WHRO is very proud of the expansion of WHRO News, and I am proud to announce that our newsroom now has a staff of 10 professionals. We have continued to ramp up local news coverage in the region with the Virginia Center for Investigative Journalism (VCIJ) at WHRO. If you didn't already know, VCIJ at WHRO reporters Brandi Kellam and Louis Hansen recently wrote an investigative series called "Erasing the Black Spot" that has received national coverage from both ProPublica and Apple News. The "Erasing the Black Spot" series displays how Virginia universities have disrupted black neighborhoods historically and in the present day. These are the types of stories that prove why local journalism is both important and impactful.

The station has also received positive feedback on the launch of a new TV channel – FNX, or – First Nations Experience. FNX is the first and only Native American and Indigenous TV channel in southeastern Virginia. First Nations Experience is truly the voice of Native American and indigenous communities, and WHRO is proud to locally broadcast FNX in southeastern Virginia on Cox 106, you can also stream live online.

As we head into the holidays, get ready to swing into the season with Jae Sinnett's Zero to 60 Quartet with special guest Randy Brecker for *A Swingin' Christmas*. From "Sleigh Ride" to "Silent Night," these tunes will be given a jazzy twist that's sure to get you in the spirit. # WHRO Education Earns Top Accolades at Public Media Awards Ceremony



WHRO Public Media was founded to support local K – 12 school divisions. The station was formed as Virginia’s first non-commercial, educational television station that brought televised teaching into our region’s classrooms – and education is still at the heart of all we do.

Through early childhood educational programs, student competitions, community outreach, professional development opportunities for educators, and online course development, the WHRO Education team works tirelessly to meet the needs of the community and provide children and their families with a strong foundation for lifelong learning.

Educators across the Commonwealth rely on the resources provided by WHRO – and the team’s efforts recently garnered national attention. WHRO won a Public Media Award for “Excellence in Education”

at the recent National Educational Telecommunications Association (NETA) Conference. This is the industry’s top award for educational services. The Public Media Awards honor member stations’ work in the highest caliber in the areas of community engagement, content, education, and marketing and communications.

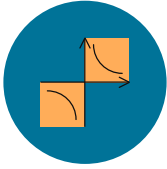
Over the last year, WHRO’s Digital Learning Team developed over 2,500 learning objects, crafted four comprehensive high school online courses, built one enriching middle school online course, and delivered a professional development course that empowers educators. They also extended their innovation beyond traditional formats to develop learning interactivities, engaging videos, eMediaVA (WHRO’s statewide digital repository) collections, and even two captivating online games.

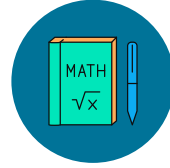

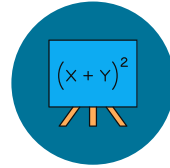

Additionally, the learning objects from the course have become the stars of eMediaVA, WHRO's statewide digital learning object repository. The learning objects are among the top-viewed assets in the entire platform. An astonishing 18 out of the top 30 most-viewed pages in eMediaVA belong to the EPF Collection, showcasing the immense popularity and influence of the team's work.

“The learning experiences we create are not just beautiful; they are powerful, meaningful, and transformative,” Fehl-Seward said. “We recognize that aesthetics, engagement, multimedia integration, and accessibility features are all instrumental in providing exceptional digital content.”

She said she is extremely proud of the team's hard work and their dedication to ensuring educators and students in Virginia have access to high-quality educational resources.

# Huge Crowds Gather for Nansemond Indian Nation's Pow Wow in Suffolk



WHRO Public Media enjoyed attending Nansemond Indian Nation's 35th annual pow wow in Mattanock Town, Suffolk, this summer. Held each year in mid-August, the Nansemond Indian Homecoming is held to welcome Nansemond descendants, family and friends back to the tribe's home. The event was first held in 1988 and celebrates the tribe's return to their ancestral land along the Nansemond River after centuries of colonial displacement. The pow wow featured a grand entry of tribal leaders, a traditional flag song, traditional dance demonstrations and music provided by drum circles.

"We are very proud of the fact that our festival is one of the largest events in Hampton Roads and one of the most beloved indigenous offerings in the Commonwealth of Virginia," Keith F. Anderson wrote in the event's program. He is the tribal chief of the Nansemond Indian Nation.

"It is imperative that events like this continue to be an integral part of the communal

fabric of Suffolk and across the entire nation," he said. "As the historical stewards of these lands, the Nansemond Indian Nation has the utmost obligation to honor the lives, sacrifices and immeasurable contributions of our ancestors."

The Nansemond were a part of the Tsenacomoco, or Powhatan paramount chiefdom, a coalition of approximately 30 Algonquian Indian tribes distributed throughout the northern, southern and western lands surrounding the Chesapeake Bay. They lived in settlements on both sides of the Nansemond River, where they fished, harvested oysters, hunted and farmed. The Nansemond Indian Nation was recognized by the Commonwealth of Virginia in 1985 and received federal recognition in 2018.

Continuing their tradition of caring for their land and its inhabitants, the Nansemond Indian Nation is dedicated to historical and cultural preservation for the benefit of tribal citizens and the community at large.



They serve in the region through numerous partnerships with local government, non-profit and community organizations. Recently, they transplanted 7,000 oysters onto a protected reef in Suffolk with the Chesapeake Bay Foundation (CBF) and the Nansemond River Preservation Alliance. The tribal community grew the oysters along the shores of Mattanock Town as part of CBF's Oyster Gardening Program.
