• To build a coherent National Statistical System in Myanmar that produces comprehensive, accurate and high-quality socio-economic statistics.

Institutional setup and Statistical System



- Established in 1952 as CSED by Central Statistical Authority Act No.34 of 1952 and Reorganized as CSO in 1974
- Statistics Law 2018 (Enacted by the Parliament in 22nd January 2018)
- CSO act as Statistical Authority of Myanmar
- Decentralized Statistical System
- CSO plays a key role in the National Statistical System (NSS)
- NSDS (2019 to 2024)

Readiness of Myanmar's official statistics for the Sustainable Development Goals

Joint data assessment by the Central Statistical Organization and UNDP

May 2016



- Main objective of this assessment was to kick-start the process of SDG indicator measurement through awareness-raising, and identifying data gaps across sectors.
- Key output of assessment is a "readiness" status for each SDG indicator.
- Plus much more detailed information (existing data sources, disaggregation, etc.)





Fig: Status of indicators (%) Overall
