

J. B. The institute was formerly known as Jamini Bhushan Astanga Ayurveda Vidyalaya and Ayurvediya Arogyashala. There is an annexed campus of the institute in the name of Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital, which was earlier known as Patipukur T.B. Hospital. The Institute was established on 10th February 1916 with the dream, dedication and devotion of the founder Kaviraj Jamini Bhusan Roy (01.7.1879 – 11.8.1926) and the foundation Stone was laid down by the father of nation Mahatma Gandhi.



The Institute is well known for its supremacy in education, research and treatment of Ayurveda throughout the country. The fame of the Institute reached to its height even in abroad. The college has already completed its centenary year on 2015. The Institute received all the privilege of the AYUSH Branch, Dept. of Health & FW, Government of West Bengal to provide best health care facilities through the Ayurvedic system of Medicine for public interest.

Course conducted

- 1. Ayurvedacharya Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery (B.A.M.S.) of 4 & ½ years course and 1 year compulsory rotatory internship recognized by the CCIM, New Delhi. The course is affiliated by the WB University of Health Sciences, Kolkata.
- 2. Panchakarma Assistant course of one year duration at Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital affiliated by the Pashchim Banga Ayurveda Parishad.

Admission Criteria

Candidate passed Higher Secondary (HS) examination under recognized Board or Council with the essential subjects like Physics, Chemistry and Biology are eligible for admission in both the courses. The candidate for BAMS course should have to be qualified with NEET followed by counseling and candidates for Panchakarma Assistant course will be admitted on the basis of the merit list.

Modern Medical Staff

Besides existing Ayurvedic teaching and Non-teaching personalities, there are engagement of modern medical staff specialized in Medicine, Pediatrics, Anesthetist, Pathologist, Radiologist, Gynaecologist and Dental Surgeon. Besides, Teacher cum trainer of Yoga is engaged in the institute.

Junior Doctors

All the passed out students of the institute are engaged as compulsory one year internee in different department as a part of the studentship with a stipend at per the rules of the Government of West Bengal. The successful internees are engaged as Junior House Staff with stipend in different departments of both the hospitals.

Treatment Facilities


A] OPD Sections: Seven OPDs at J B Roy State Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata *viz.* Kayachikitsa, Shalyatantra, Shalakyatantra, Panchakarma, Prasutitantra & Striroga, Kaumarbhritya and Swasthabritta and two OPDs at Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital *viz.* Kayachikitsa and Panchakrama runs six days in a week. Both the hospitals has Emergency Department which runs round the clock for 24 hours, seven days in a week.

B] IPD Section: J B Roy State Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital consisits of 120 beds in indoor system under the departments of Kayachikitsa, Shalyatantra, Shalakyatantra, Panchakarma, Prasutitantra & Striroga and Kaumarbhrity and two departments Kayacahikitsa and Panchakarma at Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital.

Average OPD attendance in both hospital is more than 500 per day and IPD bed occupancy around 50%. The patient strength in OPD and IPD between 2014-2019 is as follows:



Laboratories

The hospital owes pathological laboratory with sophisticated instruments under the aegis of modern medicine qualified Pathologist and radiological unit with facilities of digital X-ray and color Doppler USG under the aegis of radiologist.

Operation Theatre and Labour Room

One major OT, one minor OT and one labour room are existing and about 20 surgical operations are conducted every month. Modern Anesthetist is engaged for conducting surgical operations.

Panchakarma Therapy Unit

Specialized bio-purification therapy in different modules of Ayurvedic Panchakarma runs in full swing at both the hospitals for various diseases.

Herbal Garden

The institute has its own herbal garden at Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital campus with more than 250 varieties of medicinal plants.

Auditorium and Library

There are two well equipped air-conditioned auditorium in the institute with 150 capacity (Agnibesh Hall) and 30 seats capacity having all facilities of digital media. There is a well equipped library with approximate 12000 books.

Clinical Research Unit

The institute conduct clinical research in different filed through its own Research Unit. Sophisticated instruments like ELISA reader, -80°C freezer, pH meter, water bath, centrifuge machines, computers, etc are existing. Research projects are sponsored by CSIR, ICMR, DST (WB), funding agencies from USA, UK and various parts of country. Collaborations with different research institutes are made by the faculties.

Pharmacovigilance Centre

The institute has a peripheral Pharmacovigilance centre for conducting studies of ADR on ASU Drugs approved by the Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India. .

Publications and Award

There are more than 100 publications of research articles in different journals of national and international repute by the faculties of the instate in different departments for last 20 years. Some of the faculties have also credential for publication of books or chapter of books at national and international level. Most of the faculties have also exposure as guest speakers in various seminars at home and abroad. Many of the faculties received award from various academic organizations of home and abroad for their extra-ordinary activities in academic and research field.

Seminars and Symposium

Organization of seminars and symposium is a regular practice at the institute specially to commemorate the Foundation Day on 10th February and National Ayurveda Day. Besides, the institute also organizes conferences individually or in collaboration with other organization from time to time.





Medial Camp

The institute conduct health check up cum Ayurvedic treatment and awareness camps in different parts of the state engaging faculties, students, junior doctors and other relevant staff. Free distribution of Ayurvedic medicines are provided by the institute. The follow up treatment of different patients are done in two hospitals from time to time.

Hostels

One Junior Doctor's Hostel, one boy's hostel (Sukanta Chatrabas) and one girl's residence (temporary arranged) are existing under the aegis of the institute. A separate Ladies hostel is under construction at Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital campus.

About the College

J.B. Roy State Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital with its annexed Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital (Formerly known as Jamini Bhushan Astanga Ayurveda Vidyalaya and Ayurvediya Arogyashala including the Patipukur T.B. Hospital) was established in the year 1916 by renowned Ayurvedic Physician Late Kabiraj Jamini Bhushan Roy, M.A, M.B. The present building of the Institution at 170-172 Raja Dinendra Street, Calcutta-700004 was constructed in the year 1926. Before the establishment of the General Council & State Faculty of Ayurvedic Medicine, Bengal the Institute used to confer the Diploma of L.A.M.S. (Licentiate in Ayurvedic Medicine and Surgery), Vishagratna. After its affiliation of the General Council and State Faculty of Ayurvedic Medicine, Bengal in 1937 the Institution was following the course of studies and curriculum as laid down by the said body. The General council and State Faculty of Ayurvedic Medicine were subsequently succeeded by the Paschim Banga Ayurved Parishad since 1961 to which the Institution is affiliated.

The management and maintenance of the Institution "Jamini Bhushan Astanga Ayurveda Vidyalaya including Patipukur T.B. Hospital presently known as J.B. Roy State Ayurvedic Medical College & Hospital with its annexed Patipukur Ayurvedic Hospital" was taken over by the State Government with effect from 1st August 1964, for the conversion of the said Institution along with the attached hospitals into State Ayurvedic College and the running and maintenance there of along with the attached hospital for treatment and giving relief to the suffering people ordinarily on Ayurvedic principles with such amenities as may be practicable in accordance with terms of the scheme of management may be determine by the state Government from time to time.

Stipendary internship is available as per rules of the Health and FW Department, Government of West Bengal, Stipend amount is INR 29733/- per month.

UGC Guidelines regarding Anti Ragging Documentation

Why should & How can I use On Line affidavits?

- 1. It is mandatory for every student and his/her parents to submit an anti ragging affidavit at the time of first admission and there after each year at the time of annual registration. These are UGC's regulations.
- 2. It is the order of the Hon. Supreme Court that contact details of a students must be collected from these affidavits and stored electronically at a central location.
- 3. Until now each college collected such information. But it was not stored in any central location. But this year the Ragging Prevention Program developed an ON LINE procedure for downloading anti ragging affidavits. As a result, college authorities do not have to collect information separately and compile it. It will save a lot of their time and energy.

How?

- 1. It is a simple procedure comprising 3 steps.
- Step 1: Log on to www.antiragging. In orwww.amanmovement.org. Click on the button called- On line affidavits.
- Step 2: Fill in the information as desired and submit the form.
- Step 3: On successful completion you will receive affidavits, both for students and parents, through E mail.
 - 2. If you do not have an E mail address, please create one before you log in. If your parents do not have an Email/Mobile/Landline Phone number, please do not panic. You can give those of your friends or relatives. There is absolutely nothing to worry, If you make a mistake while submitting your from you can start a fresh and submit the information again. There is no problem. It is a very easy Process.

What Constitutes Ragging?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

a) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.

- b) Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher.

Where can I get Help?

- 1. I do not want you to feel that you are alone and help less. We are all with you.
- 2. Your parents are there to help. Please do not feel that you will burden your parents. Talk to them freely and openly. If you are being ragged- it is not your fault. They understand that.
- 3. We, at the Ragging Prevention Program are ready to help. You can call us any time on 1800 180 5522. It is a free phone. You can also send us an E mail on helpline@antiragging.in.
- 4. Your College Administration is there to help- Please do not hesitate to ask for help. They will definitely help you. The local police and local administration is also there to help.
- 5. Any body can register a complaint of Ragging. It does not have to be only the victim. If you notice an incidence of Ragging you must inform the call center. It is your duty to do so.
- 6. You can also register a complaint of Ragging- Anonymously. You must however avoid this option because without knowing details it becomes difficult for us to take any action. We can assure you of confidentiality.

What is ragging?

Ans: Any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or a junior student. 2. Indulging in a rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student. 3. Asking the students to do any act or perform something which such student will not do in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.

Why would anyone indulge in ragging?

Ans: a) To derive a sadistic pleasure and b) To show off power, authority or superiority over juniors or fresher's.

Is some form of ragging good?

Ans: No. Ragging, in any form, is a reprehensible act which does no good to anyone. Every act of ragging, major or minor, is beyond the limits of decency, morality and humanity. Civilized societies across the world are doing away with this nefarious practice. Some states in India have done the same. Madhya Pradesh will do it this year.

Why does ragging still exist?

Ans: a) Earlier, public opinion against ragging was not as strong as it is now. b) It was not clearly defined what ragging is C) Earlier, the concern was limited to violent form of ragging and other forms were considered tolerable, even desirable. This is not the case now.

What is "zero tolerance" policy?

Ans. No act of ragging major or minor, shall go unnoticed. No ragger, male or female, student or non-student, shall go unpunished. No institution that fails to take action against ragging shall be allowed to operate.

Who will implement this policy?

Ans: Everyone concerned, specially: 1. The heads of the educational institutions. 2. The state Government, through Divisional Commissioners. 3. The opinion makers.

How can we exterminate this evil practice?

Ans: By exercise of the disciplinary authority of the teachers over the students and of the management of the institutions over the teachers and students. No effort should be made to minimize the number of "reported cases". Reporting is to be encouraged through all available means. Antiragging movement should be initiated by the institutions right from the time of advertisement for admissions. The prospectus, the form for admission and /or any other literature issued to the aspirants for admission must clearly mention that ragging is banned in the institution and anyone indulging in ragging is likely to receive deterrent punishment.
