Galvezia speciosa & Horticultural selections Island Bush Snapdragon

HERBACEOUS SUBSHRUB - evergreen.

2 - 3' high, 3' spread.'Firecracker' is a compact form.Leaves tomentose.Bright red flowers - spring to summer.

Native habitat: Rocky cliffs and canyons below 3000' - Channel Islands, Guadalupe Island.

Galvesia speciosa 'Firecracker' is a horticultural selection from G. speciosa.

Full sun near the coast, part shade inland.

Drought tolerant. Water 1 - 2 x /month.

Attracts hummingbirds and butterflies.
