturalize in moist soils.

Dries back to a low cluster of stems in summer and fall. Grows as an understory under water-loving trees or tall shrubs.
