VINE, semi-deciduous.

Sprawling or climbing. Vigorous.

Wiry trailing or twiny stems 3 - 12 ' long.

Pale pink trumpet-shaped flowers - spring to summer.

Horticultural selection.

Original plant habitat: rocky slopes and canyon walls below 300' - Channel Islands.

Full sun to part shade.

Good drainage.

Water 2 x /month once established.

Long bloom season.

Fast grower.

Good on trellises or as groundcover.
