Expectation: Follow Safety Directions

Definition	
Having a general knowledge of safety expectations in various school locations. In the case of an emergency or situations following any instructions from PA system, teachers, security personnel, or administration.	
Rationale for having the Expectation	
With a school of over 4,600 students safety is always a major concern. The students can play an integral role in helping provide a safe campus by their behavior, actions, and awareness.

Specific steps of Lesson Plan (Include lesson format, activities, and details):	
Study hall teacher will review school expectations and rules. All students will watch examples of positive and misbehavior in various school scenarios and critique the student's behavior in the video. Then they will discuss the most appropriate way to handle the situation. If there was no problem with the situation they will state what positive traits were displayed.
