# Cowboy<sup>TM</sup> Perennial Peanut

- Arachis glabrata
- Narrow green leaves
- Low growing
- Vegetatively propagated(rhizomes or sod)
- Ornamental, but could be used for grazing/hay.
- Potential for ground cover in orchards.
- Cowboy<sup>™</sup> perennial peanut fixes atmospheric nitrogen (legume).
- Flowers from May thru Sept.
