Atriplex leucophylla Beach Saltbush

PERENNIAL HERB/SUBSHRUB
To 12" high, to 3' spread.
Oval leaves are silvery. Whitish scaly surface.
Male and female flowers separate, inconspicuous — April to October.

Native Habitat: plant is mainly found in sandy areas along the high tide line, dunes and around a bay — below 200' — Fort Bragg to Baja California.

Sun.

Moderate to no watering needed. Prefers beach sand. Needs fast drainage.

Good for birds.
