PERENNIAL HERB 1.5 - 6.5' high, to 1' wide. Rough-hairy stems. Leaves 2.5 - 5" long, lance-shaped, hairy. Flower heads in clusters, with yellow to red-brown centers, yellow rays up to 1" long. Long flowering: Apr - Oct

Native Habitat: North coast ranges to San Diego and northern Baja. Dry slopes, chaparral, woodlands to 6000'.

Full sun. Fast drainage. Prefers sand, but tolerates soil. Low water once established; Max 1x/month in summer.
