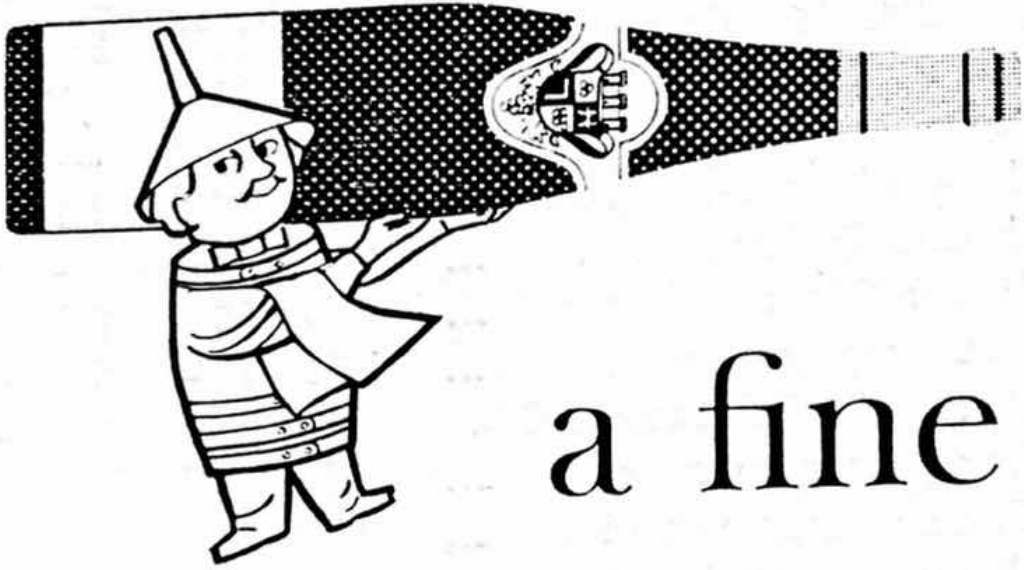

DECANTING WINE

Old wines with deposit or crust should be allowed to stand up for twenty-four hours before decanting.

Make sure that the decanter is clean and dry.

Draw the cork carefully and wipe the neck and lip of the bottle with a clean cloth.

With a lighted candle behind the shoulder of the bottle pour slowly and steadily until the sediment is seen moving towards the neck of the bottle.

When this occurs stop pouring at once. To allow any of the sediment or other deposit to pass into the decanter is to ruin the whole bottle.

Remove the stopper of the decanter at least one hour before dinner, and, as far as red wines are concerned, serve the wine at the dining-room temperature.

Serve in goblets, half filled, so that the bouquet of the wine may be appreciated.

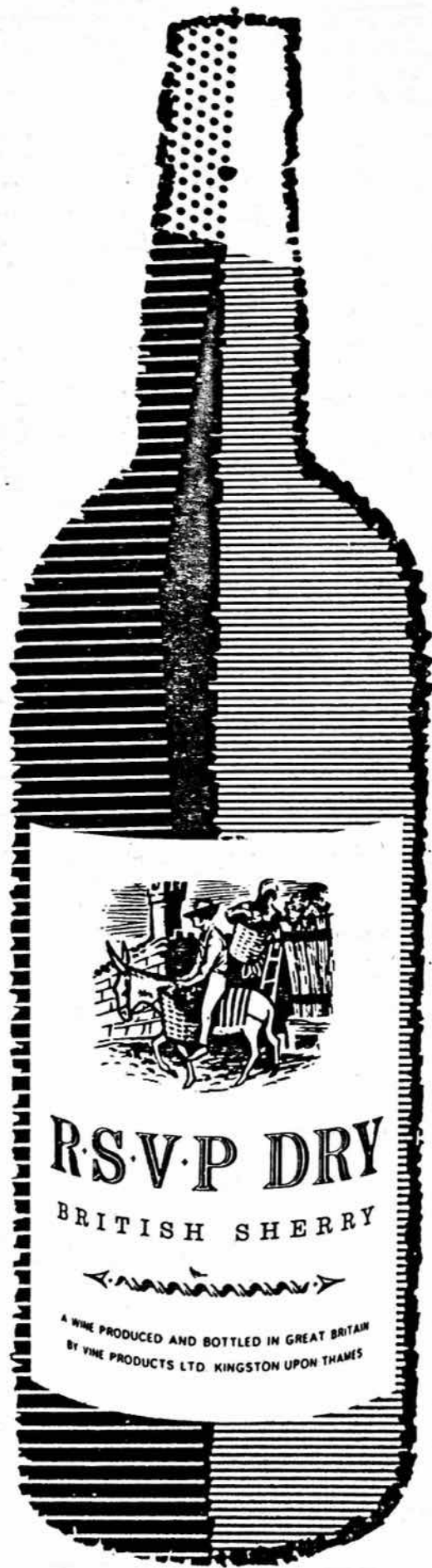

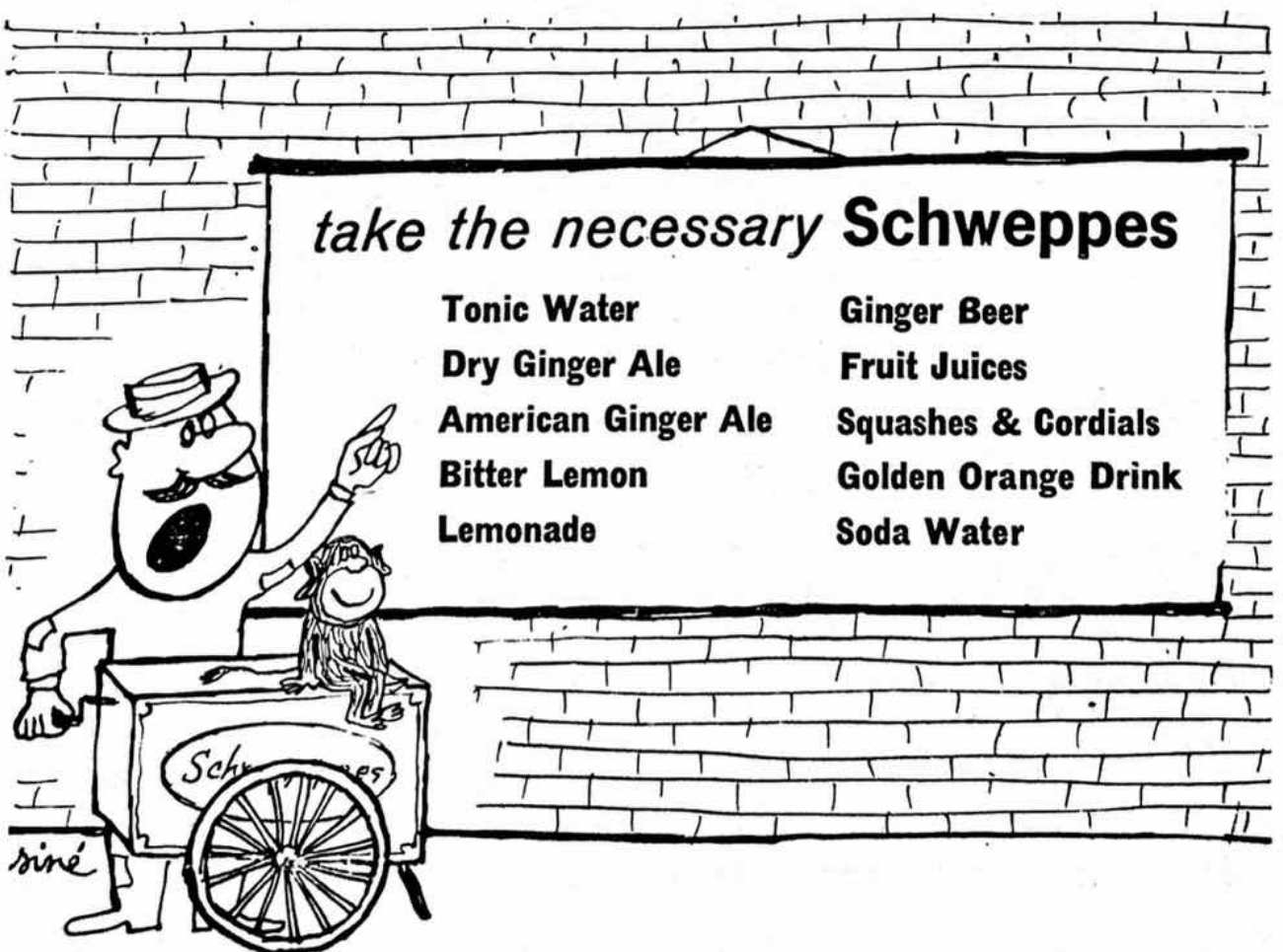

RECIPES

FOR CUPS AND COCKTAILS



DRY MARTINI COCKTAIL

Two-thirds dry gin; one-third dry vermouth. Stir in cracked ice, strain into cocktail glass dressed with olive or cherry.

MANHATTAN COCKTAIL

Put into shaker some crushed ice and add 3 dashes of bitters; half liqueur glass of curacao. Fill up with whisky and Italian vermouth in equal quantities. Shake well and serve with lemon peel, cherry or olive.

BRONX COCKTAIL

Squeeze the juice of half an orange into shaker half full chipped ice; add one-third gin, one-third Italian vermouth, and one-third French vermouth; shake well. Serve with cherry.

CHAMPAGNE COCKTAIL

Put into a wine glass one lump of sugar saturated with angostura bitters. Having added to this a small lump of ice, fill the glass with champagne, squeeze in the essence of a thin peel of lemon, and add half a teaspoonful of cognac. Stir with wooden stirrer and serve.

Rum Highball

Place into a tumbler, cracked ice. Add one measure of Jamaica Rum, fill up with ginger ale. Slice of lemon.

Orange Lady

One measure Jamaica rum, one measure orange squash; fill up with soda water, slice of lemon, cracked ice.

MOSELLE OR HOCK CUP

To 3 bottles of still hock or moselle, add 4 bottles of soda, a glass of sherry or brandy, 4 or 5 thin slices of pineapple and the thinly cut rind of half a lemon. Powdered sugar according to taste. The whole to remain 1 hour before serving. Peaches or strawberries may be substituted for the pineapple.

CYDER CUP

To 1 flagon of cyder add 1 small glass brandy, 1 wine glass rich sherry, 2 slices lemon and a few lumps ice. Allow to stand and add a bottle of soda water just before serving. Sweeten if desired.
