**Sunday Readings, Year C:**

The **First Reading** is taken from the Book of *Sirach 3:17-18, 20:28-29*. In today's reading we have a few more of the words of wisdom on humility from this saintly man who spent his life meditating on the law of God revealed to the Chosen People.

The **Second Reading** is from St. Paul to the *Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24*, in which he contrasts two scenes. One is the giving of the Old Covenant, and the other is the assembly of those justified by the New Covenant. The reason why the Church has selected these verses is the same reason that St. Paul had when he wrote them. He wanted to impress on the Jewish converts the superiority of the Christian religion over that of the Old Testament, which they had practiced until their conversion.

The **Gospel** is from *St. Luke 14:1, 7-14*, in which Jesus had been invited to dine in the house of a leading Pharisee. The Pharisees were so convinced of their own perfect knowledge and observance of the law, that they thought nobody else could possibly know it or observe it as perfectly as they did. In a very simple parable, Jesus told them where their pride would lead them.

A proud Christian, that is, a proud follower of the humble Christ, is a contradiction in terms. Christ, the Son of God, lowered himself to our level when He took our human nature. He was born in a stable, reared in the obscure village of Nazareth, earned his meager meals as a country carpenter, died on a cross as a malefactor with two thieves as companions and was buried in a God's banquet. Thank God, there are few whose pride leads them to these extremes, but there are far too many who set themselves up as judges over their neighbor and appoint themselves as the models to be imitated by all others.

There is a little demon of pride in each one of us. There is a natural inclination in each one to esteem ourselves a little better in most ways, if not in all, than our neighbor. We must keep this demon in check and not let him grow in us. Any gifts of mind or body that we have are from God—our duty is to use them properly and to thank God for the loan of them. If He gave greater gifts to another, I thank God for it. That other was able to make better use of them than I would. I have enough gifts to go on. I shall not be judged on the use or abuse of gifts which I did not receive.

If I use all the gifts which God gave me, to help my neighbor, the spiritually poor, the lame and blind, to heaven, instead of keeping myself aloof from them as the Pharisees did, then my judgment will be easy. I shall be "repaid in the resurrection of the just."

The proud Christian sets himself up as a critic of God's wisdom. He muses: God forgives sinners too easily. God doesn't know them as well as I do. That conversion cannot be trusted, it will not last, he says. The "sinners" prosper, they are blessed with good health, a happy family, more than their share of the world's goods, and here am I who never failed God, who always did what was right and even more, and I am neglected by God. God doesn't know his real friends!

These are the questionings of a proud soul. Such Christians raise themselves above their neighbors in their own minds. They choose the first places, and from their self-appointed heights they look down on their fellow guests at stranger's grave. Could He have done more to induce us to listen to his counsel when He said: "Learn of me, for I am humble of heart?"

Yet, there are Christians who are proud. Like the Pharisees of old, they thank God that they are not like the rest of men. They shun any contact with sinners. They cover their ears when any scandal is mentioned. Yet they never miss the gossip and are always ready to condemn offhand the unfortunate giver of scandal, without knowing the extenuating circumstances.

**Get ready for the upcoming Diocesan Synod Survey**



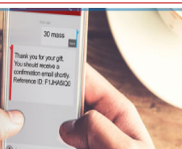

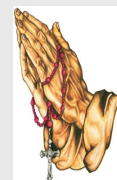

**Lecturas del domingo, Año C:**

La **primera Lectura** está tomado del Libro de Sirach 3:17-18, 20:28-29. En la lectura de hoy tenemos algunas palabras más de sabiduría sobre la humildad de este hombre santo que pasó su vida meditando sobre la ley de Dios revelada al Pueblo Elegido.

La **Segunda lectura** es de San Pablo a los Hebreos 12:18-19, 22-24, en el que contrasta dos escenas. Una es la entrega del Antiguo Pacto, y la otra es la asamblea de los justificados por el Nuevo Pacto. La razón por la cual la Iglesia ha seleccionado estos versículos, es la misma que tuvo San Pablo cuando los escribió. Quería inculcar a los judíos convertidos la superioridad de la religión cristiana sobre la del Antiguo Testamento, que habían practicado hasta su conversión.

El **Evangelio** es de San Lucas 14: 1, 7-14, en el que Jesús había sido invitado a cenar en la casa de un fariseo importante. Los fariseos estaban tan convencidos de su perfecto conocimiento y observancia de la ley, que pensaban que nadie más podría conocerla u observarla tan perfectamente como ellos. En una parábola muy simple, Jesús les dijo a dónde los llevaría su orgullo.

Un cristiano orgulloso, es decir, un seguidor orgulloso del Cristo humilde, es una contradicción en los términos. Cristo, el Hijo de Dios, se rebajó a nuestro nivel cuando tomó nuestra naturaleza humana. Nació en un establo, se crió en el oscuro pueblo de Nazaret, se ganaba la vida como carpintero rural, murió en una cruz como malhechor con dos ladrones como compañeros y fue enterrado. Gracias a Dios, son pocos los que por su orgullo los llevan a estos extremos, pero son demasiados los que se erigen en jueces del prójimo y se designan como modelos a imitar por todos los demás

Hay un pequeño demonio de orgullo en cada uno de nosotros. Hay una inclinación natural en cada uno a estimarse un poco mejor en la mayoría de los aspectos, si no en todos, que nuestro prójimo. Debemos mantener a raya a este demonio y no dejar que crezca en nosotros. Todos los dones de mente o cuerpo que tenemos son de Dios; nuestro deber es usarlos apropiadamente y agradecer a Dios por haberlos prestado. Si le dio mayores dones a otro, doy gracias a Dios por ello. Ese otro pudo hacer un mejor uso de ellos que yo. Tengo suficientes regalos para continuar. No seré juzgado por el uso o abuso de regalos que no he recibido.

Si uso todos los dones que Dios me ha dado para ayudar a mi prójimo, el espiritualmente pobre, el cojo y el ciego, al cielo, en lugar de mantenerme alejado de ellos como lo hicieron los fariseos, entonces mi juicio será fácil. Seré "pagado en la resurrección de los justos".

El cristiano orgulloso se erige en crítico de la sabiduría de Dios. Reflexiona: Dios perdona a los pecadores con demasiada facilidad. Dios no los conoce tan bien como yo. No se puede confiar en esa conversión, no durará, dice. Los "pecadores" prosperan, son bendecidos con buena salud, una familia feliz, más de lo que les corresponde de los bienes del mundo, y aquí estoy yo, que nunca le fallé a Dios, que siempre hice lo correcto y aún más, y soy descuidado por Dios. ¡Dios no conoce a sus verdaderos amigos!

Estos son los cuestionamientos de un alma orgullosa. Tales cristianos se elevan por encima de sus vecinos en sus propias mentes. Eligen los primeros lugares, y desde sus alturas autoproclamadas miran a sus compañeros invitados en la tumba del extraño. ¿Podría haber hecho más para inducirnos a escuchar su consejo cuando dijo: "Aprended de mí, que soy humilde de corazón"?

Sin embargo, hay cristianos que son orgullosos. Como los fariseos de antaño, dan gracias a Dios por no ser como los demás hombres. Evitan cualquier contacto con los pecadores. Se tapan los oídos cuando se menciona cualquier escándalo. Sin embargo, nunca se pierden los chismes y siempre están listos para condenar de inmediato al desafortunado causante del escándalo, sin conocer las circunstancias atenuantes.
