Cneoridium dumosum **Bushrue, Spice Bush**

SMALL BUSH - evergreen.

3 - 5' high, equal spread. Compact. Intricate spiny branches. Leaves tiny, aromatic.

Tiny white flowers, sweetly scented cover shrub in early spring. Attractive red fruits.

Native habitat: coastal sage scrub, scrub - mesas and bluffs below 2500' - Orange and San Diego Counties, Baja California.

Full sun to part shade on coast, part-shade inland. Needs no summer water, but can tolerate some.

Grows slowly. Irritant to skin of some people.
