Davallia pyxidata: Hare's Foot Fern

Family: Davalliaceae

Genus: Davallia after E. Davall, a Swiss botanist.

Species: *pyxidata* from the Latin *pyxidatus* (endowed with a lid) in reference to the shape of the indusium.

This fern can be epiphytic, lithophytic or terrestrial. The fronds grow to 100cm and are deciduous. The fern often grows in association with other epiphytes e.g. amid the nest leaves of staghorns.
