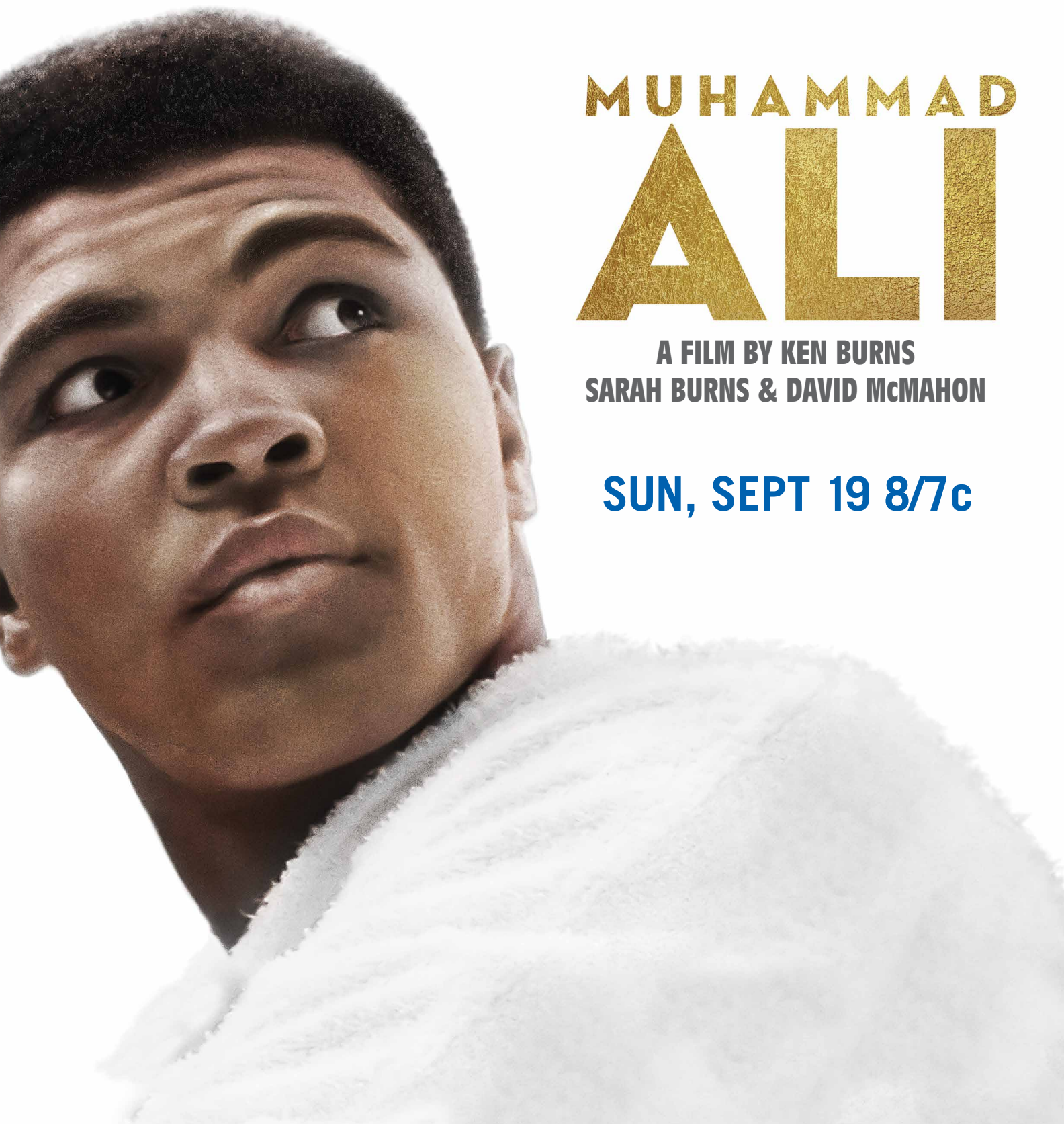

A new voice has recently been heard across the WHRV airwaves. Jordan Christie has joined the staff as a producer and announcer, and she also has even had a stint as the audio engineer for *Another View!* Jordan is a

native of Virginia Beach and a graduate of Kempsville High School and Virginia Commonwealth University where she majored in Mass Communications and Broadcast Journalism. Her interest in radio began at a young age—her mother Ann is a faithful WHRV listener and Jordan grew up with a healthy dose of NPR programs on their radio. “I loved listening to *Wait Wait Don't Tell Me* and *This American Life* while we were out running Saturday errands,” Jordan said.


While in college she worked at independent station WRIR in Richmond producing *B-Side News*, a bi-weekly news show that highlights the Richmond community. Since coming to WHRV last fall, she's hosted *Morning Edition*, *Middays*, and *All Things Considered*. She also co-produced the series *Tapping Gaston*, which looked back on the 15-

year battle to build the crucial pipeline that is the region's key source for water. Currently, Jordan is working as a co-producer with Gina Gambony on *Watching America*. While her radio duties bring her indoors to announce and edit, Jordan is passionate about hiking and biking and kicking around her downtown Norfolk neighborhood with boyfriend Ashlar where they live with two cats and 15 fish. “I'm thrilled to be a part of my local public radio station and to come home to it after being away at college,” she said.

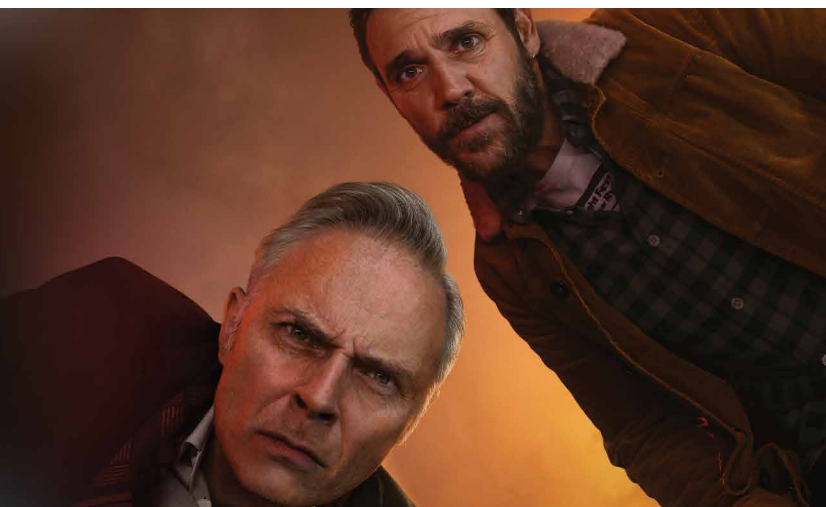

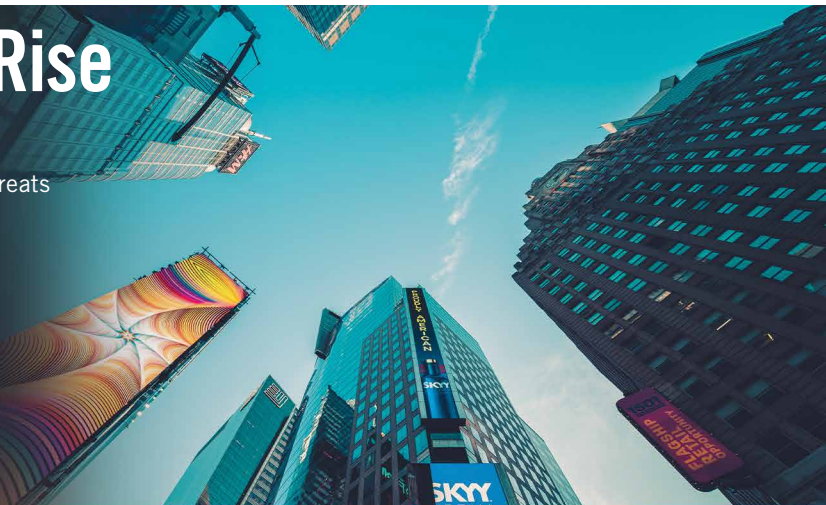

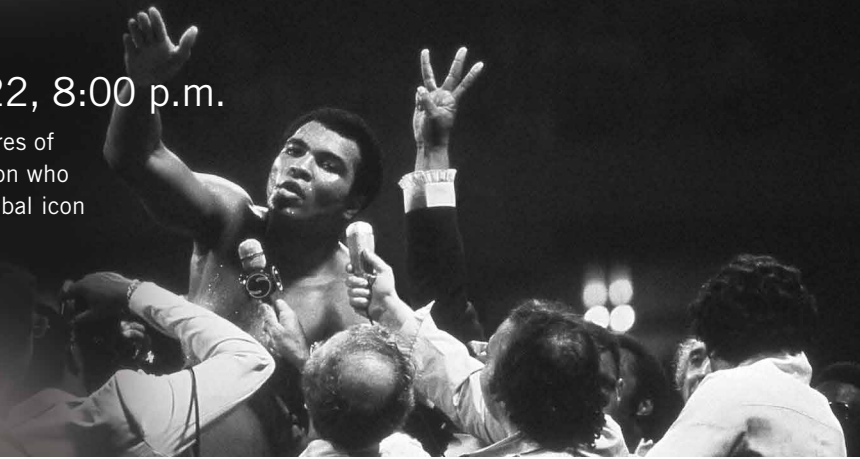

Muhammad Ali: A Film by Ken Burns, Sarah Burns & David McMahon

Muhammad Ali was one of the best-known and most indelible figures of the 20th century, a three-time heavyweight boxing champion who captivated millions of fans throughout the world with his mesmerizing combination of speed, grace and power in the ring, and charm and playful boasting outside of it. Ali insisted on being himself unconditionally and became a global icon and inspiration to people everywhere.

This month, a new four-part documentary directed by acclaimed filmmaker Ken Burns explores Ali's life and legacy. At

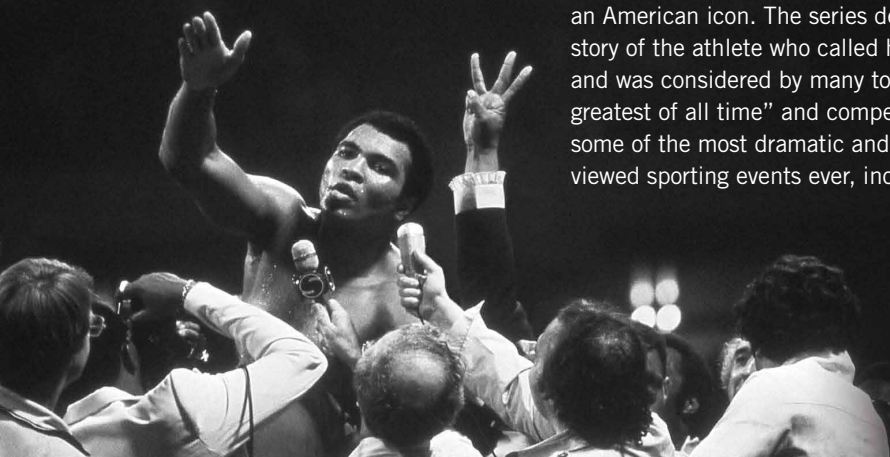
the height of his fame, Ali challenged Americans' racial prejudices, religious biases, and notions about what roles celebrities and athletes play in our society, and inspired people all over the world with his message of pride and self-affirmation.

Drawing from an extraordinary trove of archival footage and photographs, contemporary music, and the insights and memories of eyewitnesses—including family and friends, journalists, boxers and historians, among others—the documentary paints a sweeping portrait of an American icon. The series details the story of the athlete who called himself—and was considered by many to be—"the greatest of all time" and competed in some of the most dramatic and widely viewed sporting events ever, including

"The Fight of the Century" and "The Thrilla in Manila," both against his great rival Joe Frazier, and "The Rumble in the Jungle," in which he defeated George Foreman to regain the heavyweight title that was stripped from him seven years earlier. Muhammad Ali also captures Ali's principled resistance to the Vietnam War, his steadfast commitment to his Muslim faith, and his complex relationships with Elijah Muhammad and Malcolm X, who profoundly shaped his life and worldview.

"Muhammad Ali was the very best at what he did," said Ken Burns. "He was arguably America's greatest athlete, and his unflinching insistence that he be unabashedly himself at all times made him a beacon for generations of people around the world seeking to express their own humanity."
