- On 1 September 2012 ARTI become a Partner at the Web in Union Project. The objective of this project is the enhancement of EURAXESS national and regional networks in the Western Balkans. The Partner of this Project are : Croatia, Serbia, Greece, Albania, Montenegro, Bosnia Herzegovina, Macedonia. The project is coordinated by Greece and its duration is 24 months.
- On 3 October 2012, ARTI in cooperation with Joint Research Centre JRC organized in Tirana the event "JRC General Information Day". The objective of this event was to make Albania's researchers and entrepreneurs aware of the research activities performed at the JRC level, stimulate exchanges around common topics of interest and strengthen future collaborations between JRC and national researchers and research institutes.
- On October 2012 ARTI become a partner at the Tempus Project E-Learning Innovation and Sustainable Albanian Agriculture.
- On 12 November 2012 ARTI in collaboration with the Albanian Investment Development Agency (AIDA), the Regional Development Agency (ARD) and the Union of Chambers of Commerce and Industry of Albania organized in Tirana the Launching Event of the European Enterprise Network EEN Albania.
- ARTI is actively promoting COST and assisting Albanian researchers to participate in COST Actions. Before ARTI was established, there was only one participation in COST. The number of participations reached at 9.
