

Introduction and Purpose

Through the planning or permitting process of a project, areas are often identified for restoration to mitigate development impacts and to enhance the natural heritage system. A Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) requirement for the selection of appropriate flora species, is that species are native to the TRCA jurisdiction.

This document lists flora species native to the TRCA jurisdiction based on the 2022 jurisdictional score and rank (TRCA L-Rank). It also includes the current wetland status of each species according to the Ontario Wetland Evaluation System (OWES).

Please note that this is a living document, i.e., it will be updated as required based on new scientific information as it becomes available, and might be subject to additions, subtractions, or other changes. Please ensure you are using the most up-to-date version.

This document should be used for the preparation of restoration, planting, or landscape plans in conjunction with other relevant TRCA guidelines, such as:
