Ers 1994, mae Grwp Cefnogi Nicaragua wedi bod yn anfon dirprwyd bob dwy flynedd i Nicaragua i gyfnewid syniadau, dysgu am brofiadau a rhannu gwybodaeth. Mae'r daith yn para am bythefnos ac yn costio tua £990 (yn cynnwys teithio, llety, bwyd a phopeth) Wedi dod yn ôl i Gymru, mae cyfle i barhau'r cysylltiad gan fod gwaith cefnogi i'w wneud, ac mae ymwelwyr yn dod o Nicaragua i Gymru.

Dros y ddegawd, mae tua 60 wedi gwneud y daith, ac mae pob un yn cyfaddef i'r profiad wneud argraff fythgofiadwy arnynt.

Since 1994 the Wales Nicaragua Solidarity Campaign has sent a delegation every two years to Nicaragua to exchange ideas, learn from others' experiences, and share information. After returning to Wales, there's an opportunity to continue the link through solidarity work, and with visitors from Nicaragua coming to Wales.

Over the past decade around 60 have made the trip, and the experience has left an unforgettable impression on everyone.

The recent delegations have concentrated on **Education, Trade Unions Opposing Water Privatisation, Globalisation and Fair Trade.**

As well as political campaigning, we have supported a number of practical projects:
